

As the country prepares to downgrade the Covid-19 pandemic to endemic disease, Thailand is gearing up for a return to normality and is hoping to boost economic recovery by further easing travel restrictions.

Starting April 1, 2022 travellers may enter the country without the need to show proof of a pre-arrival negative RT-PCR test within 72 hours of travel.

- Travellers who wish to visit the land of smiles may enter the country with or without quarantine depending on vaccination status and country of departure. Below are the updated simplified schemes:
- Test and Go: No Quarantine – fully vaccinated travellers arriving by air from any country will be able to enter the country with no quarantine requirements. Travellers only need to undergo RT-PCR test (Day 0) when they arrive at their SHA+ or ASQ hotels and get a negative result. After getting a negative test result, travellers are allowed to travel to other parts of the country. A self-test Antigen Test Kit will be performed on the 5th Day and report your test result on the Mor Chana mobile app
- Sandbox Program: Will be reduced to 5 nights from currently 7 nights. After completing five nights within the Sandbox destinations (Pattaya, Phuket, Khao Lak, Krabi, Samui, Koh Phang Ngan, or Koh Tao) travellers will be allowed to travel domestically within the country
- Alternative Quarantine Program: For partially vaccinated or unvaccinated travellers, quarantine will be reduced to 5 nights from currently 10 nights in a designated quarantine hotel in Bangkok, Samut Prakan, Pattaya, Phuket, or Samui before they can travel to other parts of the country. Travellers need to undergo an RT-PCR test on Day 4-5

The information above was correct at time of going to press. However, we as much as our readers will I'm sure, be hoping for a further easing of restrictions. This is needed in order for Thailand to take a more competitive stance when vying for the tourist market against the likes of Indonesia, the Philippines, Vietnam, Cambodia and Malaysia. All have taken bold steps to scrap restrictions as they seek to rebuild their travel sectors





Want to get away from Songkran Mayhem? - Koh to an Island!



Thailand has many islands or Koh. Koh Larn and Koh Samet are amongst Pattaya's closest and most popular resort islands but Koh Si Chang is hardly on the radar. A weekend escape for Bangkokians, it is a small picturesque island with a relaxed atmosphere, clear waters, colourful houses and a slow pace of life. The island can be reached by ferry from Si Racha in about 45 minutes.

Then just north of Bangkok Koh Kret can be discovered in a kink in the Chao Phraya River. This island of villages, potteries and concrete pathways was created in 1722 by digging a channel across an ox-bow bend in the river. Koh Kret is famous for the terracotta and earthenware pottery made by its ethnic Mon inhabitants. To get there catch the Chao Phraya Express boat from Sap han Taksin pier to Pak Kret, Nonthaburi, and then the ferry from Wat Sanam Neua.



From the waters east of Phuket, there are a hundred ancient limestone islands looking just like sleeping mammoths. Local myths tell of them as being a herd of elephants that were trapped by the incoming tide. They comprise the Phang Nga Bay Marine Park and include gems like the donut-shaped Koh Hong "room island" that is best explored, inside and out, via a sea kayaking expedition. Further north is Koh Phing Kan aka "James Bond Island" which, owes its fame to having been one of the locations used in the 1974 Bond movie "The Man with the Golden Gun".

Still in Phang Nga Bay but further south, past Koh Lanta you will come to Koh Muk, deep in Hat Chao Marine Park. Here you can swim into Tham Morakot, "the Emerald Cave," where a winding, dark, 50-metre tunnel opens out into an interior grotto whose roof has collapsed, leaving a ceiling of sky above a sunlit beach.

Phang Nga's last offering is Koh Rok Nok where you can go ashore on an untouched beach to find a banyan tree bedecked with ribbons, spirit altars and dozens of wooden carvings forming a local fertility shrine. Snorkeling here happens amid not just schools but veritable "clouds" of fish.



Koh Laoliang, just off the Andaman Coast boasts a gorgeous beach with longtail boats and shacks selling fruit shakes and fried rice. A small island in Koh Petra Marine Park it sits 20 km off the Trang shore. Of course snorkelling is also popular here but also rock climbing, and kayaking. Koh Tachai, also on the Andaman Coast, north of the Similan Islands and south of the Surins is a low-key, day trip island which can be reached in about 1 hour by speedboat from Khao Lak.

