British people who need emergency assistance can contact us in person. The British Embassy Bangkok is located at AIA Sathorn Tower, next to the Saint Louis BTS Station, Exit 2.

The main reception to the Embassy is on the left of the lobby on ground floor. Telephone access is provided inside the booth for further contacts.

British people who need further emergency assistance (for example they have become a victim of crime) can be referred up to the Consular Section on 11th Floor, where they will be seen by a Consular Officer.

This of course is ideal for those not working or too young (under 50) to apply for a retirement visa. No minimum bank balance is required. 



PAK NAM (SAMUTPRAKARN) RAILROAD

This railway from Bangkok to Samutprakarn route was established in 1913 in the reign of King Chulalongkorn, King Rama V with the distance of 21.3 Kilometers. This railroad was built up three years before Bangkok to Ayutthaya route by The Royal Railway Enterprise. Railway to Pak Nam (Samutprakarn) was operated by Pak Nam Train limited capital company which was a Danish enterprise. King Chulalongkorn presided over the opening ceremony and took a premiere ride with other royal family members on 11 April 1913. This was counted as the first railroad of Thailand. Even though it was the first route, there was a dispute from other opinion that it was not a train but tram. As there was no steam locomotive and the passenger compartments were forced to move by electric. Some people recognized the route of Bangkok to Ayutthaya 3 years later as the first railroad of Thailand as the steam locomotive provided the force to move passenger compartments.





This route from Bangkok to Pak Nam passed 12 railway stations with the concession of 50 years. At the end of contract, the Royal Railway Enterprise took over its operation. Eventually, Field Marshall Sarit Thanaracht, the prime minister at the time, terminated this route on 1 January 1960 and replaced by motor roads which nowadays are Rama IV road and new road on the abandoned rail track. At present, sky train from Bangkok to Samutprakarn has modernized the old rail-road with much more speed to commute.



ทางรถไฟสายปากน้ำ

ทางรถไฟสายปากน้ำ ถือว่าเป็นทางรถไฟสายแรกของประเทศไทย สร้างขึ้นในปี พ.ศ.2436 ในรัชสมัย ของพระบาทสมเด็จพระจุลจอมเกล้าเจ้าอยู่หัว รัชกาลที่ 5 มีระยะทาง 21.3 กิโลเมตร ซึ่งได้ก่อสร้าง ขึ้น ก่อนการเดินรถของรถไฟหลวงสายกรุงเทพฯ-อยุธยา สามปี ทางรถไฟสายปากน้ำ ดำเนินงานโดย กอมปานีรถไฟ หรือ บริษัทรถไฟปากน้ำทุนจำกัด บริหารกิจการโดยชาวเดนมาร์ค พระบาทสมเด็จพระ จุลจอมเกล้าเจ้าอยู่หัว ได้เสด็จพระราชดำเนินทรงประกอบพิธีเปิดบริการและเสด็จขึ้นประทับโดยสาร ขบวนพระที่นั่ง พร้อมด้วยพระบรมวงศานุวงศ์ เป็นปฐมฤกษ์ในวันที่ 11 เมษายน 2436 นับเป็นทาง รถไฟสายแรกของประเทศไทย แต่มีข้อโต้แย้งว่า ไม่ใช่ทางรถไฟ แต่เป็นรถราง เพราะตัวรถไม่มีหัวรถ จักรไอน้ำ อีกทั้งมีรูปแบบเป็นรถรางที่ขับเคลื่อนด้วยไฟฟ้า บางคนจึงไม่นับว่าเป็นรถไฟสายแรก แต่ ไปนับเอารถไฟสายกรุงเทพฯ-อยุธยา ซึ่งขับเคลื่อนด้วยรถจักรไอน้ำ

