Which is useful as Hotel Danmark, Denmark or Danemark - depending on how your particular nationality likes to spell it, has a truly international clientele. Having been a well kept secret at the base of Soi Whitehouse just off Jomtien beach road for over 20 years now Americans, Canadians, Germans, Dutch and of course Scandinavians flock here for the excellent value breakfast buffet - there have even been a few curious Chinese diners.


Kent took over last year and immediately took command of their famous buffet breakfast tremendous value at only 190 baht. Served from 7:30 - 12;00 my advice is to come hungry as there really is such a great selection here you could quite easily call it brunch or lunch

depending on the time you visit! Their secret? Well Kent is not frightened of an early morning alarm call and is up at 5 a.m. to ensure everything is fresh - nothing hanging over from the night before! Also his selection of staff and their training is essential he personally shows them how to prepare and serve "farang food" always on the lookout for friendly hard working staff who are prepared to look and listen. He instills in them the need to clean the tables as soon as there are plates to be cleared away and has also told them to be friendly and smile!

After breakfast there is lunch 1 request with a special menu 10 pm. Every Sunday there is "Flaeskesteg" which is extremely personally love the Danish blue cheese, Danish bread and which is fantastic being crisp, from the egg and bacon station.



until 3 sometimes by special and then dinner from 5 until a speciality dish of Danish pork popular and I have to say I produce he serves. The Danish unsurprisingly the bacon streaky and freshly prepared,



Should you decide to eat al fresco there is a lovely breeze direct from the sea that is funnelled down Soi Whitehouse to cool you, whilst inside a large area with plenty of seating just perfect for groups and clubs. The Norwegian club meet here and just starting now a Danish club that will hold regular meetings at Hotel Danmark on Thursdays between 14:00- 16:00 the first one (31st May) having a representative from the Danish Embassy on hand to help with questions and problems.



Groups of golfers also enjoy holding their pre and post tournament meals at Hotel Danmark. Kent has even organised his own tournaments in November and then January. Attended by 40 players there was even a celebrity Norwegian sporting hero Bjørn Wirkola - Olympic Ski jumper who became the World Champion in 1966 winning both the large and normal hill competitions. Now in his 70s he still creates quite a stir when he visits and takes part in the golf although he wouldn't want to add the Hotel Danmark' Jumbo to his trophies as this is the "prize" for the player who finishes in last place!



A Weekend Jaunt to Hua Hin



t my age people sort of forget about birthdays but at heart I have always been a big kid. When I was young I was a complete nightmare, pestering my parents a good few months before the due date to try to find out what present I was going to get and putting forward outrageous suggestions (None of which ever materialised). So a couple of months ago I was already planning my birthday with my friends, where and what should we do to celebrate? This year everything fitted in perfectly, my birthday landed on a Saturday and many options were open.

It was over dinner that my three good Thai friends and I threw some suggestions into the proverbial party hat. First up was Koh Samui, but the flights were an outrageous price, then Siem Reap in Cambodia came up but was instantly dismissed for the same reason. Finally a road trip in Thailand seemed the best option but somewhere not too far so that we would not be spending all our time in the car. After much deliberation and one or two Leos later, the decision was made and Hua Hin was our chosen destination.

Now at this point I should tell you I do not drive, and last time I was driven to Hua Hin my friend decided to come off the toll road and negotiate Bangkok, which was an utter disaster and added hours to the journey. Thus, I nominated myself as navigator and I volunteered to sort out the route. I was also nominated to find accommodation and was given a budget not to exceed. Normally I tried to avoid organising things as you never get any thanks and usually I make a complete mess of things.

I immediately set to work on the accommodation and whilst surfing the normal hotel sites stumbled on a great deal at the Hua Hin Hilton Resort & Spa,. For some reason Agoda seemed to think I should benefit from discount vouchers, perhaps they knew it was my birthday? I felt really pleased with myself telling my friends all about the great hotel we would be staying at and droning on and on about all the first class amenities that it had. I had reverted back to my birthday mode and was one real great bore.

The day of my birthday finally came around and we all agreed to meet at my house at 7.30 am to get the most of the day. Being quite anally retentive I had studied maps, double checked Google maps, and restudied the maps again. The route was planned and written down in triplicate, in fact the only difficult part seemed to be getting around Bangkok. My Thai friends all have that lovable Thai trait of never quite being on time, so the jaunt actually finally got going a little late, just after 10 am! One of the great advantages of being the navigator is you get to travel in the front of the car, and also control the tunes.