While you're in the area you should also check out Koh Phra Thong about 10 km off the port of Khuraburi. In the middle in a group of three islands, Phra Thong is flat, with long empty beaches fringed by palms and the closest island to the famous Richelieu Rock dive site.



WHAT IS HYPERHIDROSIS?

Hyperhidrosis disorder is a condition that results in excessive sweating. This sweating can occur in unusual situations, such as in cooler weather, or without any trigger at all. It can also be caused by other medical conditions, such as menopause or hyperthyroidism. Hyperhidrosis can be uncomfortable. However, several treatment options can provide some relief.

Sweating is a natural response to certain conditions, such as warm weather, physical activity, stress, and feelings of fear or anger. With hyperhidrosis, you sweat more than usual for no apparent reason. The underlying cause depends on which type of hyperhidrosis you have.



Primary focal hyperhidrosis

Sweating mainly occurs on your feet, hands, face, head, and underarms. It usually starts in childhood. About 30 to 50 per cent of people with this type have a family history of excessive sweating.

Secondary generalized hyperhidrosis

Secondary generalized hyperhidrosis is sweating caused by a medical condition or as a side effect of certain medications. It generally starts in adulthood. With this type, you might sweat all over your body, or in just one area. You might also sweat while you're sleeping. Conditions that can cause this type include: heart disease, menopause, cancer, adrenal gland disorders,

Several types of prescription and over-the-counter medications can cause hyperhidrosis as well. In many cases, sweating is a rare side effect that most people don't experience. However, excessive sweating is a common side effect of antidepressants such as:

desipramine (Norpramin) and nortriptyline (Pamelor). People who take pilocarpine for dry mouth or zinc as a mineral dietary supplement can also experience excessive sweating.

Symptoms

Symptoms of excessive sweating can include excessive sweating that's occurred for at least six months without an apparent reason.

Sweat that occurs on both sides of your body in roughly the same amount. Sweating that interferes with your daily activities (such as work or relationships). A family history of hyperhidrosis

These factors might indicate that you have primary focal hyperhidrosis.

Sweating all over or excessively in one area might indicate that you have secondary generalized hyperhidrosis. It's important to see your doctor to find out the underlying cause. You should also call your doctor if you experience sweating and weight loss, sweating that mainly occurs while you sleep, sweating and chest pain, or a feeling of pressure in the chest

Your doctor will ask questions about your sweating and perform certain tests, such as blood and urine tests, to determine if you have hyperhidrosis. Sometimes a starch-iodine test may be used that involves putting iodine on the sweaty area. Starch is sprinkled on this area when the iodine dries. If the starch turns dark blue, you have excess sweating.

Treatment

There are several treatment options for excessive sweating. Your doctor might prescribe an antiperspirant containing aluminium chloride which is stronger than those available over the counter. Or anticholinergic drugs such as glycopyrrolate (Robinul), prevent acetylcholine (a chemical your body produces that helps stimulate your sweat glands) from working. Or Botox injections may be used to treat severe hyperhidrosis. They block the nerves that stimulate your sweat glands.

Primary focal hyperhidrosis is a treatable condition. Your doctor will help you develop a treatment plan so you can manage your symptoms. However, treatments for secondary generalized hyperhidrosis depend on the underlying condition causing your sweating that is why it is always good to talk to your doctor.



One idea I particularly liked was how the smaller canapes were served inside paper cupcake cases on the larger trays making picking up of these convenient and very easy. All in all the food at Poseidon provided excellent "soakage" for the wine pairing and I for one will certainly be returning soon as their Fondue Bourguignon (min 2 people and 1-day pre-order) sounds amazing.

So what about the wines on offer? Well two standouts from the selection for me were the Conte Fosco Cuvee Brut -95% Trebbiano, 3% Moscato Bianco 2% other white grape varieties. Just the right level of fruitiness and dryness and unbelievably great value at only 439 baht a bottle.

Then the Primitivo di Manduria a richly rewarding red which my Italian relatives would most certainly refer to as "Robusto". This smooth, full-bodied wine paired excellently with the meat canapes from Poseidon.