สถานีรายทางมีทั้งสิ้น 12 สถานี สัญญาสัมปทานมีอายุ 50 ปี เมื่อหมดสัญญา กรมรถไฟหลวงจึงรับ มาดำเนินกิจการต่อ ต่อมาจอมพลสฤษดิ์ ธนะรัชต์ ได้ยกเลิกรถไฟสายปากน้ำ เมื่อวันที่ 1 มกราคม 2503 โดยสร้างถนนแทน ปัจจุบันคือ ถนนพระรามสี่ และถนนทางรถไฟสายเก่าปากน้ำรถไฟฟ้าสาย สมุทรปราการ นับได้ว่าเป็นการฟื้นฟูเส้นทางรถไฟสายปากน้ำไปโดยปริยาย

Inspiring Southern Thailand Road Trip Part Two By Kim Waddoup

This is the second part of our Inspiring Southern Thailand Road Trip: Phuket, Phang Nga and Krabi, If you missed Part One you can still read it at pattayatrader.com Back Issues August edition.

Rawai Beach, Phuket

You either love or hate Phuket and I am still not sure where I stand. The island does have some really beautiful beaches and there is some charm amongst the crass commercialism if you can find it! We explored most of the island and were most impressed with Rawai Beach and Phuket Old Town. Rawai has a laid-back, relaxed atmosphere and a lovely beach with some excellent eateries and 'character' cafés.



Phang Nga – what an amazing sight

This area is magnificent and we enjoyed an amazing longtail boat tour of Phang Na before resuming our journey following Route 4 to Krabi. In the old town by the river, it is lovely to walk along the embankment where there are many food stalls and small restaurants. Also worth a visit is Wat Tham Suea temple also known as the Tiger Cave Temple which is a revered meditation centre with significant archaeological and historical importance. The highlight of the temple is the outlook which is 309 meters above the entrance area. There are 1260 steps and, as a word of warning, many are not of equal heights and are uneven creating quite a challenge.





Phuket Old Town

Phuket Old Town is the absolute opposite of the rest of the Island. The Chino-Portuguese architecture has survived and old, established businesses are side-by-side with modern, chic boutiques and trendy coffee shops. However, in the busiest parts of Phuket at almost every meter there is someone trying to sell you a taxi, a boat trip or a pingpong show. So from Phuket, we crossed the Sarasin Bridge generally heading for Krabi. We stopped at the Tree Cups coffee house and whilst enjoying an espresso from the branches could see some of the enormous limestone karst formations that the Phang Nga area is so famous for. Going on to the Samet Nangshe Viewpoint we had to park the car, pay THB.80 to be taken up by a 4wd pickup to the viewpoint.

We then drove out of Krabi to find the lovely small community of Nong Thale. Whilst boasting some up-market hotels including the impressive Sofitel it is generally a very small, laid-back community directly on Klong Muang beach.

I attended a conference at the lovely Elements Resort some years ago, and have fond memories of a deserted beach with 2-3 bars and restaurants on the beach. Sadly, the rustic Jamaica Bar & Restaurant did not survive Covid and is a ruin, however, the down-to-earth Rueng Thong Restaurant remains directly on the beach.

Klong Muang Beach

We overnighted at the very charming Viangviman Luxury Resort which enjoys a quiet, rural location. Beautifully constructed of teak, the chalets are traditional, tastefully furnished and comfortable with all amenities. The resort offers two large villas with private pools and I could imagine that these could prove to be quite noisy when occupied by families or small groups. We had avoided Ao Nang so far, but now it was time to have a look. It is a mass tourism resort that enjoys a laid-back atmosphere with the normal plethora of bars, restaurants (offering every type of food from the same kitchen), and souvenir stands. For many, this may be the Thai dream that they are looking for, but for me, it has sadly become very unoriginal.





Ao Nang beach is a lovely beach with views over to the islands and is naturally popular with longtail boat excursions. Walking through the town every 3rd shop is selling boat trips but nothing like as pushy as we had experienced in Phuket. At the end of Ao Nang beach is the main departure point for boats to the islands and further destinations. It is also where you will find Hatnoppharatthara Beach which is a lovely walk around the headland on a sandy beach. At low tide, sandy islands appear and you can walk out to the nearby rocks. We did also discover the charming Baan Ton Mai treehouse cafe, which is well worth a visit.

