

"Space is the ultimate freedom." Mendes Cavin, Founder & CEO of Deehiy. Deehiy believes in well planned spaces rather than the quantity of it, which goes against almost every principle of property development in Thailand where, until now, the number of bedrooms has been a more important criterion to buy property than its size or comfort. "We aim at creating spaces to unwind and rejuvenate from daily stress in a home where you feel comfortable and confident to host friends" Mendes continues. "I never understood how developers got away with creating these tiny spaces, and I felt the need to disrupt the market. If we will get away with it, and people will actually go for it, is written in the stars, but at least with our villas, we can be proud to have created a high-quality development for the few to enjoy".

Casa Verde Villas consists of 8 secluded pool villas. 7 sit on a plot of 135 square wah (540 square meter), and 1 on a plot of 189 square wah (759 square meter). The standard house size is 435 square meters over two floors with 3 generously spacious bedrooms. Casa Verde Villas are designed with a yet unseen architecture, surrounded by greenery as the name would suggest. The biggest difference to the "usual" single house is the front of the building, which does not contain a large fence or brick wall but instead an open entrance showing the beauty of the building.

Privacy, or security, however is not an issue, as the fence is set back further into the property and thus offers the same security or privacy as any other walled-in property would.

Casa Verde is built based on Swiss finishing standards, UK electrical standards, and the use of various imported materials. These include a new wall system from Germany that assures better durability, fire resistance and insulation. "We want to use only the best quality materials to create Casa Verde and therefore chose various European brands to achieve that". The kitchen is Kvik, imported from Denmark, and comes with Swiss appliances from FRANKE. All sanitary ware is custom designed and made of imported high-quality brass.

Casa Verde Villas will feature 3 bedrooms and 3 bathrooms, with 1 bedroom on the ground floor next to the pool and two rooms on the upper floor. The ground floor offers a large open space combining kitchen and living area overlooking a beautiful pool and lavish green backdrop. For those who enjoy fine wines, the villa offers a provision for a built-in wine room. There is a garage with space for two cars and direct access to the house, another small convenient detail. The master bedroom, located on the upper floor, spans over 72 square meters with a spacious walk-in closet, large bathroom and a beautiful round bathtub overlooking the swimming pool.





Casa Verde Villas is situated within the beautiful countryside of Nongprue. "The development has its own water well and produces drinking water quality through a Dutch designed filtration system, allowing residents to drink best quality mineral water from their tap at home", Mendes mentions. "This was something very important to me as it is normal in my home country (Switzerland), and I wanted to bring the same convenience to Pattaya".

At time of writing Mendes mentions: "We have not yet fully finalized all plans but expect to complete everything within January 2023 when we can then bring it to the market officially. We have, however, 4 villas already reserved for pre-booking and expect to be able to quickly sell all of them".

Casa Verde Villas has indeed many unique features, and breaks a few of the usual rules of Thai developments for the benefit of those who appreciate quality and comfort.

There was much criticism of the competition before the start of the World Cup in Qatar, with some justification, but in the end the quality of the football and the fairytale result made it seem all worthwhile. Lionel Messi captained Argentina to beat France on penalties in what some are calling the greatest final in the history of competitive football. Messi finished second in the scoring charts behind the new "world's best player" Kylian Mbappe but won the Golden Ball award for best player in the tournament whilst guiding Argentina to the trophy. All of this looked a long way away after the Argentinians suffered a shock opening group match defeat against Saudi Arabia, but they rallied superbly and were just about the best team in the tournament with France a very close second.

There were a few shocks at the group stage, chief of which was the exit of Germany from group E. They were pitched alongside Spain in the same group and both of these world giants were supposed to progress quite comfortably, but Japan had other ideas. The Asian side had the temerity to beat both Germany and Spain by the same score 2-1 and qualify as group winners. This after a loss to Costa Rica in between the two victories.

Incidentally Japan won both of those games whilst setting a record for the lowest percentage of possession in a World Cup against Germany at 26% and then breaking it against Spain with only 17%. Just goes to show sometimes it's what you do when you have the ball, not how much you have it that counts.

