



## THE AVANISPA EXPERIENCE

Here in Pattaya we are lucky to have Khun Wan of the Avani Spa. She has given massages to royalty, not only in Thailand but also at The Ritz in Paris, and to celebrities such as Lady Gaga at The St Regis in Rome. I was also delighted to see a massage bed with a hole for your face. Although seeming a little odd at first it is in fact the most relaxing way to lie on your front and stops the aggravating neck ache that can occur when you simply turn your head to one side, which is something I am bothered by if I have a massage at the beach.

During this blissful treatment I have to say that never at any time did I feel uncomfortable. Bolsters and pillows were placed under my ankles and knees to give extra support and put my body in the most comfortable position possible. There were no wooden sticks or jerky movements. The pressure from Khun Wan was controlled, consistent and always to the degree that I was happy with and her skill could certainly be felt by the fluid movement of her hands.





## **ALL ABOUT THAILAND SNAKES CHAPTER 2**

#### By Songpone Siriwanlert

Preface: In this chapter, we have classified the common venomous snakes in Thailand by group of venom that have different effect to human body. As Thailand is geographically in tropical moist climate, venomous animals are always plentiful. Such kind of animal is snake. Over 180 species of snakes comprising strong and mild venomous, also nonvenomous as well. Poison effect to people who is bitten by venomous snake is very common in nature. The patient has high percentage of death unless on time treatment with the right serum. General problem to the doctor or nurse for treatment is uncertain confidence in diagnostic analytics of venom kind. In the most case, dead body of beaten snake is brought to the doctor with the patient. In order to help for proper treatment, we shall provide all readers with basic information of type of venomous snakes as follows:

Venomous snakes shall be classified into 3 groups:

- 1. Neurotoxins or toxic to nervous system: This group of snakes comprises of Cobra, King Cobra, Banded krait, Malayan krait.
- 2. Hematotoxins or toxic to blood system: This group of snakes comprises of Russell's viper, Malayan pit viper and Green pit viper.
- 3. Myotoxins or toxic to musculoskeletal system: This group of snakes are Sea Snake

















This chapter is to classify venomous snakes by type of venom that is beneficial for right serum for treatment of snake bitten patients.

The next issue will show you in detail of each kind of snake in term of type, ecology, and chance to face it in people's living residence.

## งูไทย อะไรก็ได้ บทที่ 2

คำนำ: ในบทที่ 2 นี้ เราได้จัดประเภทของงูพิษที่พบเห็นได้ทั่วไปตามแหล่งธรรมชาติของประเทศไทย โดยจำแนก ตามกลุ่มของพิษงูซึ่งมีผลต่อระบบร่างกายของผู้ที่ถูกงูกัดแตกต่างกันไป โดยที่ประเทศไทยเป็นประเทศที่ตั้งอยู่ ในเขตร้อนชื้นแถบศูนย์สูตร จึงมีสัตว์มีพิษอาศัยอยู่อย่างชุกชุม สัตว์เหล่านี้มีงูอยู่ 180 ชนิด ซึ่งมีทั้งพิษร้าย แรง พิษอ่อน และไม่มีพิษ คนถูกงูมีพิษกัดมีอยู่เป็นธรรมชาติและอาจถึงแก่ชีวิตถ้ารักษาไม่ทันและไม่ถูกวิธีด้วย การใช้เซรุ่มที่ตรงกับพิษงูที่ถูกกัด ปัญหาโดยทั่วไปของแพทย์และพยาบาลในการรักษาผู้ถูกงูกัดคือ การวินิจฉัย อาการเพื่อหาประเภทของพิษงูด้วยความไม่มั่นใจ ดังนั้นผู้ถูกงูกัด มักจะนำเอาซากงูมาพบแพทย์ด้วย เพื่อให้ มั่นใจต่อการใช้เซรุ่มที่ถูกต้อง ในบทนี้เราจึงขอเสนอประเภทของงูพิษแยกตามกลุ่มของพิษ ซึ่งแบ่งออกเป็น 3 กลุ่ม ดังต่อไปนี้

