





FRIDAY NIGHT AT THE SPORTSMAN

Discover Pattaya went along to the Sportsman for their "All you can Eat Pizza, Pasta and Salad Buffet" to find out what you get for the price of 249 Baht. We sat down at the opening time of 6pm, (it goes through until 10pm) and the place was already busy with people who had come for the buffet. It would surely get busier later into the evening, and given what we discovered about the food on offer, that is no surprise.











The pizzas appeared on the dot at six to be as fresh as possible. Thin crust with various toppings including Margarita, Pepperoni, Meat Feast and the excellent BBQ Chicken, none were skimped on, and all were really full of flavour. The spaghetti and fusilli pastas were accompanied with a choice of Cheese, Carbonara, Bolognese, and Tomato sauces. We definitely recommend the cheese sauce because The Sportsman is always particularly good at that.

However, what really set the food apart for one of our party, was the quality of the salads and sides on offer. You can get a pretty poor show at some places with their so called "salad bars", but not here. The coleslaw, pasta and potato salads were excellent, plus garlic bread, olives and again well presented with a good selection of accompanying sauces. Of course, it's our job to advertise but I was personally quite taken aback by the quality of the food and the excellent, friendly service. Remember, this is just for a price of 249 Baht and really is all you can eat - it doesn't stop coming!

Another offer on Fridays is the 2 for 1 cocktail deal. Now, as I'm sure you know, you can come a serious cropper in Pattaya by ordering cocktails from a place that has no idea how to make them. So, we tried the Sportsman on two classics, a Margarita and a Bloody Mary. The Margarita was not too sweet (often a mistake) and the Bloody Mary thick, delicious and with all the accompanying essential extras of Tabasco, Worcester Sauce and pepper. As prices range from around 145 to 195 baht this is a great offer especially as they don't insist on you having to buy 2 the same.

All in all, we can thoroughly recommend the whole Friday night experience. The manager keeps right on top of things so the food is brought out fresh and in good time and the staff are great. I'm going again very soon and you should get along too!







Another important factor to consider is the school's location and transportation options. Pattaya is a sprawling city, and traffic can be challenging during peak hours. Take the time to research your options carefully and choose a school that aligns with your child's needs, interests and goals. HER Planet Earth Team Embarks on a Triple Challenge in Switzerland to put the Spotlight on Climate Action for Refugees.







In June 2023, a self-funded team of 12 women, under the banner of HER Planet Earth, will embark on a unique triple-challenge, which will incorporate mountain climbing, biking and stand-up paddle boarding across one of Europe's most challenging destinations, Switzerland. The expedition will include summiting an alpine peak at close to 3,000m in the Furka Pass, biking 100km across mountainous areas and crossing an icy lake on SUP boards. The objective of this is to raise awareness and donations for one of the most underfunded humanitarian crises in the world: the Rohingya refugee emergency.

The team which includes 3 ladies from Thailand: Cindy Sirinya Bishop, Nin Viraviadya and Pear Viracha, will aim to raise a total of \$50,000 USD to support a UNHCR Environmental programme in Bangladesh which includes reforestation, human-elephant contact management and youth-led climate action training activities.

Why Bangladesh?

Rohingya refugees fled the violence in Myanmar at a staggering rate in 2017 – and the numbers keep growing. Bangladesh is home to Kutupalong – the largest and most densely populated refugee settlement in the world.

Bangladesh is extremely vulnerable to the impacts of climate change. Many of the refugees' makeshift shelters, are built on deforested, unstable hillsides, providing little protection against tropical storms of increasing intensity. Last year flooding and landslides forced 24,000 refugees to abandon their homes.



Also the refugee site lies along one of the Asian elephants' main migratory routes between Myanmar and Bangladesh. Behaviorally, elephants always follow their traditional routes and if they find any obstacles within it, they may charge when they feel threatened. This can be terrifying to those who encounter them. and since 2017, 14 people have died due to contact with elephants. To mitigate this issue, UNHCR and its partners have trained over 884 refugees and host communities to understand how to deal with elephants when they enter the camps.