INSPIRED BY AMARA

"Water gives me energy I have always lived by water"

This is one of the many quotes I remember from my talk with the fascinating Amara. Born in Ayutthaya to a large family of 16 children (although 5 did not survive) they lived by the river. Then after her father tragically died of TB when Amara was just 10 years old, she moved a couple of years later when 13 years old to Pattaya to join her sister and brother and find a better life. As soon as she saw the sea she knew it was the place for her!

Despite having had only 7 years in full-time education her father who had been a teacher, instilled in Amara an amazing work ethic. Another source of inspiration was King Rama 9. When Amara found out he was going to be making an official visit 18 km from her home, at just 10 years old she made the bus journey all by herself in order to meet him.

Amara was making food wrappers from old newspapers she collected from a nearby GI camp area. Selling 100 bags for 1.5THB to finance her school bill. Ironically she is now helping school kids to collect and repurpose trash into objects to help finance their schools.

"I was only 15 and it was the happiest time of my life"

Her brother found work at a beach club and started learning how to windsurf also helping Amara learn. She fondly remembers the first time she went out onto the sea and soon joined him working at the surf school, learning to get better and better at windsurfing.



After just 3 months she was good enough to take part in a competition arranged by Cobra who had set up a nearby factory in Chon Buri. She won her first race outright and was totally elated remembering how proud she was to prove to all the boys that she could beat them!

"When you find the thing you love it can change your life"


Cobra recognising Amara's natural talent asked if she would like to travel to Europe to compete in windsurfing competitions. She went and was extremely happy to travel to Germany, Belgium and France. Another year of competing in Europe followed then Israel

where at the age of only 17 she became International Freestyle Champion. It gave her great pleasure to become so successful at the sport she loved and Amara felt she had something to prove not just to herself but for all Thai women. Often whilst travelling she was asked what bar she worked at?! Frustrated by the bad reputation of Thai women abroad she was proud to represent her country to have a strong belief in her own self-worth and ingenuity and to hopefully motivate and inspire others.

"If dirt can make bricks that can then make a house so I too can do anything."

She believes this idea came to her when still young and learning to make bricks. The clay had to be mixed and trodden by foot, then left in wooden moulds in the sun to dry and finally baked in a fire kiln ready for use in building roads or houses. So at only 17 Amara along with her brother and a friend bought 2 Catamarans and 5 Windsurf boards to rent out and start a business.

Although the two boys eventually left, Amara carried on progressing with her teaching by taking courses to become a qualified instructor. In between, there were yet more competitions and more trophies culminating in her being chosen to be part of the Thai Olympic team when she was 29. For her, it was a perfect life, with a mix of competing around the world with sponsorship from the likes of Singha beer then returning to her own company where she could teach and pass her skills on to others.



"I am a Trash Hero"

Today with another couple of instructors working alongside her, Amara can focus on her other passion of taking care of the environment, especially the Ocean! She has already organised successful beach clean-ups with dignitaries such as the ambassador of Norway and not content with merely the collection of tons of plastic, she also helps with its transformation via a small local factory that can make it into useful objects such as plant pots Most of all she loves educating especially the young about the importance of not dumping plastic.

THE MASTERS

The golf tournament that many fans regard as the greatest in the world, The US Masters, takes place this month at the Augusta national Golf Club. Starting on Thursday the 7th and finishing, as tradition dictates, on the 10th, the second Sunday of the month, the event holds a special place in the affections of players and fans alike. This is due largely to the fact that unlike any of the other three major tournaments of the year, it is held at the same venue and has been since its inception in 1934.

The Augusta National Golf Club has an aura and mystique all of its own, as many of the players and spectators who first arrive at the course have attested to. Each hole of the eighteen is named after the tree or flower with which is most closely associated, and names such as Magnolia, White Dogwood and Golden Bell are familiar to golf aficionados around the world.

The idea for both the course and the tournament came from Bobby Jones, the greatest golfer of his day and one of the most influential figures in the history of the sport. First played in 1934, the tournament has grown from an invitation event only into the most popular golfing event of the year and attracts the best players in the world. Thankfully, now that the worst of the pandemic restrictions are over, this year's event will be watched by a capacity crowd, although as always they will be very well behaved, as the committee take a dim view of any unruly behaviour from spectators.