Other surprises were Denmark crashing out allowing Australia to reach the last 16 and Belgium, second in the world rankings and expected to go far by some, exiting group F behind surprise packets of the whole tournament and history makers Morocco.







The round of 16 went very much to form except for the mighty Morocco knocking Spain out on penalties and the quarter finals was the place where everything really started to take shape. Brazil were still favourites at this stage but were up against Croatia here, who don't know when they're beaten and continued their brilliant World Cup form by hold the Brazilians to a 1-1 draw before going through on penalties.

France beat England 2-1 to go through and this was a real good game of football. There was nothing much in it and although France just edged it after Harry Kane missed a late penalty you would expect England to build on this as they have some exceptional young players coming through.

Portugal had a strong squad and were expected to end the run of Morocco. Nobody told the Moroccans though, who played brilliantly to edge the Portugese out 1-0 and become the first team from the African continent to reach the semi finals. In the last game Argentina cruised into a 2-0 lead but were pegged back by a quietly fancied Netherlands, who scored the equalising goal in the 11th minute of time added on before losing out on penalties.





And so to the semi finals. Two good games here but both Argentina and France eventually cruised through quite comfortably against Croatia and the heroic Moroccans respectively, setting up the final which everyone wanted between the two best teams in the competition. Although I wouldn't think that anybody could envisage what was to come in the final.

Of course the big story was Lionel Messi. The World Cup is the one trophy that has eluded him and the Maradona legend has loomed large over his career for that very reason. Until now. Argentina were brilliant for the first 75 minutes to go into a 2-0 lead and then conspired, as they had against the Netherlands, to get pegged back. This was mostly due to Kylian Mbappe producing one of the goals of the tournament with ten minutes to play which followed a penalty only a few minutes before. You could have forgiven the Argentinians if they had dropped their heads but they roared back in extra time and took the lead again through Messi before again being pegged back by an Mbappe penalty. That goal made him only the second player, after Sir Geoff Hurst, to score a hat trick in a world cup final.

The penalties were a slight anti climax really. The French were never really in it and Argentina didn't need the fifth spot kick to run out 4-2 winners and give Messi his crowning moment in the game after a glittering career. The best ever? An argument for another article perhaps.

So all in all it was an excellent footballing World Cup for both players and fans alike, and after some initial misgivings, things turned out pretty well. Let's hope the array of young talent on show here continues in the same vein for many tournaments to come. Exterior designer Bernardo Zuccon says the knife-like profile of the SP110 was inspired

by the great white shark.

Sanlorenzo's quest for innovation shows no signs of slowing down with the SP110, its first open coupè and fastest yacht to date. In fact, the two-deck design is so far removed from the SL, SD and SX flybridge yacht ranges that it's reaching a new sector of owners. Sanlorenzo Asia, represented by Simpson Marine, secured a sale soon after the model's world premiere at the Cannes Yachting Festival.

In an era with increasing focus on fuel emissions and a huge push for greener propulsion and operational systems, even Sanlorenzo Chairman Massimo Perotti admits that the high-speed SP110 may be a more niche offering than more voluminous models from the well-established SL, SD and SX series.But that's where the 'Smart' in Smart Performance comes in. Sure,the SP110 can seriously shift when it needs to, but Sanlorenzo says its performance is matched by impressive efficiency, the driving force behind the boat's fractional propulsion system.

To improve efficiency at slower speeds, the yacht can use just one engine or only the two outer engines, paired with a steering waterjet as opposed to the central thruster. "Personally, I think the best performance in terms of economy is at 10 knots, with the two side engines running at about 800-900 rpm and consumption at about 110-112 litres per hour," Antonelli says.

Furthermore, the SP110 incorporates a solar-electric energy system to help power onboard systems.