We got as far as Thepprasit Road, two minutes from my house and our first stop was 7/11 for goodies to eat along the way. Back in the car for two minutes and the second stop was for petrol, then a good five minutes of driving on Sukhumvit Road and our third stop was to top up somebody's phone. I thought to myself that if this continued we would spend the weekend just trying to get out of Pattaya! My three travel companions now seemed content, I heard the munching of seaweed from the back seat and the unmistakable ping of somebody's LINE messages coming through. I took the opportunity of programming in Google maps to the car's system and we were off to Bangkok on Highway 7.

Saturdays on Highway 7 everybody is heading towards Pattaya from Bangkok for a weekend by the seaside, so our progress was rapid going to the Thai Capital. Google maps was in control so I put Singular on the sound system and the birthday jaunt started in earnest. Spirits were high and there was a frantic discussion regarding what would be our first point of call when we reached Hua Hin. Suggestions varied from hitting the pool, to relaxing in the spa, my idea of getting a cold beer was widely accepted.

If you look at a map the journey from Pattaya to Hua Hin is a sort of horseshoe, from Pattaya you travel north via Chonburi, circle around Bangkok, then start heading south through Samut Songkhram, passing Phetchaburi and then on to Hua Hin, it looks perfectly simple unless you have me as navigator. I had made one colossal mistake, I had programmed the shortest route in Google maps and not the quickest. The mood in the car soon changed when all of a sudden we were in the middle of one of Bangkok's infamous traffic jams! If the idea of our weekend jaunt is tempting to any of our readers my advice is to stay on the Bangkok toll roads. It is well worth the 200 baht or so to circle the capital on the fast ring roads, do not be tempted under any circumstances to try the shortcuts.

It took just as long for us to get through the frustrating traffic in Bangkok than it had to reach the capital. My three travel companions were not amused and there was no conversation in the car whatsoever, I had been sent to whatever the Thai equivalent of Coventry is. However we were finally clear of traffic and on Highway 4 heading south, the journey was becoming more and more pleasant partly due to my companions talking to me again. The route takes you near the Tanintharyi National Park on the right with the Gulf of Thailand to the left. Great rock formations loomed in front, covered in luscious vegetation and the countryside all around was green and verdant. The small towns we passed were busy with Saturday life, and it was all a far cry from crowded Bangkok and Pattaya.

I had been to Hua Hin once before a few years ago and was amazed how clean everything was, you could almost eat your lunch off the pavement. And this time around nothing had changed, as you pass the Royal Palace and the large five star resorts there is a feeling of opulence and that somebody actually cares about the place. Glimpses of the ocean appeared

through chinks between buildings as we turned off the main highway into Hua Hin itself and I smiled to myself as I saw that my companions in the car were all getting as excited as me in anticipation of what was to come.

Following the directions being narrated by the robotic Miss or Mrs Google we pulled into the sweeping driveway of the Hua Hin Hilton Resort & Spa and a man in a starched white suite and cap came running out blasting on his whistle to welcome our arrival. We had made it, and surprisingly with all our hiccups it was still only just after 3pm and a whole weekend of fun and frolics ahead to look forward to.


Vampyr (Win, PS4, XB0)





Do you need glasses?

n Sukhumvit Road in Bangkok, there used to be a rather classy restaurant where they gave you an enormous wine glass if you ordered anything grander than the house plonk. Honestly, they were absolutely massive and could have made a desirable residence for a small goldfish. They were extremely heavy too and I was always scared of dropping one of the wretched things and causing an unseemly commotion.

At a push, you could drink wine out of a plastic mug but you'd lose most of the aroma. Wine invariably tastes best out of a well-designed glass. Shape, comfort, size and transparency are the four main issues. Price too, so don't buy glasses that you can't afford to break, for break they will sooner or later. For table wine, a tulip-shaped glass is best, because it concentrates the aroma near the rim. It should be well-balanced, with a long thin stem which is comfortable to hold. And incidentally, we always hold glasses by the stem, not by the bowl. This prevents the wine from warming up too quickly. Go for clear, plain glasses because those frosted or opaque things are useless.