We decided to give Ao Nang a try for one night and stayed in the Vacation Village Phra Nang Inn. This must be one of the original hotels here and enjoys a prime position on the beach. It is an older hotel but comfortable, has full facilities and we even booked an additional night!

All Road Trips must come to an end and as the West/ South of Thailand is relatively narrow we had little choice but to start to retrace our route north.





The first part of the journey was a pleasant surprise on the glorious Route 44, a relatively new road that is mostly in a straight line through extensive Palm Oil plantations. With a brief overnight stay on the beach near Prachuap Kiri Kahn, we returned to Pattaya through Bangkok.

We are just over halfway through the 2022 Formula 1 season and some very familiar names are showing the way in both the driver and constructor championships. In the drivers table the supremely talented Max Verstappen has already notched up eight victories this year and given his style of driving the fact that he has two other podium finishes to his credit, and has only missed three all season, says a lot about the consistency of both himself and the car he drives. He has a commanding lead in the table but given the circumstances and the fact that he is being chased by his team mate Sergio Perez in the other Red Bull, George Russell and Lewis Hamilton in the improving Mercedes and both Ferrari drivers, the season may not be done and dusted quite yet.

The Mercedes performance this season has been particularly interesting. Both drivers had a dreadful start to the year with both of them only securing one third place each in the first five races of the season. There has however been a significant improvement in the car's performance since then, with Hamilton in particular showing great resilience to get onto the podium in each of the last five races.



Hamilton, after significant technical changes to the car before the start of the campaign, deemed the car "undrivable" after only the second Grand Prix of the season in Saudi Arabia, so things must have improved quite considerably since then. Their are some encouraging noises coming from the Mercedes camp about what they are expecting from the cars over the remaining races of the season and the fight for both titles may not be over yet.

DRIVING – AND SURVIVING – IN PATTAYA

I think everyone is aware of the very poor record that Thailand has in relation to how many accidents, and deaths, there are on the roads every year and the latest set of figures that have been released only confirm it.

Driving in this country can be a hair raising experience, especially for the new arrival. I have been in Pattaya for over ten years and having driven both cars and bikes for all that time, I have a few observations that may help the newcomers on our roads among you to avoid a few pitfalls along the way.

Around three quarters of all fatalities happen on motorbikes. As in most South East Asian countries, the motorbike is used by the vast majority of people for obvious



economic reasons, hence the heavily skewed figures. In spite of this it is my much preferred way of getting around in the city, mainly because you can judge more or less what time it will take to get to any given destination. If you're using a car or truck in Pattaya, a journey can take 15 minutes one day and an hour the next, depending on the time of day and especially the time of year. After the recent pandemic we have yet to see the return of hundreds of coaches clogging up the roads but if they return this coming high season, you'll see what I mean.

Firstly, keep your eyes open, for everything. You do get used to driving here and it does feel fairly safe to get around after a while. At least in the city. Pattaya doesn't quite have the manic traffic of Bangkok, but has enough not to really allow the lunatic speeds which are the main cause of most accidents, along with alcohol, in the provinces. Just expect



anything to happen and the road sense you'll need here will come to you with more experience.

You should certainly keep an eye out for one of my personal favourites, the overtaking bike on your outside when you're already indicating to go right. It goes like this. You're driving along and are due to take the next right turn. You move to the right and indicate to do so. As you're slowing down to either turn right or stop altogether and wait for the oncoming traffic to clear a lunatic food delivery driver will overtake at great speed on your right. It's now only luck that will decide if you turn right as he arrives and you both get sent to a better place. I know it sounds insane, but before you turn check your rear view mirror for this, just in case.