The Team's Journey

For this expedition the team will begin the journey from Lugano and cycle from Coglio-Castlerotto, heading up through the small villages of Malcontone and Arosio. The women will then start the descent from Arosio and wind their way around the 19-hairpin bends to Agno. The next day the team will hike in Ticino in the Western Alps, from Monte Lema to Monte Tamaro. They will continue the next few days, on bikes to reach the Gotthard Pass, before continuing to Andermatt. In the last few days, the women will attempt to summit Chli Bielenhorn peak at 2,940m part of the iconic Furka Pass, in the Swiss Alps with deep valleys, and twisting hairpin turns to the oldest glacier in the Alps. This will all be challenging because of the complexity involved in hiking and mountaineering on rock, snow, and ice. Finally, the team will stand up paddle board across Lake Brienz and ride bikes from Interlaken to the Lauterbrunnen valley.

Founder and CEO, Christine Amour-Levar says "HER Planet Earth's objective is to inspire people to go beyond their comfort zones for a certain period while pushing their limits to rally support for a worthy cause. At the core of our culture is a commitment to empowering underprivileged people, a passion for adventure and a deep respect and love of nature. HER Planet Earth seeks to take participants on pioneering expeditions around the world so that they can make new discoveries, flourish as individuals, and most importantly, contribute to society. The team hopes to bring international attention to the need for societies, governments, and corporations to get involved and help support climate action and women's empowerment,"







As it celebrates its 10th anniversary, Asiamarine has added Swan and Silent-Yachts to a portfolio of brands including Galeon, Bali and Nimbus, while growing its regional network of Fraser superyacht brokers from Hong Kong to Singapore and Thailand. As excited as CEO Eric Noyel is about both new brands and moving into new sectors of the yachting market, he's clear that motor yacht powerhouse Galeon remains Asiamarine's flagship brand, as it has been since 2016. "Galeon remains our anchor brand, followed by Bali and Nimbus, while Swan and Silent are complementary because they're focused on different but growing segments," says Noyel, who founded Asiamarine in March 2013.

Asiamarine sold and delivered its first Galeon in the Philippines last year, with the 460 Fly followed by a 325 GTO later in the year. Thailand also welcomed its first 500 Fly, Galeon's iconic 'transformer' model that made the brand a household name, while Singapore welcomed its first new 500 Fly in late 2021. To date, Asiamarine has sold over 60 Galeon yachts in the region. Whilst still a new name in Asia, there are now enough clients who have shown they're happy to buy a Galeon motor yacht.

Galeon has collaborated with UK-based Tony Castro Yacht Design for over two decades and is best known for its iconic 'beach mode' models popularised by the 500 Fly and its drop-down wings, waterside bar and transformable outdoor areas. It was followed by the 460 Fly, 640 Fly, 400 Fly, the 440 Fly last year and the 560 Fly that debuted at this year's Miami International Boat Show. However, Noyel is most excited about the brand's new flagship, the 800 Fly, which debuted at the Fort Lauderdale International Boat Show last October.

The Frenchman has been aboard and believes the boat would make a strong impression in Asia. "The boat is massive, and the quality of the interior styling has gone up a lot. It's a really nicely executed 83ft yacht and competitively priced. It's also a Category A boat, so you can take it offshore, which makes it stand out from most of the competition in that size range," says Noyel, who believes the model is priced at least 20 per cent below competitors. "It's a great boat for Asia and a very good first 'regional' model for someone who wants a longer range and to explore other countries."

Asiamarine has also moved into the world of sailing monohulls with Swan, one of the industry's most iconic brands. Noyel, who grew up sailing in the south of France, is excited about the potential of the premium brand, "My hopes for Swan are huge. Firstly, because I think the sailing market is coming back to life very strongly. The ratio of sailing yachts versus motor yachts has increased for the first time in over a decade and that applies across all sizes including superyachts," he says. "Secondly, the Swan brand has an immense following among experienced sailors in Asia who know it from its international reputation. Swan has been a bit quiet in Hong Kong and Southeast Asia, but I anticipate the brand will catch up in two to three years"

As if that wasn't enough, Asiamarine is also taking its first steps in representing Silent-Yachts in Hong Kong, Singapore and Thailand. The first few units of the Silent 60 were built in Thailand and have been delivered to Europe and the US, and although other builders have moved or are moving into the sector, Asia is still awaiting its first solar-electric catamaran. That is until 2024, when Noyel says the first Silent 62 3-Deck will be delivered to this region. "I think solar-electric powercats are going to be very much in demand so in anticipation of that, we wanted to work with Silent-Yachts,"

As well as being CEO of Asiamarine, Noyel is Managing Director of Fraser Asia, whose sales have been spearheaded by Adam Blackmore, Asiamarine's Commercial Director and a Sales Broker for Fraser since 2018. "It really helps to have a team of Sales Brokers for Fraser, while all our other Asiamarine staff can help them when they have a lead or yacht to sell. A very positive development is the resumption of international charter "We did more charter bookings in January and February this year than we did across 2021 and 2022!"