Now I happen to like big ones - and you can take that foolish smirk off your face, that boy in the back row. Never buy tiny wine glasses. "Neither use nor ornament," as one of my Yorkshire friends liked to say. You need to swirl the wine around in the glass to release the aroma. A big glass enables you to accomplish this without spilling the contents all over the table or worse, over yourself (and you might detect the voice of experience here). A capacity of 380-425ml is ideal for good wine because the glass should only filled a third full anyway. If you tend to drink table wines and nothing else, this type of glass will be fine for everything. For sparkling wine, the so-called champagne flute is ideal because it's tall and thin. Forget that horrid traditional champagne glass that looks like a saucer on a stick. It's completely useless for wine, especially sparkling wine.

The Thai-made Ocean range of glasses are excellent value and easily available. Their 425ml Madison Red Wine Glass is a large and elegant and I always use these for wine tasting. For ordinary cheap stuff the inexpensive Ocean Classic Red Wine glass is fine, with a capacity of 230ml. If money is no object and you drink expensive wines, you might prefer the Austrian Riedel glasses. In contrast, here are relatively inexpensive wines (by today's standards) from Australia's Eden Valley wine district.



Bandicoot Estate Premium White, Australia (c. Bt. 650 @ various outlets)

In case you'd forgotten or possibly never knew, a bandicoot is a small rat-like nocturnal marsupial, covered in grayish-brown fur with a pointed nose and a long tail. From a distance it looks like a rabbit, except perhaps to another bandicoot. This wine is a lovely, bright gold with an aroma that gives the impression that the wine is rather more expensive than it actually is. The wine is made from Chardonnay, the most popular of all white grapes. Chardonnay can produce a wide range of aromas and sometimes there are distinct notes of green apples, celery or even cucumber. In this wine, tropical fruit dominates with nectarine, apricot and lemon up front. In the background there's an elusive hint of peppery lime. This is a light dry wine, not as dry as the proverbial bone but dry nonetheless. It

has an attractive fresh, fruity taste with pleasing tang of acidity, which helps to give it a bit of shape and also adds another dimension to the taste. At 13.5% ABV this is a terrific little wine and tremendous value for money. It would make a splendid aperitif but would also make a good partner for light chicken or fish dishes.

Bandicoot Estate Premium Red, Australia (c. Bt. 650 @ various outlets)

This rich, dark red wine looks inviting. Get your snout into the glass (assuming that the glass is big enough) and you'll pick up a sweet jammy aroma of black fruit. The wine is made primarily from Shiraz, or Syrah as it's known in France. You might notice a background, dryer aroma too. I have to admit that I was expecting a hefty, beefy wine but to their credit, the winemakers have taken a more reserved approach. At 13.5% ABV there's plenty of dark fruit on the palate and just a mild touch of tannin to give a sense of firmness. As you'd expect, it's dry but the generous fruit helps to balance it out. The "finish" is the word used to describe the experience during the time the flavour lingers in the mouth after swallowing. Assuming the flavour is pleasing and satisfying; a long finish is generally considered a good thing and this wine has just that, which is unusual for a wine with this price tag. I've been reliably informed that it's one the house wines at the Hilton, so that should say enough. As to food, Shiraz is fairly versatile but it's the traditional partner for beef dishes. I tried it with one of my home-made spicy pizzas and it the combination worked perfectly.

You can try these excellent wines by bottle or glass (about Bt 120) at many Pattaya restaurants including Aroi Pub & Restaurant (Soi Talman), La Scala (Soi Rompho), Little Italy (Second Road) Grottino and Fusillo Restaurants (Naklua Rd) and Amber Restaurant (just off Thepprasit Soi 8). I'd certainly recommend giving these pleasant wines a try, assuming that you haven't spent all your money on wine glasses.







Since the last time we visited Fire and Stone there have been some changes and improvements. For example the addition of a smoothie/cocktail bar for those wishing to get some refreshment whilst waiting to pick up their pizza. The hatch direct from the kitchen to the outside street means that diners are not bothered by messenger bikes picking up deliveries and for customers waiting to collect their own pizzas they can now try out one of the fresh fruit smoothies or fabulous cocktails - but more of those later!

We were eating inside and availing ourselves of the very friendly and efficient service. First up the vegetable spring rolls with sweet plum sauce - piping hot so be careful with that first bite! Then some Antipasti a selection of Italian cold cuts and cheeses - great for sharing.

The signature Fire and Stone Pizza was accompanied by the signature salad The Insalata Fire and Stone had plenty of spicy, grilled chicken on top of the crunchy green salad with a delightful addition of truffle oil and the Fire and Stone pizza I was informed has this artistic design to represent the fire coming out of the stone and we added chilli oil to taste.