A recent fun addition for both drivers and pedestrians is the crossing that half the drivers on the road ignore and don't stop for. Let's forget for the moment the crossings that are just put down at any busy intersection, where the traffic never actually stops completely, leaving the hapless pedestrian doing some sort of involuntary break dance in the road to avoid the oncoming vehicles, and concentrate on the crossing where a button is pushed and the traffic is told to stop

on a single road. If you are the first to arrive here as the light goes red you have a dilemma, especially on a bike. You want to stop to allow the person to cross, but you are also aware that there is every chance that the vehicle coming up behind you will ignore the signal and go straight through. If there is a space to pass then no problem, except for the people half way across, but if there isn't, then you could well be in the way. Again, when coming to one of these crossings and having to stop, keep a sharp lookout in both mirrors for anything coming up at speed behind you.

I would not want to put you off driving in the city. To me one of the great things about Thailand is the ability to ride a motorcycle every day and use it as my first mode of transport. It is still a very cheap and effective way to get around and adds a great deal to life here, whether just visiting or in the long term.

Don't drink and drive. It is one of the great curses that the country has to deal with and is the main cause of the appalling figures that we see year after year, and they certainly don't want us adding to them.

You will get used to the way things are done here and you'll see some strange sights too. My own personal record is seeing five people on one bike but I have heard reports of more! Watch out for loaded trucks too. You won't believe how inventive the locals are at getting the seemingly impossible on the back of their vehicles. Most of all take care when you're out on the road. Keep your eyes open, your mirrors clean and stay safe.

BUYING A CONDOMINIUM IN THAILAND - FAQ

Mon-Thai nationals can own a condominium in Thailand under their names upon presenting all correct set of documents. The ownership ratio held by the foreigner must not exceed the "foreigner quota". Moreover, the foreign purchaser shall be able to present evidence of bringing foreign currency to Thailand to the amount not less than the price of the condominium unit in the form of a Foreign Exchange Transaction Certificate.

What does "Foreigner Quota" mean?

A condominium building can only sell 49% of the total space of all units within a condominium building to foreigners and register the ownership under their names. This means that in any condominium project, Thai nationals must own at least 51% of the units by area. Therefore, a foreign buyer must first check the current ratio of foreign ownership in a condominium with the Juristic Person.

What is a Foreign Exchange Transaction Certificate? Why is it necessary?

A Foreign Exchange Transaction Certificate (Thor Thor Sam) is a legal document issued by banks upon receipt of foreign currency into your bank account in Thailand. This certificate can be requested from the bank when remitting funds to Thailand for the purpose of purchasing a condominium unit. It is Thailand Government's condition that the money used to pay for the purchase price must originate from an offshore source in the form of foreign currency. You have to present this certificate to the Land Office where the ownership registration shall take place. Otherwise, you cannot register the property under your name.



Is it possible to transfer the money directly to the account of the Developer or my Lawyer?

This shall be possible. Your name must appear as the sender and the money came from your own bank account. It is important that your name shows at one end of the transaction.

How can I be sure that the Property I will buy is not a scam?

You can consult a legal advisor on how to check all the papers for validity. We recommend to perform a Due Diligence procedure to confirm all material facts of the property.

What should the Sale and Purchase Agreement Cover?

This agreement for a condominium shall specify in detail the responsibilities of the buyer and seller of the

condominium. It covers, among others, the agreed price and payment schedule, transfer date, exact

details of the condominium, condominium common and maintenance fees, sinking fund, responsibilities

for transfer fees and taxes, warranties, and matters on due diligence.

Can I legally rent out my Condominium Unit?

You can legally rent out your unit unless restricted in the bylaws of the condominium. Just make sure that you are settling all the corresponding taxes and there is no business intentions. Only when you engage this as a business, then you should comply with the requirements of the Foreign Business and Foreign Employment Act.



CHINA EASES RESTRICTIONS FOR INTERNATIONAL COVID FLIGHT SUSPENSIONS

China shortened the length of suspensions for inbound airline flights that carry passengers infected with Covid-19, the latest sign the nation may be ready to ease virus-control measures for international travellers.