While Antonelli is focused on the Smart Performance the exterior and interior designers, Bernardo Zuccon and Piero Lissoni admit it was a "complex task" finding the balance between the SP110's dynamic performance and the need for elegant, comfortable outdoor and indoor spaces. "While respecting the stylistic features that historically characterise this type of boat, such as the aerodynamic and extremely organic surfaces, with Tilli Antonelli we arrived at a compromise: a dialogue between dynamism and liveability not normally perceived on boats of this size," said Zuccon.









Outdoor social areas include the foredeck and a five-person sunbathing area with an aft terrace, so offering space for outdoor furniture, water toys and whatever else an owner might wish to use it for.

Whether you're standing on the aft terrace, swim platform or even the dock, you have a clear view through to both the lower lounge and the main deck above. Both decks are connected by what Lissoni describes as a "hyper-technological staircase" to starboard and both are far more relaxing, comfortable and welcoming than the minimalist exterior might suggest.

Antonelli is full of praise for the connectivity of the outdoor and indoor areas. "The SP110 is designed to be social," he says. "When one guest is reading a magazine on the main deck, another is watching a movie in the lower lounge and others are sunbathing or playing on the aft deck, they can all communicate. They're in separate areas, but they're all connected."

Inside, Lissoni themes include long sight lines, big windows, large openings and clear deck spaces that can be dressed by owners how they wish.

In essence, the main deck is designed to start with an open saloon, while forward is a dining area flanked by huge sliding doors on both sides for a pleasant cross breeze and beautiful sea views. Like the main saloon, the lower lounge can be dressed and laid out to the owner's taste.

The SP110 is the first of what will genuinely be a new generation of yachts.





#### STARTING A CANNABIS BUSINESS IN THAILAND

Ince the Thailand Narcotics Law was amended to decriminalize parts of Cannabis, it is now allowed to produce, sell, and consume certain parts of Cannabis for medical and health purposes, as well as for food consumption, and research purposes. Cannabis bark, trunk, fiber, branch, root, leaf without flower, extract containing Cannabidiol (CBD) and Tetrahydrocannabinol (THC) not exceeding 0.2% or residues after extraction do not exceed 0.2% are no longer considered narcotics. However, these parts of the plant must come from Cannabis grown in Thailand.

Even though cannabis is now legal in Thailand, there are certain limitations in place. Cannabis extracts with more than 0.2% THC is considered to be a narcotic substance. Possessing, selling, and distributing this without a license is a criminal offence. Possession, use, or smoking of Cannabis with less than 0.2%

THC is legal but is only limited to people aged 20 years and above, unless prescribed by a doctor. Pregnant women and breastfeeding women are strictly prohibited from buying and using cannabis products. Moreover, the use of Cannabis for recreational purposes, and smoking in public is still strictly prohibited and punishable by fine and imprisonment.

#### CAN FOREIGNERS ENGAGE IN CANNABIS BUSINESS IN THAILAND?

Production and exportation of Cannabis is prohibited to foreigners or foreign-owned companies. However, the Cannabis and CBD market are open to foreigners through incorporating a Thai Limited Company. In order to obtain licenses to produce, sell, and import cannabis, 51% of the company shares, and at least two-thirds of the company capital and directorship must be owned by Thai nationals.

#### IS A LICENSE REQUIRED TO SELL CANNABIS?

Various licenses will be required for producing extracts, growing, selling, importing, and exporting cannabis. Varying on the operations of the company, an Authorization from the Plant Varieties Act, Ministry of Agriculture and Cooperatives and the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) may be required. Failure to secure the appropriate license will be punishable by fine and imprisonment. For people who are planning to grow Cannabis, a website and mobile application was launched by the FDA, where one has to register, stating the reason for growing cannabis.

#### WHAT TYPE OF PRODUCTS CONTAINING CANNABIS CAN BE SOLD?

Use of cannabis as an ingredient for selling must only use the parts allowed by Ministry of Public Health such as hemp seeds, oil from hemp seeds, protein from hemp seeds, trunk, fiber, branch, root, and leaf, without the tip or the flower.