So what about those cocktails I hear you cry? Well the frozen cocktails start from only 140 baht and were lovingly prepared by our two waitresses. Of the ten to choose from we opted for Passion Fruit Margarita and the Frozen Mexican "Hot" Chocolate that was an enticing blend of tequila, chocolate liquor, chocolate syrup and chocolate chips. These were so completely delicious that we thought stopping by just for a cocktail any time of the evening would be a good idea - or before the watershed for a fresh fruit smoothie that start at only 50 baht.

DINING IN DETAIL - L'AUBERGE

So to see the pretty layout at L'Auberge was a great first impression quickly followed by a second great impression in the form of a sumptuous selection of produce laid out for their Sunday French cheese and cold cuts Buffet. If you want to be reassured about the quality of the food you are about to sample just go and cast your eyes over the display presented by the restaurant's owner Renault.

Although born in the Alsace region of France Renault has really been a world traveller throughout his life spending time in Switzerland Morocco Tunisia even Las Vegas in the USA working at a hotel there for six months before joining us here in Pattaya. He explained that many customers come to him to try his fantastic Couscous because it is so authentic and this of course he puts down to his time spent in Morocco where he learnt to make it properly. Also his attention to detail and passion for food is clear to see. When he prepares Beef Bourguignon for example, he imports the beef and the lamb he uses is La Belle Rouge direct from France. So the quality of the produce is sure to be seen and 3 course set meal looks incredibly interesting - but we were here on a Sunday and our mission was to eat cheese!

What is it about cheese? I have always preferred a cheeseboard at the end of the meal in preference to dessert but since coming to Pattaya have found that its scarcity and expense generally means cheese has become even more desirable. L'Auberge certainly had a marvellous selection accompanied by a delicious crisp crunchy salad, Tapenade Olive and fresh French bread. The cold cuts included salami Parma ham, Mortadella, there were wonderfully crunchy little pickle gherkins and cheese aplenty.

Renault is on hand to explain and introduce the different varieties. He told me that he likes to have the classics: Camembert, Brie etc. but each week introduces new cheeses because of course he has loyal fans of his Sunday buffet who will come to sample the new varieties such as Pecorino, Camembert with truffles, Blue Goats cheese, 18 month matured Parmesan, French Blue etc. etc.



French music completes the atmosphere, everything is spotlessly clean. There's even a helping of "Trou Normand" in this instance lemon sherbet with a delightful addition of a little vodka used to cleanse the pallet so that you can go ahead and eat more L'Auberge on Pratumnak Hill corner of Soi 4 is a great little restaurant to try any evening but especially on Sunday. 



Panwa Boonak crowned 2018 Thailand Optimist National Championship

Champion for two consecutive years, a feat achieved only by a handful of others

PRESENTED BY OCEAN MARINA

One-hundred-and-thirty-one Optimist dinghies competed at the 2018 Top of the Gulf Regatta in Pattaya, all vying for top honours in the Thailand Optimist National Championships, and the three-day competition was fierce, with reigning champion Panwa Boonak (THA) looking to hold off strong challenges from fellow Thai juniors and many of the best young sailors from around Asia.

Thailand's premier youth sailing event, the Thailand Optimist National Championships was first launched in 1976 as the Optimist Thailand

Championship Cup, and has been held annually since regularly attracting more than 100 sailors each time. Now, more than 40 years since its first sailing, it remains as competitive as ever and is Thailand's second oldest annual sailing trophy, the oldest being the Vega Rudder Trophy donated by His Majesty the late King Bhumibol Adulyadej.

The Thailand Optimist National Championships is held as an integral part of the Top of the Gulf Regatta, organised by the Junior Sailing Squadron of Thailand and the Yacht Racing Association of Thailand, and in Thailand is often a gauge of a young sailors prowess and a qualifying event for a regional games.

Having been split into two fleets prior to the first race this year, defending champion Panwa Boonak was in the Gold Fleet and was determined to be one of only a handful of juniors to ever defend the title. A fourth in the first race was a solid start, and he built on that with a first in the second race.



Squalls upto 25 knots and thunder and lightening, while periods when the fleet was becalmed, made the three-day event exceptionally challenging and only one race was completed on Day 2. In that race Panwa managed to secure a bullet and set himself up well for a final day showdown.

Hong Kong's Duncan Gregor had a strong start to the series snd sat in second place at the end of the first day, but a string of below par performances thereafter saw him to drop and finish fifth overall, one place above another Hong Kong sailor, Casey Law.