- 1. NEUROTOXINS พิษต่อระบบประสาท งูกลุ่มนี้ ได้แก่ งูเห่า งูจงอาง งูสามเหลี่ยม งูทับสมิงคลา
- 2. HEMATOTOXINS พิษต่อระบบเลือด งูกลุ่มนี้ได้แก่ งูแมวเซา งูกะปะ งูเขียวหางไหม้
- 3. MYOTOXINS พิษต่อระบบกล้ามเนื้อ งูกลุ่มนี้ อยู่ในประเภทงูทะเล ซึ่งอาศัยอยู่ในทะเล ว่ายน้ำอยู่ใกล้ ชายฝั่ง หรือ แนวปะการัง

















ในบทนี้เราได้จำแนกชนิดของงูพิษตามประเภทของพิษงู ทั้งนี้เพื่อเป็นประโยชน์ต่อการใช้เซรุ่มให้ถูกประเภท สำหรับรักษาผู้ที่ถูกงูพิษกัด บทต่อไป จะกล่าวถึงูแต่ละชนิดตามถิ่นที่อยุ่และโอกาสที่จะเผชิญหน้ากับงูภายใน เคหะสถานบ้านเรือน







If we take a look at the sales that were generated at the Motor Expo 2022 show that took place at the Impact Challenger Arena in December last year, Japanese motor manufacturers seem to have a stranglehold on the Thailand car market at the moment. The event, which attracted over a million visitors, has released the sales figures and the revenue generated over the twelve days that it ran. Orders were taken for nearly 43,000 vehicles, 6,000 of which were motorcycles. Of the near 37,000 cars sold, the top five in popularity was headed by Toyota and followed by four more Japanese manufacturers, accounting for nearly two thirds of all the vehicles sold. The modern version of the always trendy Lambretta headed the bike list with nearly 2,000 sales, followed by Yamaha. The electric car giant BYD headed that category with over 2,700 units and they were closely followed by MG with over 2,400. MG are really making headway in the Thai market and have re-invented themselves very well over the last decade or so. Old English ex-pats like myself remember the name being dead and buried many years ago so this incursion back into the market is all the more commendable.

#### **VOLVO LEAD THE WAY IN ELECTRIC CAR CHARGING INNOVATION**



Volvo Thailand have come up with something interesting for the recharging of their electric car range. They have opened solar carport charging stations at four of their dealerships, which is available to Volvo customers free of charge. I have always wondered how the question of where the extra energy would come from as the electric vehicle market increased and this could be one possible solution. Of course there is no question that electric vehicles help enormously with emissions but when you plug into the power grid to charge up your car, that energy has to come from somewhere.

That somewhere will usually be a power station that burns fossil fuel and only adds to the problem of carbon dioxide in the atmosphere. The solar carport idea means that you are recharging your car with renewable energy direct from source, which not only means that you don't contribute to air pollution but you make considerable savings too. Volvo have apparently made a commitment to reduce their greenhouse gas emissions by 50% over three years, not an easy Thing to do I would have thought, and this innovation will go some way to reaching that target. If this idea really takes off I could see space being an issue in the future. I can't imagine spending billions on some land in Bangkok and using it to let Volvo drivers recharge their cars! It looks like an idea well worth pursuing though and this continued innovation from the car makers is good to see.

#### SALES OUTLOOK FOR 2023



The automotive producers in Thailand are expecting sales to pick up in 2023, principally after the general election in May. The industry has slowed since October last year in the wake of rising inflation and increasing interest rates but it is widely believed in most parts of Asia that elections increase confidence and people are more willing to spend their money in the long term. Whether this applies to Thailand or not is another question but alongside the recovery from the pandemic the makers are hopeful of an upturn in sales in the second half of the year. A long term semi-conductor shortage also held up the growing electric car market and is expected to continue to do so throughout the coming year. In spite of that, the EV market in the Kingdom is a target for some of the biggest manufacturers around and their will be a concerted effort in the coming year to woo the Thai motorist over to electric.



Of course what Thailand really needs is a massive improvement in its road safety figures. No matter where you get the statistics, the numbers are awful and have been in all the twelve years I have lived here, with no improvement in sight. The information released concerning the recent Christmas and new year only confirm that. Whoever runs the country after the election in May has to make a long term commitment to the education of drivers throughout the country. Not an easy task.

DISCOVER MOTORING



From September 5th last year the penalties for various driving offences in Thailand increased substantially. The authorities decided at the time to give a three month grace period to all road users to give them time to adjust and "improve their road behaviour". Judging by the figures over the Christmas and new year for road deaths and injuries this has not yet filtered through to the general population but the main point is that the grace period ended on the 5th of January and the new penalties are now in place.