Asiamarine has a lot to look forward to in its second decade No wonder the company's annual party looked so much fun.

RORY MCILROY AND THE MAJORS

When Rory McIlroy won the fourth of his major titles in the US PGA championship at Valhalla in Kentucky in 2014, the great Jack Nicklaus said "Rory is an unbelievable talent. I think he can win 15 or 20 majors or whatever he wants to do if he wants to keep playing. I love his swing".

Coming up to nine years later, and we're still waiting for that fifth major. This question always arises after the Masters in April, when the spotlight falls on McIlroy because a win at the Masters would give him the "career grand slam", meaning he would have won all of the four majors played each year at some stage in his career, putting him into some rare company indeed. Only Walter Hagen, Ben Hogan, Gary Player, Jack Nicklaus and Tiger Woods have completed the task of joining one of the most exclusive clubs in golf.

Rory's record in the Masters looks good on paper, with 7 top ten finishes, including 5 top fives. Looking back on it though, he has never been in the hunt for the title and even when he finished 2nd in 2022 behind Scottie Scheffler he was running through beaten horses, with Scheffler never looking like he was going to be overhauled.

Going into the 2023 tournament, their wasn't a golf pundit around who didn't think that McIlroy wouldn't be there or thereabouts for the title. He went into the tournament in good form and conditions were said to be perfect for his high ball style power hitting. But he was awful, and after battling through a distinctly average level par first round he capitulated on the second day with a 5 over par 77 to miss the cut. You have to remember that the Masters field is only 84 strong compared to the 144 or thereabouts that start in other majors, and about 30 of them have no chance. So missing the cut is a disaster for a player of Rory's ability.

It may be that the huge amount of speculation in the press and on social media about Rory's quest for the career grand slam may be taking its toll. This obviously adds to the pressure but the role that Rory has taken on, which is to be a sort of unofficial spokesman for the PGA players in its long running dispute with LIV Golf, may have also sidetracked him over the last two years.

This doesn't seem to stop him winning other high quality events though and only last year he became the first player ever to win three FedEx cups, surpassing even Tiger Woods on the way to an 18 million dollar bonus.

It just seems to be the major championships that give Rory problems and there is no doubt that a player of his talent should win more titles, especially given the four-in-three year stretch from 2011 until 2014 that kickstarted his career.

I think the Masters will always be a problem for him but I can see him winning at least one, especially as he gets older and the spotlight dims somewhat. Both Tiger and Jack have proved that great golfers, even as they age, can still plot their way around Augusta and win.

I also believe that the loss of the 2022 British Open to a magical Cam Smith last round after leading really hurt McIlroy and took some getting over.

Discover Motoring is going to take a look at some of the new model vehicles that are, or will be, on sale in Thailand very soon. We'll start this month with the new power truck from Ford. A word of warning about the new Ford Ranger, if you're concerned about the environment, look away now!

FORD RANGER RAPTOR

Ford have two versions of their latest Raptor Ranger truck on the market. The diesel version, and the one that everyone wants, The turbocharged V6 petrol variant. The petrol edition is more expensive than the diesel and of course the diesel vehicle is better economically, but buyers don't care.

When details of the new range became public knowledge their was an outcry on social media about the environmental impact of such a vehicle, but not from anybody who wanted to buy it. This second generation V6 3 litre vehicle is officially the most expensive truck on the market, coming in at a hefty 1.9 million Baht. But that hasn't stopped the orders flying in. As far as the Thai market is concerned, bigger and faster is better.

The twin turbo V6 3.0 litre engine produces 397bhp and the drive is much smoother than any diesel powered vehicle can hope to be. But here's the problem. Ford are saying that the average fuel economy is around 11.5kpl. This sounds optimistic to me and probably is, judging by the comments from the first buyers of the truck, who are saying that you can drop to near supercar levels of consumption if you hit the throttle too often.



Some people have mentioned a figure of around 5kpl, which I think exaggerates the other way somewhat but still makes this a very expensive runner.