As the conditions continued to be tricky, local experience came to the fore and M.L Weka Bhanubandh worked his way up the fleet. A second in Race 3 and third in Race 4 helped him to finish in second place overall and be crowned the top Under 12 sailor. Other fast finishers included Patihan Vorrasart (THA) who placed third overall and Chalisa Krittanai who was one place back in fourth and the top female sailor.



The three days, however, belonged to Panwa Boonak. Never flinching under the pressure a 4,1,1,1,1 scoreline saw him defend his title comfortably and be crowned 2018 Thailand Optimist National Champion at the final prize-giving held at Ocean Marina Yacht Club.

In the Silver Fleet the top three places went to Yoth Srimanchanda (THA), Attasuk Boontawee (THA) and Kritphet Suwannarai (THA), respectively.

Out and About is more than just "Hua Hin"



There is no need to convince the millions and avid outdoors men and women, who get excited by reeling in a 30-pound catfish in Thailand or seeing a beautiful brown trout rise to a fly on the Blackwater Co Cork, why they need to start making plans to head outside. But if for some reason, you need a little convincing, I have compiled a list of 10 good examples that might just offer you an excuse to call in sick to work or leave/take the ones you care about, for another weekend ...so you too can spend a day fishing.

1. Contribute to Conservation: Anglers put their money where their mouth is and are passionate about the environment. By purchasing fishing licenses (Not an issue in Thailand) and paying special taxes that they themselves have agreed upon anglers have helped to fund many of the wildlife and conservation programs that exist in Europe and beyond. They also contribute to non-game and education programs,

and to the purchase of thousands of acres of public lands, where everyone is welcome to recreate year round. Anglers are also acutely aware of the importance of clean water and air and pride themselves on protecting and preserving our environment, natural communities, and valuable habitat.

- **2. Stress Relief:** Ask most anglers why they enjoy spending time in the outdoors and you're likely to hear the word "freedom." For decades, folks in both Pattaya and Hua Hin have looked across the Gulf of Thailand and wished they could leap to the other side, Superman-style, in a single bound.

The straight-line distance between the two resort cities is just over one hundred kilometres but by land it's a grinding, 350km drive via the grand snarl auto of Bangkok and Co, which takes up to five hours. The two towns were like lovers stuck on opposite sides of a river with no way to get across. And now they can. A new, direct ferry service across the Gulf that launched in January 2017 has not only survived but thrived.

The Royal ferry is a sleek, high-speed catamaran that edges out of Pattaya's Bali Hai Pier at ten o'clock on the dot each morning to then scoot across the Gulf. Two hours later it docks just south of Hua Hin at Khao Takiap, and later departs for Pattaya at one pm.

Hua Hin is the most popular tourist destination in Prachuap Khiri Khan province. Being home to a royal holiday palace, it has retained the sense of decorum that Pattaya never really bothered about. Instead of barhoppers and jet-skis, you're more likely to find golfers (and then more golfers), with this region being home to ten world-class courses. The town's long, shallow beaches are generally free of deckchair slums and banzai speedboats, and come evening, you can max-out on eating and shopping at night markets. The most authentic one is still the original, midtown melee on Soi 72. But, you might protest, Pattaya has the same tourist trinket-trash markets, plus golf courses galore and beaches, so why pay the ferryman to go see same-same? Because, having briefly box-ticked Hua Hin's options, you then get to run yourself out of town on a rail. Head to Hua Hin's historic railway station and hop a train south to the real Prachuap, a land of plenty minus the resort sprawl and shout-fest tour groups.

Like it's full name, Prachuap is a long and lyrical sort of province. Exploring its beaches that loop from headland to headland you find sea pines and fishing boats instead of hawkers and high-rise. Take Baan Grood for instance, 100 km south of Hua Hin.This snoozy seaside town — more like a large village — is also known as Ban Krood, Ban Good, Ban-Kood, Bangrut and other variations. (My preferred version, as used on the railway timetable, is Ban Krut, meaning "bankrupt" in Indonesian.) You'll see few farang here except for a handful of defrosting Scandinavians who pass the day in leisurely cycling or beach basking like bronzed whales.













Rolf, a Norwegian longtime retired in Thailand, tells me he has retreated here to escape the intensity of once-tranquil Hua Hin where he first settled. "And the temperature here today is 30 degrees Celsius while it's ten below in Oslo, so I am 40 degrees better off."