#### HARSHER PENALTIES

Jumping a red light or not stopping at a zebra crossing now both carry a maximum fine of 4000 Baht, up from 1000 Baht. How this would help if a pedestrian gets knocked twenty feet in the air whilst trying to cross or a truck smashes into the back of your bike because you stopped and they decided not to is unclear at the moment.

Driving against traffic and not wearing a crash helmet on a bike or a safety belt in a car all now carry a maximum 2000 Baht fine, up from 500 Baht. There has also been an addition to this because up until now passengers in the rear seats of cars or trucks were not required by law to wear seat belts, but are now. Failure to do so also carries a 2000 Baht fine.

Driving without care for the safety or lives of others now has a penalty of a fine of between 5000 – 20,000 Baht and a jail sentence of a maximum one year. This is increased from 2000 - 10,000 Baht and a three-month prison sentence. This seems a bit vague and who decides what constitutes "driving without care for the safety or lives of others" is not made clear. It seems to leave lots of room for interpretation and I assume that would be done by the officer that attends the scene, so good luck with that.

Drink driving is the area where the punishment for contravening the law has increased substantially. If you are convicted of drink driving you will now face a fine of up to 20,000 Baht and a prison term of a maximum one year. However, if you repeat the offence within two years of the first one you will face a fine of up to 100,000 Baht and a MANDATORY jail term of up to two years. Whatever your thoughts on these increases, it's hard to argue with the fact that drink driving has been a curse on Thailand for decades and they have to start somewhere to get the general population to understand that drink driving is a serious offence and needs to be stopped. It will take time because it seems endemic here but as I say, you have to start somewhere.

New offences for road racing and preparing vehicles for same have also been put in place but needn't concern us here. Of more interest is that the original plan to make child car seats compulsory has been shelved, wisely in my opinion, until more research can be done.

So there we have it. Major increases in fines and possible prison terms for all kinds of offences. For foreign nationals, all you can do really is make sure you have a valid license, buckle up if you're driving, wear a helmet on a bike and most importantly, don't drink and drive under any circumstances. If you do drink and drive and are involved in an accident, especially with a Thai national and there are injuries, you are in serious trouble, make no mistake, so avoid.

Drive carefully and stay safe.

#### **DUE DILIGENCE ON THAI PROPERTY PURCHASE**

nvesting in real estate certainly involves a huge amount of money. We cannot deny the fact that there are some fraudulent dealers and developers taking advantage of naïve investors who can easily get victimized by unscrupulous deals. Therefore, investors are advised to take extra precaution before finalizing any transactions.

It is essential to consider conducting Due Diligence as it is a useful tool for estimating the status of a prospective project and its developer. 



After leaving the band in 1967 he recorded "Hi Ho Silver Lining", which reached the UK top twenty. After this he formed the Jeff Beck Group with Rod Stewart on vocals and Ronnie Wood on bass guitar. He then went on to be part of the supergroup Beck, Bogart & Appice before being rumoured to have been offered the lead guitar role in the Rolling Stones on the departure of Mick Taylor around 1974-75. He decided to stay on the instrumental side, teaming up with Jan Hammer and guesting on other musicians projects, preferring to be the hired gun when you wanted a distinctive part on your recording.

Speaking with Jennifer Batten some years back who toured with Beck, she was greatly influenced by his style and tried to pick up some of his "nasty" licks. As a guitar player he was very unique and very difficult to copy. His use of the tremolo bar combined with harmonics created some hauntingly beautiful melodies, as on the track "Where were you" which was Just one of the many innovative ways he played his cream white Fender Strat. Deciding to use his fingers instead of a pick gave him a closeness to the instrument and many percussive attack options. His style also kept evolving as he moved from his blues roots to hard rock and experiments with Jazz Fusion. He ranked in the top five of Rolling Stone's list of 100 greatest guitarists in a recent poll





I heard that his musical career helped fund his other passion, collecting and working on classic hot rod and vintage cars. In fact, before he joined The Yardbirds in the 60's he worked at a car body shop to make ends meet. If you were one of the lucky few to visit him at his Surrey mansion you would probably find him tinkering away at his purpose built garage where he kept his beloved fleet of hot rods.