งูเห่าไทย: เป็นงูพิษที่มีมากและพบเห็นได้ในทุกพื้นที่ในประเทศไทย งูเห่าไทยมักจะอาศัยอยู่ตามพื้นที่ลุ่มต่ำ ที่ เย็นๆ และมีหญ้ารก เช่นทุ่งนา แม้แต่พื้นที่ใกล้เคียงกับบ้านเรือนที่อยู่อาศัย ฝาผนังหรือใต้พื้นซีเมนต์ที่มีรอยแตกหรือ มีโพรง งูมักจะเข้าไปออกไข่ซึ่งฟักออกมาเป็นตัวจำนวนมาก งูเห่ามักจะเข้าบ้านคนที่มีพื้นซีเมนต์ในระดับเดียวกับพื้น ดินภายนอก โดยเฉพาะบ้านที่มีสิ่งของวางไว้รกรุงรังไม่เคยปัดกวาดเช็ดถู ทำให้หนูมาอาศัยอยู่ใต้กองสิ่งของนั้น งูเห่า ตัวใหญ่ๆมักจะหลบอยู่ตามซอกมุมต่างๆของบ้านเพื่อจับหนูกินเป็นอาหาร ลูกงูเห่าตัวเล็กๆมักเข้าไปนอนอยู่ในรองเท้า ซึ่งต้องตรวจให้ดีก่อนสวมใส่ เมื่อเห็นงูเห่าเข้ามาในบ้าน อย่าจับเอง ต้องโทรแจ้งให้หน่วยกู้ภัยมาจับไป

งูเขียว: เป็นงูไม่มีพิษ มักอาศัยอยู่บนต้นไม้รกทึบที่ปลูกไว้รอบๆบ้าน หรือ ซุ้มเถาไม้เลื้อย งูจำพวกนี้ ไม่ทำร้าย คน จนมีผู้ให้สมญานามว่า "งูสามัญประจำบ้าน"





งูเขียวหางใหม้: เป็นงูที่มีพิษอ่อน พบเห็นได้ในพื้นที่เดียวกับงูเขียวธรรมดา หากถูกกัด พิษจะไม่ทำอันตราย ต่อร่างกาย ยกเว้นคนที่แพ้พิษงู จะมีอาการปวดบวมเล็กน้อย ตรงบริเวณที่ถูกกัดและจะหายเป็นปกติในไม่ช้า

งูเหลือม: เป็นงูขนาดใหญ่ที่ไม่มีพิษ พบเห็นได้ทั่วไป ส่วนมากจะเป็นบ้านที่มีต้นไม้รกทึบเป็นป่ารอบๆบริเวณบ้าน งจำพวกนี้มักจะมาขโมยกินสัตว์เลี้ยง เช่น สุนัขและแมว รวมทั้งเป็ดไก่ที่เลี้ยงอยู่ในเล้า บางทีก็ขึ้นไปนอนบนหลังคาหรือ ชื่อบ้าน เนื่องจากงูเหลือมมีขนาดใหญ่และพละกำลังมาก จึงควรที่จะต้องเรียกหน่วยกู้ภัย มาจับไปปล่อยยังที่ไกลๆ ท้ายที่สุดนี้ เราขอแนะนำ เพจชื่อ "งูไทย อะไรก็ได้" ในเฟซบุ๊ค เข้าเป็นสมาชิกฟรีโดยกด like หรือ subscribe มี ผู้โพสต์เรื่องราวต่างๆเกี่ยวกับงูในเคสที่ต่างๆกันเป็นจำนวนมากในแต่ละวัน เป็นการเผยแพร่ความรู้ รวมทั้งไขข้อ สงสัย สิ่งที่ต้องการรู้ โดยคอมเม้นท์ต่อท้ายโพสต์แต่ละโพสต์ สำหรับผู้ที่อยู่ในพัทยา หากมีเหตุด่วนเกี่ยวกับงู สามารถเรียกหน่วยกู้ภัย ของมูลนิธิสว่างบริบูรณ์ได้ที่หมายเลข 038-222474


So, what can an unsuspecting public expect to be unexpectably exposed to from Sunshine Productions and the always over creative mind of yours truly?