The new model has a host of high-tech features in the cab including a top quality Bang & Olufsen sound system and a full digital 12.4 inch instrument readout.

The brakes are discs all round and are considered the best on the market at the moment, especially for a near two ton truck. So, if you can work your way around the high fuel consumption and are willing to pay the high entry price, this is what you'll get







STEPS IN SETTING UP A BUSINESS IN THAILAND

1. DECIDE ON YOUR BUSINESS STRUCTURE

You may register a business as Limited Company, Sole Proprietorship, Partnership, or Board of Investment Promotions. Thai Limited Company is the most popular structure and ideally the first step in setting up a company in Thailand. A Thai Limited Company is majority-owned by Thai nationals, owning at least 51% of company shares.

2. IDENTIFY YOUR DIRECTOR(S) AND SHAREHOLDERS

A Thai limited company has to consist of 1 or more directors. They can either be Thai or foreigner. You should have a minimum of 2 shareholders to establish a Thai Limited Company and Partnership.

3. RESERVE A COMPANY NAME

The name you select for your business must be unique. It cannot be identical with any registered Thai company, whether it be in English or Thai. Be ready to provide 3 or more proposed business names.

4. REGISTER YOUR COMPANY

Prepare all the necessary registration paperwork and then register your business at the Department of Business Development (DBD).

5. OBTAIN SPECIAL PERMITS AND LICENSES

It is a requirement for some enterprises to secure a special license from other government agencies, depending on the nature of its business operation. These include: Food License, Alcohol and Cigarette License, Entertainment License, Import License, etc.

6. VISA AND WORK PERMIT APPLICATION FOR FOREIGN WORKERS

All foreign workers in Thailand must hold the proper visa and a valid work permit issued by the Ministry of Labor. There is a mandatory requirement for a minimum number of Thai employees per foreign employee, depending on the status of the company. The standard ratio is 4 Thai employees to 1 foreign employee. Moreover, a company can hire one foreigner for every 2,000,000 Baht registered paid-up capital.

7. CORPORATE INCOME TAX AND SOCIAL SECURITY FUND REGISTRATION

You need to make sure that your employees are registered in the Social Security Fund System and must therefore submit monthly contributions. You must apply for and get a business corporate tax ID card from the Revenue Department within 60 days of incorporation or the start of business operations.

8. OPENING COMPANY BANK ACCOUNT.

Companies can open a corporate bank account in Thailand.

9. MONTHLY ACCOUNTING

Accurate bookkeeping records must be maintained. Tax filings and employee social security contributions must be made on a monthly basis.

10. ANNUAL BALANCE SHEET

It is extremely important that companies prepare and submit the balance sheets at least once every twelve months. Such a twelve-month period constitutes the company's accounting period or financial year. A newly established company should, therefore, close accounts within 12 months from its registration. It is important that a qualified external auditor certifies the accounts and the officer must file with the Revenue Department and Department of Business Development every year. You must file the company balance sheet within 150 days after the end of its accounting period.

You should seek legal counsel for the precise actions that your company needs to undertake. 
I. – THE FUTURE OF MUSIC?

When 'Napster', a peer to peer file sharing application, reared it's ugly head on June 1st 1999, it heralded the demise of the music business as I'd known it. Throughout the following years, sales of CDs declined and illegal downloading increased to the point where the general public were, mistakenly, of the opinion they were getting bargains in the form of new free music. This led to established record labels merging and the number of 'majors' decreasing meaning small, or indeed, no investment in upcoming talent. Suddenly, many were complaining about the lack of new creative inventive music that they had grown up with. Today, the music business is completely different with revenue levels diminished and digital platforms ruling.

Myself, as a writer, can still receive 'performance' royalties as before but as far as 'mechanical' income goes (i.e. sales), as an artist, we have to look for alternative methods of music distribution.



Artificial Intelligence (A.I.), is right now the latest revolution for many industries including the music industry. A.I. has the potential to transform the way music is created, produced and consumed. It can generate music after analyzing vast amounts of data and identify patterns and create music that sounds like it was composed by humans.



Furthermore, A.I. is transforming the way streaming services like Spotify and Apple Music use algorithms to analyze user's listening habits. This means homoginising what you, the consumer, gets to hear and be offered in the guise of new and creative music. Some critics, including myself, worry that A.I. generated music will lack the emotional depth of music created by humans and that real musicians and artists will be replaced. This is already happening with A.I. creations sounding like new material from artists like Oasis and Drake, with a fake Drake track, according to Drake fans, sounding better than his originals. This then means his record label don't need him anymore and can save on paying him royalties (thoughts & prayers please).