An endless beach stretches south from Baan Grood with low-rise bungalow resorts lining its parallel seafront road. Cycling the grand corridor of palms and sea pines that shade the beach for miles is my morning heart-starter. I stop anywhere and swim in the windless sea, and then cruise back to the resort for breakfast.

It might be an Accor-free coast but this "sunny side of the Gulf" (as it is known) is in fact a favourite of in-the-know Thai families. Thus the numerous bungalow resorts. The absence of a convenient local airport is a contributing "plus" to the tranquility of life here — a place in the sun that you have to earn.

So, what's there to do in Baan Grood? Visit a temple, swim, sun-bake, read, grab a massage and dine at the little thatched restaurants along the sand. Cycle and repeat cycle. Like visiting Casablanca for the waters, if you're here for the neon stars and jangle bars, you've been misinformed.

Another 65 km further south down the line, just off Bang Saphan Noi, sits equally-unsung Koh Talu. The hilly, jungle-clad island is privately owned although a large part is slated to become national park. The sole resort has comfortable, Thai-style bungalows overlooking the white sand arc of Big Bay and the smaller, absurdly pretty Pearl Bay. Meals at its restaurant happen languidly to the sound of waves lapping beneath the wooden deck.

A list of might-do's (as opposed to must-do's) on this the 1500-ha, whale-shaped island includes snorkel, bushwalk, read, kayak, snooze, email. Again, repeat cycle. For variety I check out the hawksbill turtle hatchery along the beach, try squid fishing at sunset and join in with the resort's coral reef replenishment project. And then I must ask, "Do I really have to leave tomorrow?"I console myself with a farewell massage at dusk. The masseuse interrupts her vigorous pummelling (well, I asked for it) to say, "Look. Batman over the beach." Huh? I think — we're ten kilometres offshore on a superhero-free coast. "Batman?" I ask.

"Yes, Batmans, many small ones. See," she insists.

I look up to see a dark, shadowy wave rising above the island ridge. It is the nightly exodus from Koh Talu's caves of hundreds of thousands of bats — batmans — going out I suppose to party all night and fight crime?

Getting there

Obtaining a Work Permit

foreigner can apply for a work permit if he holds a nonimmigrant visa or resident visa and his chosen occupation is not prohibited to foreigners. Also if he has an employer who can provide pertinent documents and be able to meet the cap of paid-up capitalization. If you are a foreigner who intentions to work in Thailand, you have to make sure that your intended job and skills do not belong to the categories generally closed for Thai nationals only.

Steps to securing a Work Permit

Step 1: Securing a Non-Immigrant Visa

To be granted with a non-immigrant visa, you are required to present the following:

- An offer of employment from a Thai company. If you are offered a job in the Kingdom, you ought to present the invitation and or recommendation letter of your would be employers in Thailand. Or you may be planning to start a company to employ yourself.
- A request from the company that you be given a non-immigrant visa that will allow the company to apply for a work permit
- The company can attest that you are dependable, upstanding, law abiding and guarantees that you will respect the laws and customs of the nation.

Also, you must apply for a nonimmigrant visa at least 30 days prior to departure for Thailand. The consulate or consular office will ask for copies of the registration documents and financial statements of the company. These documents should be issued by the company.



If granted, you are allowed to have a temporary stay in Thailand for a period of 90 days only.

Step 2: Obtaining the Work Permit

The following are the documents that you must present:

- 1. Passport copies with every page signed by you
- 2. Non-immigrant visa card
- 3. Departure Card TM. 6
- 4. Scholastic records (certified copies)
- 5. Transcript of Records (certified copies)
- 6. Certificates or licenses of the applicant (certified copies)
- 7. Curriculum Vitae or Resume that has detailed description of your previous employment, position, duties, performance and length and place of employment.
- 8. 3 recent photos (within 6 months of application) 5×6 centimeters in size, full face and wearing business attire.
- 9. Marriage certificate if you are married to a Thai national (certified and original copies). Must also include your Thai spouse's ID card, birth certificates of children (if any) and household registration.

The Thai government may require you to have these documents to be certified by your country's embassy. Also, a translation from the foreign language to the Thai language may be required.