# Oh the places you'll go in south korea exploring gyeonggi-do Maria Cerquillana



My friend and I took a short drive to the quirky and artsy Heyri Art Village, a very picturesque place full of small stores, souvenir shops, dramatic restaurants, and cute cozy cafes. What could be a better way to start off our little adventure than with delectable food? Lunch at Mochuisle, an impressive dining space that has been the filming site of popular k-dramas such as Business Proposal, My Roommate is a Gumiho and Our Beloved Summer proved to be a great choice. It's a restaurant I absolutely recommend for its gorgeous interiors and excellent Italian food. We were lucky enough to have gone on a perfect sunny weekday and it ultimately was the perfect place to laugh and catch up. Because of my sweet tooth, one of my favorite things to do when in South Korea is to get my fill out of the sweet and silky Korean strawberry milk that is made with fresh chunks of strawberries and sweet strawberry syrup. The dreamy creamy one I had at this place certainly did not disappoint!



I couldn't leave Paju without visiting a part of the DMZ, the world's most heavily militarized borders, which I've always found fascinating. Unfortunately, due to the lack of time, we were only able to visit the South Korean side where there were a lot of observation towers, museums, and beautiful parks. It was still such an insightful experience where visitors who love culture and history would get to understand why the 2 Koreas separated. You could also have an opportunity to see a part of North Korea which is mostly mountains and forests.



Heyri Art Village was a joy to explore. It has a little bit of everything for everyone but it would certainly be a tiny piece of heaven for creative folks such as writers, artists, and the like. A place that stood out for me was the Old Objects Museum. It offers a very quirky environment that showcases fun stuff from interesting museum pieces to old toys, comic books, uniforms, and even old-school candy which reminded my Korean friend of her nostalgic school days. I even experienced creating the famous Dalgona candy, which was made infamous by the highly acclaimed K-drama, Squid Game! The afternoon was well-spent strolling around and getting lost in fancy museums, interesting shops, and cute galleries.



#### Incheon

Another highlight of my trip was visiting the animated Chinatown in thecity of Incheon. What I love about South Korea is the creative, cutesy, artsy vibe you get while wandering around its many streets and this particular Chinatown exudes certainly that! The country just knows how to make everything cute and fun. With its exuberant street life, it was so much fun just walking along its historical streets and taking in the buzzing sights and sounds. Delicious street food stalls offering Chinese Korean delicacies were abundant! Colorful gates were a sight to see. Small museums showcasing the port city's history lined the streets. Adorable cartoon cotton candy stalls were fun to explore. There were even little nostalgic game shops where we spent half an hour playing the classic Super Mario game. Everything was just so vividly wistful and colorful with a lot to take in and buy!



The main table has a memorable plant display as the centerpiece adding more to the charming interior. The fruit teas and cakes we ordered were exquisite! I couldn't get enough of the delicate Original Soufflé Castella and the divine Strawberry Fromage Cake. They were the cutest and tastiest things ever.

Who doesn't love a fun photo session with friends? After getting pleasantly lost in the numerous alleyways, my friend and I decided to visit a photo booth studio. This by far contributed to my really fun memories of the trip. Korean photo booths are definitely an experience anyone should try at least once. They bring you to another world where you get to choose exciting props, trendy costumes, and tons of accessories to play with. They even have hair irons to help you get ready! With all these along with its fabulous weather and amazing food markets, South Korea is and always will be a place I will unquestionably keep on going back to.





Walking up the road, my friend and I also explored a little of Songwoldong, or the Fairy Tale Village. It's a cute little neighborhood where. numerous colorful western and Korean fairy tale cartoon characters are featured on walls along the streets. It was so much fun for me when I visited a small caricature shop where a talented artist draws the most lovable cartoon-style portrait of yourself while you sit for a few minutes. I was so happy with the winsome finished product that it remains one of my favorite souvenirs from the trip.