I've always known a saying in the music business, 'where there's a hit, there's a writ'. I believe that music lawyers all over the world are now licking their lips at the amount of litigation that will be coming their way.

The loser in all of this will undoubtedly be us, the real creative artists and you, the consuming public who from now on will have no idea if what you are hearing is real or fake. We all already experience this on a daily basis with photoshopped images and filtered Instagram photos, especially from the females of our species...yes you know


who you are. So, welcome to the new world of fantasy which will undoubtably lead to job losses and an impossible grasp of what is real in the world.

To test the usefulness of A.I., I have utilized it for my next project. I was flabbergasted at the speed and quality of what was offered to me.

Now, as a successful songwriter of forty years, I've learned a thing or two about lyrics and can reveal that most of the lines A.I. gave to me were not useful. However, I can admit that there's a few ideas that might 'influence' my final composition.

I believe that using A.I. to help in the same way as Dictionarys, Thesaurus and Google have done, can only be a step forward. However, be very scared of the gradual take over of us as a human race by the devilishly evil higher power that is Artificial Intelligence. (cue - dramatic apocalyptic A.I. generated music).



Prompt engineers and courses in prompt engineering are now springing up in response to this.

Amongst the disadvantages discussed were: privacy concerns for customers' data, lack of nuance and up to the minute information (current cut-off date for ChatGPT is end 2021) so recent amendments or information will not be covered. Also, there is a real worry that through dependency and reliance on the ease of using this tool, users may take the text verboten and not read through to make edits which is essential as the Al can make errors and repeat itself if not properly checked.



BATTERSEA POWER STATION 2023

Built during the 1930s, Battersea Power Station has long been an important London landmark. It was designed by Sir Giles Gilbert Scott who was responsible for Liverpool Cathedral and also designing the country's famous red telephone boxes.

For nearly a century the decommissioned coal-fired power station, with its four towering chimneys, remained a fixture of the city's skyline. Made famous by Pink Floyd who used it on the cover of their seminal album "Animals" (complete with flying pig), it seemed that no one knew what to do with this iconic building.





That was until a consortium of Malaysian investors purchased it in 2012 and officially opened their new development a decade later. The total cost for this has been given as more than £9 billion with the centrepiece being the transformation of the power station itself. So now, after years of disuse, the power station has been transformed into a mixed-use development that is one of the capital's most exciting new areas.

During a recent trip to London, I decided to take a look for myself via the new purpose built Northern line extension linking Nine Elms to the new Battersea Power Station underground. Incidentally, this is the first new station to be built in London in over 20 years!

I was duly impressed at how the developers kept the Grade II listed exterior. This extended to appointing two of the companies who produced the original 6 million bricks when a further 1.75 million were needed. Using the same clay and hand-throwing techniques that they had last century, they were also required to match the new bricks perfectly to the shades of the originals.

The interior of the power station has been reimagined as "Electric Boulevard", which is in fact some rather high-end retail outlets. Notable brands include Ralph Lauren, Under Armour, Jo Malone, Hugo Boss, Abercrombie & Fitch, Rolex and Paul Smith. There are also the more expected retailers such as Marks and Spencer, Uniqlo and the most stunning Zara store ever.



There is also a new park situated along the banks of the River Thames designed to be sustainable, inclusive, and diverse. Certainly, it is a haven for dog walkers - I have never seen so many Dachshunds in one place! Most of the popular dining destinations like Wright Brothers, Gordon Ramsay, Bread Street Kitchen, Street Pizza, Megan's and Fiume, to name but a few, have bowls of water inside and out for four-legged guests.






When you're next in London go take a look. The Power Station is open from 10 am to 8pm Monday – Thursday, 10 am – 9pm Friday and Saturday, and 12pm to 6pm on Sunday As well as access via the new Northern Line extension you might also want to try getting there by using London's River Bus. operated by Thames Clippers



LONDON CROWNED WORLD'S BEST CITY BRAND



London has been named the best city brand in the world, followed by New York and Paris, by the inaugural Brand Finance City Index. The ranking is based on a global survey of close to 15,000 members of the public conducted in April 2023 in 20 countries on all continents to measure perceptions of the world's top 100 cities. With a score of 84.6 out of 100, driven by its high familiarity among respondents worldwide, London has recorded stronger brand perceptions than any other city in the study.