Back in 2019, the year of Tiger's comeback win, the sight of thousands of fans racing up the 18th fairway must have given them some anxious moments!

The tournament has grown at an astonishing rate. When you consider that Arnold Palmer, the man who made such a huge contribution towards making the game what it is today, collected 11,250 US Dollars for his first victory in 1958 and the winners for the last five years have each won around two million, you can see how the event has gained in popularity, especially since Tiger burst onto the scene in 1997.





After numerous trials and tribulations, including career threatening back surgery, Tiger came back to win his 5th Masters by one shot and the scenes afterwards were something that Augusta, and indeed the world of golf, had never witnessed before.

Although still an invitation only tournament, meaning that the field is generally smaller than for the other “Majors”, certain criteria has been laid down to ensure that the cream of the worlds players attend the event.

The current top fifty in the world are invited, both for that particular week and the past calendar year, and a raft of other exemptions are in place to capture the top names in the game. Along with the history and the draw of the venue itself, this always leads to a top quality field.

I am sure that many golf fans on this side of the world will be awake in the early hours of the morning on that weekend to watch the final two rounds of the tournament and find out who will be declared the 2022 Masters champion and don the traditional Green Jacket. I know I certainly will.

Jack Nicklaus, the bridge between Palmer and Woods, also supported the tournament throughout his career, winning a record six times between 1963 and 1986, when at aged 46 he became the oldest winner in the history of the event. This feat was only bettered by Tiger’s win at aged 21 in 1997, making him the youngest winner ever. Of course, that was by a record 12 shots!

The course itself, being old and well established, at least in American terms, has had the same problem as many layouts across the world in that the advancement of technology, in both ball and club, has led to players hitting it much further than they ever have in the past, making the task of setting a major championship test for the players that much more difficult.

Over 500 yards in length has been added since 2000 and the organisers are constantly tinkering with the course to ensure that it continues to represent a stern examination for the players.

Every golf fan will have their own favourite memory of the Masters, mine being Nicklaus’ last win in 1986. For some it will be Tiger’s first win in 1997, but for the large majority it will be his “comeback” win in 2019 that will live longest of all.



SPORTS UPDATE FOR APRIL

April is one of my favourite sporting months of the year. Not only do we have the Masters golf tournament and the Grand National race meeting, on the same weekend mark you! We also have the quarter and semi-finals of the Champions League, plus the World Snooker Championship. The Premier League has a full match-day on each of the five weekends as it speeds towards its conclusion in May and the other Major European leagues are doing the same.

The Masters, featured elsewhere in Discover Pattaya, starts on the 7th of the month and continues through to the final round on Sunday the 10th. Meanwhile the Grand national, the race itself, is run on the Saturday although the meeting starts on the 7th .



Having made dramatic improvements in both the facilities on course and the quality of the racing, Aintree as a whole has transformed itself into one of the premier race meetings of the year. Elsewhere the Formula One season, which got underway in March, continues with two major events, the Australian and Italian legs of the season long championship. In the Premier League, Manchester City and Liverpool have drawn away from the rest in the race for the title and these two play each other on the 10th. It may be too early to call it a title decider but a win for either side will go a long way towards telling us where the trophy will end up this year. Their is a full programme throughout April and a host of fixtures are being played which will have a significant bearing on the European and relegation issues.

The world Snooker championship will be held, as ever, at the Crucible Theatre in Sheffield.

Starting on the 16th of the month, it will go through until the final, which climaxes on Monday the 2nd of May, a bank holiday in the UK and traditionally the last day of the event.

A great TV sport, I'm sure this will be of great interest to the many pool players and Snooker fans we have in the city.

That's about it for now. We have a great month of sport to look forward too. Good luck everyone.

Songkran – great fun

April is the one of the hottest months of the year here in Thailand. A month when all schools are closed, many young boys follow tradition and ordain as Buddhist monks, and millions travel across the country back to their home towns and villages to spend time with their family and celebrate the Thai New Year festival of Songkran. It is also a time when farangs complain more than they usually do, calling for Songkran to be banned, or to revert to the quieter and more sedate traditional Songkran ceremony.