#### Seoul

Finally, the trip would never be complete without a visit to one of my most-loved cities - Seoul. Aside from shopping in its popular shopping landmarks, I can't help gushing over one of my favorite neighborhoods- Iksandong which is definitely a precious hidden gem in such a bustling city! We went on a rainy day but it nevertheless added to the whimsical charm of the place. Strolling around a labyrinth of the cutest little alleys was a dream. The restaurants and cafes were amazing! Trendy boutiques are heaven-sent for shopaholics. The rustic tea houses were so cute. It feels like you are in another world as you are lulled by the sound of chimes and beckoned by the taste of heavenly tea. With lots of beautiful traditional Korean houses (Hanoks) lining the streets, it offers such a unique atmosphere where the vibe is simply remarkable.

As the place is popular for having superb cafes, of course, we couldn't leave without entering one. We visited Cheongsudang, an alluring and delightful cafe that mixes the modern and the traditional. It is surely one of the most beautiful cafes in Seoul. Showcasing bamboo, lanterns, and even a small pond, the whole theme is simply gorgeous.






Maybe one of the most spectacular sights in Thailand are the Thung Bua Tong Sunflower fields

However, sometimes Instagram-type photos can be luckily taken with perfect weather and lighting, filters and photoshop. These 'idyllic' shots can then cause overreaction in our judgement and increase anticipation. The result being that when we actually see the real life view with our own eyes, it does not live up to the perceived images of our embroidered expectations.

Whilst I had been wanting to visit Thung Bua Tong Fields at Doi Mae U Kho for some time, I was slightly concerned that this might be a case of over-expectation but was jubilant to discover that, in reality, the spectacular sights were much more than I had ever anticipated and they have left deep impressions.

From Khun Yuam on Route 108 you turn up further into the mountains on route 1263. It's a good road that twists and climbs for about 25 kms. Finally, at an altitude of 1,600 metres one starts to see the yellow hillside and shortly one is surrounded by masses of bright yellow 'Sunflowers'.





Commonly known as the Tree Marigold the plants are from the family Asteraceae and also called Mexican Sunflowers and Nitobe chrysanthemum, amongst others. Whether they are true sunflowers or not is irrelevant as one leaves the car and is enveloped by this cornucopia of 2-metre + tall swaying bushes of yellow delight.

The flowers bloom between November and January and one is recommended to visit either early morning or late afternoon to enjoy the best views. It really is breath-taking, awe-inspiring, almost surreal, hypnotic and even spiritual as one attempts to absorb all that one is seeing within an aura of quietness and respect from the other visitors.

The development here is quite tasteful. Yes, there is a winding road that passes through these fields, but traffic is minimal and respectful. There are a variety of trails that one can explore through the tunnels of flowers. Conveniently placed view-points afford magnificent vistas over the flowers to the surrounding mountains. Whilst there are toilets there are no commercial shops or cafes to disturb the scenery or clear alpine air.



It is a photographer's dream, and one could probably spend 24 hours there to take in both the sunrise and the sunset. I believe that it is possible to camp, and a simple mountain resort is relatively nearby but apologies, I did not get the name

For me it was one of the most inspirational sights that I have had the privilege to witness. I have heard it likened to the alpine meadows from the Sound of Music, but this does not do the Bua Tong Sunflower Fields justice.

They are magical and we were truly fortunate to visit with the flowers in full bloom, spectacular panoramas over the mountains, a clear blue sky and few other visitors. Add this to your bucket list, no lifetime is complete without this experience.





Thung Bua Tong Forest Park – Doi Mae U-Kho is one of the top-list natural attractions in Mae Hong Son. However, be careful when you visit. Bua Tong flowers only bloom during the winter, If you go there during the other seasons it will be disappointing.

It's a good drive from Mae Hong Son or Mae Sariang in addition to about 1 hour up the mountain and there is limited accommodation in the region. So visit websites such as https:// mychiangmaitour.com/- they have a chat room so you can ask about the blooms before you head off