To arrive at a comprehensive assessment of the city brands in the ranking, alongside measuring familiarity, the survey asked the respondents about the general reputation and their personal consideration of each city as a place to live, work locally, work remotely, study, retire, visit, or invest in. The evaluation of preferences across these seven dimensions was complemented by perceptions of 45 underlying city brand attributes, grouped under seven pillars, such as Business & Investment or Sustainability & Transport.

Crowned as the overall winner, London ranks 1st in two of the seven key dimensions – study and visit – as well as in the top 4 in all other ones. London is ranked as the best city globally to study. The British capital hosts top universities – such as University College London, King's College London, Imperial College London, and the London School of Economics, while prestigious schools in and near London that prepare for university – like Eton and Harrow –attract students from around the world. It is no surprise that the city comes 1st globally for great universities and great private schools.

As a result, NYC ranks as the 2nd best city in the world to visit.

Paris rounds off the podium, coming 3rd in the ranking with a Brand Finance City Index score of 79.7 out of 100. Paris is also ranked as the world's 2nd most familiar city boasting an abundance of renowned attractions, including the Eiffel Tower, the Louvre Museum, and the Moulin Rouge, Ranking 1st across the Middle East & Africa, Dubai comfortably makes the top 10 of the world's best-perceived cities. The 'City of Gold' is a major shopping destination for jewellery and has performed well across multiple Business & Investment attributes, ranking 1st for future growth potential, 2nd in strong and stable economy, and 3rd behind only New York and London as a city of global significance.

From Australia, Sydney ranks 5th overall, standing out as the best city to live in and 2nd best to work and retire in. Singapore boasting strongest perceptions globally for startups and innovations and Tokyo ranking 1st as the global leader in science and technology.

Phnom Penh, Cambodia, is a Hot, Fun Place!

You can easily make a holiday trip out of going to Phnom Penh. It's "hot" as in exciting! When we were there it was really hot though. We braved the heat by hydrating with sugar cane juice and fresh coconut water, from sellers dotted throughout the city. It's really a fun place to visit and just a short flight from Bangkok. During our week's stay, we never ran out of things to do in this magical Cambodian city along the Mekong River.



Phnom Penh isn't what it used to be, just a decade ago. No more dusty roads with a hint of danger; now it's a mix of old and new. You see tall buildings right beside the shorter, older ones. It feels safe, clean. Modern buildings, yet still plenty of street food, with parks and happier people than we remember from a visit some years ago. Walking around, we found lots of family food stalls with delicious food and beverages – as well as craft beer and cocktails in cozy cafes and bars. People are mingling and socializing everywhere. It felt good to see the world traveling again. Phnom Penh is a happening place, a paradise for food and drink choices. There are expats meeting at unique expat events and for those needing it, it is a perfect place for a visa run.

You can see heritage sites, such as the Royal Palace and the Silver Pagoda, take walks, enjoy comedy and other entertainment, or just have a beautiful ride on a sightseeing boat. It's a pleasure meeting people all over Phnom Penh, sometimes called "PP." We loved it all.

Arriving at the fully modernized Phnom Penh Airport (PNH) is convenient and easy from Bangkok, just over an hour's flight. Our adventure began with the tuk-tuk ride into the center of the city to our hotel. After settling in with our bags, we checked into our hotel, the Artist Residence, to explore and found much to see and do. We decided the rooms were so-so, but the coffee shop downstairs was worth being there. Taking tuk-tuks around in the lively streets is fun, and you can order them on Grab now, without any annoying haggling. You just order them and they come to you, with the price set. It's a wild and fun way to get around.





One of our first nights included lots of laughs in a comedy club called The Box Office Craft Beer Bar. We saw traveling expat comic Trevor Lock entertain in an interactive show, with the audience hailing from all over the world. The Box Office served up some great food, but we especially enjoyed the double IPA craft beer. Afterwards, just a short walk away, we found and tried bagels at Cambodia Bagels. We thought of our hometown in New York City as we ate them. They may as well just call them New York bagels, since they are the best we have had outside of N.Y.C. Wow, that was yummy.