I recently spoke with a well-educated eighty five year old Thai lady and I asked what Songkran was like when she was a young girl? Her reply, ‘exactly the same as today, we spent all day throwing water over everyone.’



Songkran is an important holiday for Thai people, a time for spending time with family and friends, visiting temples and paying respect to elders. But it is also a time for fun, and you don't have to be young to enjoy Songkran. In pre-pandemic days, hundreds of children and students with disabilities would gather at the Father Ray Foundation on the main Songkran day. Everyone would be wearing their brightest and most colourful shirts, water guns in hand and ready for a day of fun.

The morning starts with a traditional ceremony where the children pour scented water over a statue of Lord Buddha, then pay respects to the elders by also pouring water over their hands.

Then everyone was free to make their way to Sukhumvit Road, where huge buckets filled with water are waiting for them, and they would spend all day getting soaked and throwing water over anyone and anything that passes by.

COMMON MISCONCEPTIONS ABOUT PRENUPTIAL AGREEMENTS

With a prenup, each party can specify premarital properties to remain as their respective property throughout the marriage. This real estate development is building a forest in Bangkok

A common complaint is that Bangkok lacks green areas. With space in the city center at a premium and land prices inching upwards, real estate developers opt to maximize usage. While most builders try to find ways to incorporate trees and sometimes small parks into their projects, these can still be rather limiting. One company wanted to change that. Magnolia Quality Development Corporation (MQDC) felt like they could invert that concept by building a forest in Bangkok and then placing a real estate development around it. This idea is what has inspired The Forestias.



It must be stressed that MQDC is building a real forest in Bangkok. This isn't simply some trees or green spaces. Ecologists and conservationists have been hired to help build a living, breathing ecosystem that will be the heartbeat of The Forestias. Flora and fauna have been carefully selected and introduced gradually to ensure a vibrant, healthy forest that grows right alongside the project's residents. Meanwhile, a team of park rangers will be on hand to monitor The Forestias ecosystem as well as provide educational services to the public.

MQDC has set aside 30 rai (4.8 hectares) of forest that will be inaccessible to the public. This decision was made to provide protection to certain plant and animal species that flourish better without human traffic. However, the public can still observe some of these areas via the canopy walk that connects the various parts of the mixed-use estate. This protected area is the hub of the forest which spans to every last corner of The Forestias. In fact, more than half of the entire development has been set aside for it. The project itself covers nearly 400 rai, or 64 hectares. To put this into context, the newly expanded Benchakitti Park is 72 hectares while Lumphini Park is 57 hectares. According to the developer, this is the largest such forest to be built within a metropolitan township project.

Forests will cover more than half of The Forestias and MQDC believes that building a forest in Bangkok can allow people to live a better life. For starters, it cites numerous studies conducted over the years that show a direct correlation between access to green spaces and improved health and wellbeing. There are also the environmental benefits that building a forest in Bangkok should bring. For example, there will be much less pollution in and around The Forestias. Additionally, temperatures inside could be anywhere from two to five degrees Celsius cooler than in other parts of the city.

The developer has been very careful to place the various residential projects around the forest to ensure everyone could enjoy a connection to nature. Every time a person walks out of their front door or building, they will be immersed in the beauty only the environment provides.



The public has taken notice of the work MQDC is doing at The Forestias. The development won Thailand People's Choice Award for Project of the Year at the Dot Property Thailand Awards 2021. Given the firm's unique and bold plans, it was something they took a great deal of pride in winning. "Winning these awards makes us very proud.

"It makes us feel like we are developing The Forestias in the right direction. We don't only want to develop a good project, we want it to be one of the best projects in the world," Khun Kittipun Ouiyamaphun, MQDC Senior Vice President, proclaims. 

Developers expect home prices in Thailand to rise this year

The rising cost of building materials will lead to home prices increasing in Thailand. A labour shortage coupled with rising costs for construction materials will cause home prices in Thailand to increase this year. Developers have been monitoring the situation and are trying to keep these increases to a minimum in order to meet existing demand.