Documents that the employer provides:

- 1. Commercial Registration Department Certificate that shows the company to be duly registered as a juristic entity and bearing the name of the Managing Director and/or Director, its objectives and registered capital.
- 2. A Commercial Registration Department certified Shareholder's List.
- 3. A Factory Department, Ministry of Industry issued Factory License (if required).
- 4. VAT Certificate Phor Phor 20
- 5. Withholding Tax Phor Ngor Dor 1 (if renewing the work permit)

All these documents should have a seal of the company stamped on every page, true and authorized signature(s) of the Managing Director and/or Directors next to the seal. These will be required by the government officials who will examine the application.

The approval of the work permit does not rely heavily on the documents to be submitted alone. The deciding factor is usually the job description. Your job description must contain a detailed description of the required skills of your line of work, skills that Thai nationals are not likely to have.



You and your employer must justify why the Thai government must give you a working visa. Once your application for a work 🐯 permit is approved, you will be allowed to work in the same company and location. If you transfer to another employer or location, you need to obtain a new application for work permit. You are not allowed to work in a different job from the one you were given a work permit for. You are also not allowed to work with a different employer from the one stated in your application. This will require you to return your work permit to the Labor Department. You have to do so in order for you apply for another work permit with another company.

Step 3: The Tax ID card

When your work permit is being processed, your company is supposed to apply a Thai taxpayer identification card for you at 🗸 the Thailand Revenue Department. On that card is a Tax ID number that you will use in filling up tax documents.

Step 4: Obtaining the Re-entry Permit

- Visa is issued outside of Thailand by a Thai embassy or consulate. This gives you access to enter the country. Once in the Kingdom, an immigration officer will stamp a date on your passport called "extension of stay."
- Extension of Stay is the time period in which you are allowed to stay in Thailand. This is stamped by the immigration officer at the border checkpoint upon arrival or by the immigration police after a request for extension of stay.

Misunderstanding the difference between the extension of stay and the re-entry permit may lead to certain consequences.

The extension of stay stamp is the controlling date. Meaning, your length of stay is dependent on the said date. Your work permit and re-entry permit is dependent on the extension of stay date. However, if you leave Thailand without a re-entry permit, both your extension of stay and work permit will be cancelled.

Step 5: Renewing Your Visa and Work Permit

You have to renew your length of stay in Thailand first before you can renew your work permit. You may do this while still in Thailand or you may do it abroad and apply at the Thai Embassy or Consulate in another country.

If you are required to exit Thailand first before you can renew your work permit, you will need to furnish the Thai Embassy or Consulate with copies of your work permit, a new recommendation letter from your company, the company's registration documents, financial and tax reports.

If you have a long term extension of stay, you are required to report to the Thai immigration Police every 90 days. For multiple visa holders, they can simply cross border to another country and come back to Thailand to renew their extension of stay.



Divorce in Thailand

ot all marriages are meant to last. If you and your partner are currently on the verge of ending your relationship through divorce, it is necessary to contemplate on your possible divorce options because everybody knows that breaking up is never simple especially if you have finances and children that you need to consider. In Thailand, divorce is classified into 2 types:

UNCONTESTED DIVORCE

Uncontested divorce is the termination of marriage by mutual consent. The procedure is typically faster and cheaper as there is no need for a representation in court while preserving both parties' privacy. There is less emotional stress involved to both parties, as well as to their children and respective families as it enables the couple to end their marriage in a civilized manner.

Uncontested divorce is possible only if the couple has no disagreements over children or property. There is no need to have a ground for divorce. The couple's mutual decision to end the marriage is enough. A settlement or divorce agreement should contain provisions regarding the terms of sharing of assets, child custody and support, alimony, and other important matters. In the absence of such agreement, the matter shall be decided by the Court. It is recommended that you decide these matters beforehand and formalize them in a divorce contract. This will guarantee that there are no disagreements before you go to the registrar's office. The details of the divorce conditions shall be specified in the divorce registration.

CONTESTED DIVORCE

Contested divorce is when either spouse does not agree with the terms of the separation or has broken the marriage agreement.

This type of divorce allows one party to seek the court's help in dissolving the marriage subject to the existence of one of the grounds prescribed under Thai law.

GROUNDS FOR DIVORCE

- -One spouse has committed adultery
- -One spouse is guilty of misconduct
- -One spouse has seriously harmed or tortured the body or mind of the other
- -One spouse has deserted the other for more than 1 year
- -One spouse has been imprisoned for more than 1 year
- -The spouses have voluntarily lived separately for more than 3 years
- -One spouse has disappeared for more than 3 years
- -One spouse has failed to give proper maintenance and support to the other
- -One spouse has been an insane person for more than 3 years continuously and such insanity is hardly curable so that the continuance of marriage cannot be expected
- -One spouse has broken a bond of good behaviour

BOSS OF THE HOUSEHOLD BUDGET.