Authorities changed the so-called circuit-breaker mechanism for airline bans, cutting to one week the period that incoming flights will be suspended if they carry five Covid-positive passengers, or 4% of the total, according to a statement posted on the website of the Civil Aviation Administration of China. Flights that arrive with 8% of passengers infected will be halted for two weeks.



The change, starting now, is aimed at promoting personnel exchanges between China and foreign countries, and foreign exchange and cooperation, while "scientifically and accurately" achieving epidemic prevention and control, according to the statement.

In June, China reduced quarantine times for inbound travellers by half, its biggest shift in a Covid-19 policy that has left the world's second-largest economy isolated as it continues to try and eliminate the virus.

Rotary Club of Pattaya International's Beach Cleaning



BARRY UPTON – 25th ANNIVERSARY

n '96, I was travelling back and forth to Nashville U.S.A. writing and producing country rock songs with them ending up on various U.K. Line Dancing albums which were selling like hot cakes due to the sudden enthusiasm of fans of the growing Line Dance scene. As a country rock genre fan myself (I always liked a good twangy guitar), it was a joy to be creating vibrant New Country as it was then labelled.

So, I was then asked to be a judge on the U.K. National Line Dance Championships where I witnessed the D.J./organizer playing a few pop songs on occasion and witnessing young kids line dancing to them. A few people had suggested I write a pop line dancing anthem and seeing those kids suddenly sprung me into action. So, after coming up with the title 5,6,7,8 (because that is how dance choreography is always counted in), together with said organizer of the championships, Steve and his lovely wife, choreographer Rodeo Ruth, we placed an ad in the entertainers 'Stage' magazine and auditioned for members of a prospective three girl and two boy pop band who could sing but also dance well. STEPS was the obvious name as we wanted young kids to copy the dance.

After a year of personel changes and rejections from major record labels, finally a very good independent pop label (who had the Backstreet Boys and Britanny Spears on their roster) came on board and signed us. It was early November '97 by the time the



record was released and went on to spend 17 weeks in the U.K. top twenty and also charted around the world including a few number ones. The next few singles were also hits and the first album STEP ONE stayed in the U.K. top twenty albums for over a year. Who could have thunk it eh? I was completely flabbergasted. Now, after countless further albums, singles and major concert tours, the original line up I formed is still together and currently on a 25th anniversary festival tour.



My song 5,6,7,8 has become a worldwide party classic over the years and is now, I hear, on the school curriculum in the Phillipines.

Earlier on this year, I was watching some Latino style bands at local music venue Sandbar and suddenly realized that Salsa choreographers, when teaching, also count in 5,6,7,8.

So, right at this moment I am putting together a Latino version of my hit with a commercial international flavour plus a few other new original songs in the same Cuban style.

This will be my 25th anniversary celebration contribution and, who knows, may just refresh the always welcome royalty income.

I'm hoping to release the song and video in early November this year, exactly 25 years after it was first released.

In the meantime I have videos of the recent output from my last five albums available to view on a dedicated YouTube channel FAB BAZ MUSIC TV. Please take a look, 'Like', 'Share', 'Subscribe' and ring the bell icon which means you can get notified when new material is uploaded.

Also, my autobiography, which includes stories with a former band of which I was a member, Brotherhood Of Man, plus the full STEPS account and a whole host of other tales, is available here on the Pattaya Trader website.



Hacks

Contrary to popular belief men generally do care about their looks although many lack a basic grooming routine to take care of their skin and hair. If this sounds like you, here are some simple hacks that don't take much time and will definitely help.

Look after your beard

No need to shampoo hair every day

Cotton buds can actually cause problems if forced down your ear especially when pushed too close to the eardrum. Olive oil, however, if dispensed a couple of drops at a time will lubricate your ears and loosen wax so it falls out of its own accord.





Use your toothbrush and toothpaste

A toothbrush and toothpaste can be used for other things than dental hygiene for example to exfoliate lips. By simply rubbing a toothbrush across the lips particles of dry dead skin can be removed to leave them feeling fresh and clean.