It saddens me that most people only know him for just for his hit "Hi Ho Silver Lining" when there is a great catalog of his music out there to explore. Thankfully we live in the age of YouTube so most of his greatest performances have been captured. I certainly intend to take the time out to view him live at Ronnie Scotts one more time.





# Koh Phangan – Impressions from a non-party, non-yoga person and former Digital Nomad! By Kim Waddoup

Just for clarity, maybe I should preface this article with the proviso that I am a sane and mature human who loves to travel and explore new places. I don't think that I can be stereotyped and apologise in advance if I do this to others. Koh Phangan is very different with wildly diverse people and sub-cultures that are quite unusual for the rest of Thailand. I am not saying this in a negative view but keep shaking my head as I write this article! My first impression of Koh Phangan was of a green, fertile island with steep hills. Especially on the West of the island where the resorts are to be found below the road with gradients so steep as to limit any quests with limited mobility.

For the first night we booked the Pimmada Hut on Pleayleam Beach, mainly due to its proximity to Thong Sala. Whilst a lovely small resort, it did not state that the roadway down was dramatically steep. Going down was a challenge but coming back up we almost reverted to hands and feet. The chalets were simple but adequate and being the only guests, we were offered their beachside chalet just 2 metres from the sea.

Naturally we were well aware of the reputation of this





island with its infamous Full Moon parties and bohemian yoga fanatics, but the mix of visitors to the island is complex. There are many couples, young and old and probably the world's largest collection of dreadlock hairstyles and digital nomads laying claim to their tables at the island's coolest cafés. A real cornucopia and melting pot of world travellers.

Ao Hing Kong is a long but small beach running along the road. Haad Son Resort and Koh Rahan Beach Club are well worth a visit. The beach club is located on a rocky outcrop, decorated in a fantasy/shipwreck style and the bar is very cool with spectacular views.

The weather was not at its best when we discovered Haad Salad (Salad beach) but we were most fortunate to find a great offer on Booking.com for the superb Salad Buri Resort. It is a good-sized resort with a comfortable beach restaurant, 3 swimming pools and direct beach access. The hotel and Salad beach became our comfortable home for 4 nights which is quite unusual for us as we generally change hotels/resorts every day!

Also on the beach is a thatched roof massage establishment. There is nothing better than having a professional massage with just the sea breezes to cool you.

North of Haad Salad we explored Mae Haad Beach and the curious sandbar out to Koh Ma. From Mae Haad Beach it is just a short drive to Ao Chaioklum beach and its selection of fish restaurants overlooking the bay. Now in full exploration mode we headed to Haad Kkom and the road twisted and the gradients were spectacular with scenic views that were impressive along the way.

We then followed the road along towards one of the most beautiful little beaches in Thailand, Haad Khom. With just 2 small resorts of bungalows directly on the edge of the beach this must be what most people can only dream about.



The next bay is Ao Thong Nai Pan Yai which has managed to avoid the onslaught of International hotels and features simple resorts all directly on the beach. Returning towards Thongsala we turned left at the roundabout towards a series of waterfalls. There are some places to park and walk down, again quite steep and at the Phu Dang waterfall you can swim in the clear water.

Follow the falls to the end of the road and you come to the Deang Waterfall, and as the river flows into the sea the vista of Haad Than Sadet beach suddenly opens through the foliage.

Probably one of the most enchanting beaches that I have visited, there is an excellent little bar, lovely white sand and an impressive, surrealistic bamboo bridge over the small river. From There we drove on to Haad Rin Nok beach, the location of the notorious Full Moon Parties. The 'avenue' to the beach is littered by boarded up shops but the beach itself is actually impressively beautiful.




Finishing on a high, our exploration of the island was complete and it was time to book the ferry for Koh Samui. What are my impressions of Koh Phangan? It is well worth a visit; the scenery and beaches are truly spectacular. It is probably the least Thai place that I have visited. Very few Traditional Thai greetings and not so many smiles, as the majority of the staff are from Myanmar. Not a criticism, purely an observation. The people on the island are a mix of modern-day hippies, bohemians, yoga aficionados, vegetarians, vegans, partygoers and couples blending together like one of the island's smoothies. Be prepared for steep gradients on the road and if you do ride a motorbike, please wear a helmet as it is not easy to drive. Otherwise enjoy and bask in the glory of this island paradise!