"It will be a challenging year for homebuilders as the demand side is strong, but the supply side or construction costs are worrying. We need to manage costs the best to finish the units at the price we agreed with customers earlier," Phanid Maneerattanaporn, Landy Home Director of Construction and Business Development, told the Bangkok Post.

He noted that a labour shortage continues to be a challenge for many developers with workers from abroad still unable to enter Thailand. This has driven up wages for local employees with homebuilders and construction firms engaging in a bidding war for their services. That is not the only challenge facing the residential real estate sector. The price for construction materials, namely cement and steel, is another cost developers are struggling to cope with in 2022. Supalai is one firm that has already planned for the situation.


"Costs of housing development excluding land costs will likely increase by 3-4 percent this year. When combined with higher labour wages and fuel prices, housing prices will be 2 percent higher," Supalai Chairman Prateep Tangmatitham explained. Supalai will stay active in 2022. The firm intends to launch 34 developments this year, 31 of which will be low-rise housing. Of that total, more than half are set to be located outside of the Thai capital.

Other homebuilders have noted the increase in building costs but haven't yet determined how much of this will be passed on to homebuyers. For instance, Seacon expects construction expenditure to rise by 5-10 percent in 2022. However, the firm has yet to decide how it will adjust home prices.

Despite these problems, many leading Thai developers have announced new project launch plans for 2022. The property market finds itself in an interesting spot as the source of demand and buyers' preferences have changed radically over the past two years. For starters, CBRE noted the Thailand property market is now dominated by end users which is a far cry from just a few years ago when investors were scrambling to purchase condo units. The needs of buyers are increasingly different as well with demand for housing currently driving real estate purchases. These trends are reflected in what developers have planned for their new project launches this year. Many are focused on low-rise housing, although a few are jumping back into the Bangkok condo market.

Gardening in the Tropics

Gardening, whether one loves or hates it, hinges on the colour of one's thumb: Green —for those whose open-air interests extend to the growing of greenery, or Red — for those who prefer their outdoor activities to be limited to lounging poolside. Regardless of which camp you are aligned with, your garden can be managed by a landscape design that's carefully pruned to meet personal likes and lifestyle.

In most cases, outdoor gardens are the last area of the home to receive attention, but by no means should they receive any less consideration than the interior. By carefully selecting shapely shrubbery, strategically plotting the placement of trees, and intelligently factoring in the flow of flowers, footpaths and fountains you can compliment your home's architectural style. Also, a good looking exterior will increase the property's overall value and create an outdoor living space that you actually want to be in.

If you're starting from scratch or doing a complete makeover, the golden rule in terms of creating a successful garden is knowing exactly what you want and precisely what you don't want. This is often more easily accomplished by first determining where you don't want the flowers and plants to be.

Curbappeal is the primary function of the garden. It is responsible for the first impression any visitor will have of your property. As such, it should be inviting, immaculately manicured, well thought out and its design should be compatible with the style of the home. Your garden may also serve as an area for pets, a play space for children or a setting in which you can relax, entertain or grow things. Therefore, swimming pools, barbecues, patios, vegetable gardens, and playgrounds may all feature in the layout.



The key to a low maintenance garden is simplicity and actually planning (ahead of time) for it to be so. Experts claim that piecing a garden design together bit by bit is a sure recipe for disaster.

It also pretty much guarantees that the garden will be more costly, less efficient, and more difficult to sustain. If doing less in the garden is your idea of nirvana, eliminate time-consuming water features like fountains; replace flower beds with shrubs or succulents and double the width of pathways.

Large shade trees and high hedges can be an excellent first line of defence when it comes to shading the sunny side of any residence. Or attractive shade alternatives to planting large trees can include installing awnings and louvred or latticed panels.

Any tropical garden is capable of attracting the usual suspects in respect to pests and wildlife and in Thailand, these can include a variety of snakes, toads and lizards. Most of Thailand's garden snakes are harmless, but one does need to watch out for the deadly green tree viper, the venomous cobra and even large pythons. If encountered, after first hiding the toddlers and small pets, a swift call to the authorities or the housing estates security staff will see the scaly intruder carried away. If your garden does contain dense foliage, make as much noise as possible when approaching. Also, check shoes left outdoors at night as they make an excellent shelter for small snakes, and other creatures that you probably don't want near your toes.