Consider this a promotion. From now on, you are more than a humble household money manager a bill payer and a check writer. Instead, you are the chief financial officer of your household. You're the CFO of your finances, the C-suite executive of your personal capital. No corner office is required,

Your new role as household CFO will require some financial skills and a long view of your family's finances, experts say. "The CFO is the driver, the one who has concerns about the long term," says Kelly Graves, a certified financial planner and partner at Carroll Financial Associates in Charlotte, North Carolina. "That includes looking at estate planning, retirement planning, looking at the investment portfolio, education for children or grandchildren and all types of insurance," Graves adds. If this sounds intimidating, don't despair. The job isn't as difficult as you think it is.says Shashi Shah, a certified financial planner and director at SFMG Wealth Advisors in Plano, Texas.

What is required is the taking of stock of your budget for housing, debt, luxuries and other spending categories, then determining whether you need to reconsider your spending. "If you're in a situation where your cash flow is negative ... just stop the bleeding," says Eric Dossal, certified financial planner and advisor-vice president at Sontag Advisory in New York City. "Restructure the debt to where you get on a payment [plan] where you're cashflow positive." Don't forget to automate any savings, debt payments and other important bills, experts say.

Have a long-term plan. An effective CFO looks beyond day-to-day spending to achieve long-term financial goals. As household CFO, you should strive to do the same thing. "Put short-term finances in a long-term picture," says Lili Vasileff, a Greenwich, Connecticut-based fee-only certified financial planner and author of "Money & Divorce: The Essential Roadmap to Mastering Financial Decisions." Vasileff, who routinely works with women going through the divorce process, says her clients often see themselves as the bill payers and the budget makers, but they haven't felt empowered to look beyond short-term planning. Taking that long-term view, which includes everything from retirement planning to building an emergency fund, is what makes a good household CFO, she says. "The game plan is what counts," Vasileff says.

Know how to delegate. Successful CFOs know that there may be people who are better suited for a specific task than they are. If you're struggling with an element of your financial plan, don't be afraid to outsource the assignment. That might mean delegating tax-planning steps to a CPA or enrolled agent, which is a tax professional who can represent clients before the IRS. It could also involve visiting a financial advisor or investment advisor to come up with plans to control cash flow, investment decisions and retirement planning. When clients visit Shah at his firm, "we [often] end up being their CFOs for them," he says.

Knowing when to delegate may even mean transferring certain responsibilities to your spouse as co-CFO in order to manage your finances together. "A CFO does not work in a vacuum," Shah says. "Usually, [he or she] has a team."

Schedule a board meeting. Talking about money isn't fun, but top-rate CFOs don't hide from hard conversations. Instead, they schedule regular meetings with their peers and underlings to ensure that everyone is up-todate on the latest financial developments and money goals. When you have family discussions, treat them like a board meeting, Dostal says. You might schedule them quarterly or biannually - they don't have to be every month - but you should set time aside, outside of regular dinner conversation, to talk about your shared finances. In fact, this might be a conversation you plan to have in front of your financial advisor. And you should come prepared with printouts or at least an understanding of where you stand when it comes to saving, retirement planning, insurance needs and other financial essentials.

Award bonuses. Being household CFO is a tough job, but there are some perks, too. One benefit is that you can treat yourself when you do something right. "Set up a 'reward' or 'bonus program' if you've succeeded at your goals,"



Pattaya police to get tough on tourist vehicle rentals.

From now on Pattaya police have said that any tourist caught driving a rental vehicle without a licence will be fined up to 1000 baht. Also that the vehicle in question will be confiscated and the company that has rented said vehicle must pay another fine of up to 2000 baht when they go to collect it.

Police Major Arut Saphanon said that the reason for the change is because many tourists don't know the highway code and have not had any training which leads to accidents. Also that foreigners who commit crimes in Pattaya have been seen fleeing the scene of the crime in rented vehicles.

Tourists now need to produce an international licence, their home country driving licence and a passport when renting. They also need to carry these document to show the police if stopped - failure to do so will result in the vehicle being taken away. Expats can take their home country licence and a certified copy from their consulate or embassy in Thailand to the Department of Land Transport and get a Thai licence.