Next to the air conditioner, the number one crowd-pleaser in the tropics is by far the swimming pool. Be it ever so humble or grandiose, there is no better way to cool off than splashing about in a pool filled with clear sparkling water. Also, a shady sanctuary from the unforgiving tropical sun is a must. This might be a simple awning, arbour or completely covered veranda, or patio with a ceiling fan.



Then, of course, there's the Thai style Sala, under which a weary traveller traditionally took refuge from the intense rain and sun, so common in the tropics. Whether it's situated under the shade or positioned poolside, stylish tropical decor on which to repose will add a degree of comfort and elegance to your garden retreat. Consider all weather daybeds, deck chairs, sun beds, dining and side tables, and garden benches made from materials such as teak and rattan. If you feel that less is more, well there's always the tried and true hammock, just make sure that the trees from which it's hung are strong enough!

If your garden is to be the dog's domain, avoid flower beds and delicate fauna. Stick with sturdy plants that can withstand the antics of a canine and create a spacious lawn on which it can romp. A covered space or a cool shady spot, or even a shallow pooch pool where Fido can cool down after all that romping is also a necessity. Ensure that fences are high enough so that they can't be leapt over and deep enough to prevent an escape by digging.

Your final touches may include barbecue grills, outdoor showers, even colourful floodlights so that it becomes a space to enjoy both by day or by night.


We are so lucky to be living in an area with so much to offer and a vibrant community of Ex Pats organizing differing special events.

10 HACKS TO HELP YOU KEEP YOUR COOL



No matter how many years we live in Thailand it always seems to come as quite a shock when April and May months hit and we realise just how hot it can get here. Of course, staying at home and blasting the air conditioning is one way to lower your body temperature, but there are other ways to stay cool in the summer that won't rack up the electricity bill.

Stay hydrated

Yes at the top of every list of hacks and even more importantly whilst we are discussing the summer months. You must remain hydrated because water is an important element in keeping the body cool. Don't wait to feel thirsty you may already then be hydrated just make a habit of drinking water every day.

Put your feet in cold water.

As an extremity feet have slower blood circulation and can therefore be a critical component in regulating body temperature. If you dunk your feet in cold water or spray them from a hose. Once your feet are cold, the rest of your body will quickly follow, helping you feel cooler.

Turn your fan into an A.C.

Perversely eating spicy food can be beneficial during the hottest months. Spicy food can enhance blood circulation acting on heat receptors on the skin to elicit sweating which helps to cool you down through evaporation.if you find yourself sweating too much you may wish to read our article on page 12 on the subject of hyperhidrosis.



Change the lightbulbs

If you're having trouble cooling your home at night incandescent lightbulbs might be part of the problem. In many countries, these lightbulbs have been phased out because they produce a lot of heat. Switching to energy-saving bulbs can not only save you money by lowering your energy costs, they can also help to keep your home a bit cooler at the same time.

Get a Dehumidifier

Another home cooling trick is to invest in a dehumidifier. It reduces the humidity helping you to breathe much more easily whilst also removing excess moisture from the air. This is especially helpful when you live in a humid climate as moist air can cause mould and dust mites to thrive which in turn can cause allergic reactions, especially for asthma sufferers.

Wrap a cold towel around your neck.

A fact known by many athletes is that just like your feet, the back of your neck is a very sensitive part of the body, especially when it comes to temperature. Whether you have a large garden or just a balcony or terrace make sure to have some large potted plants around that you can move closer to your windows. These will absorb most of the heat around them to create a cooling effect.

Keep your AC units in tip-top shape

With air conditioning units it's a good idea to clean or if necessary replace filters every 2-3 months. This will help your AC unit run more efficiently, more cleanly and more economically.





If you are having your units serviced make sure that the condensers' coils are examined, if these become bent out of shape they can block the airflow.

If you're looking to upgrade your air-conditioner, pick one with a high energy-star rating and do your research to ensure you choose the right type of air-conditioner for your home.

Don't forget it's a good idea to get these measures put in place sooner rather than later.

As temperatures rise and AC units break down you might find yourself unable to get yours seen to as quickly as you would like!


13 Sentinels: Aegis Rim