Our favorite cup of coffee was at the little vintage lobby of The Artist Residence, where we ordered the delicious long black (or Americano). It's right near the impressive Hyatt Regency. And each time we sat here, we found expat travelers to have a chat with and get a few tips. One told us about some great Vietnamese coffee at the "Ha Noi

Corner" where everything was authentic Vietnamese.

To eat we went to Soga Cafe, Bistro & School, open from 6 am to 10 pm where we ordered carrot ginger soup and a big, beautiful gourmet salad. In our salad were bok choy, pomegranate, corn, green and yellow zucchini, yellow squash, tomatoes, grilled red pepper, mango, and cooked pumpkin cubes. The Kobe dressing was a blend of cubed carrots, sliced ginger, soy sauce, sesame oil, garlic, white onion, black pepper and lime juice. The French chef and owner said he absolutely loves Phnom Penh, as we do now.

We felt so good eating healthy and fresh food here. It was one of the best salads we have had in a long time, with so many great ingredients. Chef Olivier Guerrapin chatted with us about his career, French fusion foods, and how he landed in the capital city and started this popular cooking school and restaurant. Another great place to eat is Padang Nusantara, an Indonesian restaurant by the river and full of Indonesian people. They told us that the food was as authentic as it can get. We had coconut rice, cassava green leaves, crispy tempe, and potato and vegetable fritters with red and green chile sauces.

We then went back in fact walking, and tuk-tuks became our routine for getting around Phnom Penh. Anybody can order a tuk-tuk and know what the price is by using the apps. We would choose far-off destinations, just so we could sightsee along the way. A NEW BANGKOK INNOVATION DISTRICT SPRINGS UP IN AN UNLIKELY LOCATION

Cloud 11 is part of the South Sukhumvit innovation district near Udom Suk BTS station. Those who haven't ventured past the On Nut BTS station in a few years may be surprised to find out what's happening in this part of Bangkok.

A flurry of activity has seen new condominiums and a handful of office buildings pop up here in recent times. However, one developer is taking things a step further by establishing an innovation district in this unlikely location. The ever-ambitious MQDC recently unveiled Cloud 11 which is being positioned as Asia's largest hub for content creators. It is part of what is being dubbed the South Sukhumvit innovation district that also features the developer's True Digital Park. "We have always honoured our 'For All Well-Being' philosophy with our property projects that



enhance the lives of all on a sustainable basis," Khun Visit Malaisirirat, Chief Executive Officer of MQDC, said. "Every MQDC project delivers benefits to local communities, the public, and the country, as it is developed with innovations, advanced technologies, and concepts in line with national development policies. We have invested in the Cloud 11 project to create an innovation cluster for newgen and creative innovation in South Sukhumvit."

True Digital Park and Cloud 11 will essentially be across the street from one another as part of the innovation district that can be found between the Udom Suk and Bang Chak BTS stations. It's not the first place that springs to mind when people think of cutting-edge business, but these two mixed-use developments are changing that.

For MQDC, the key to its new project was ensuring it was complimentary to what was already available. So, while True Digital Park is billed as a startup ecosystem, Cloud 11 is focused on an "Empowering Creators" concept that centres around being a hub for the next generation of content creators.

"Cloud 11 not only has physical facilities to comprehensively fulfil the needs of content creation and new-gen lifestyles, but it will also give inspiration, knowledge and growth opportunities to creators, content-based enterprises, and related businesses," Khun Onza Janyaprasert, Project Director of Cloud 11, detailed. "We expect Cloud 11 to empower Thai creators and bring them to the global market. Also, we truly hope that our project will contribute to efforts to turn Thailand into a top global content provider." In addition to office and studio space, Cloud 11 will also contain two hotels, a retail zone, an event space and Bangkok's largest rooftop park. Work on the project began in 2022 and is slated to be finished by the end of next year.

The recovery of the tourism industry, driven in part by the reopening of China, is one of several positive indicators that the real estate market will recover from its slump in 2023, according to DDproperty.com, the official portal partner of the Awards.Phuket, among other bright spots throughout the country, has become a haven for international home buyers seeking refuge from conflict in Europe, and home buyers seeking working holidays have also flocked to Koh Pha Ngan, where they are fuelling a building boom for luxury properties.

The Price Index for residential properties in Phuket rose 8% QoQ in Q4 2022, buoyed by rising demand for townhouses (+4% QoQ and +25% YoY), according to DDproperty.com, the official portal partner of the Awards. A majority (32%) of residential properties in Phuket are priced greater than THB15 million.

Apart from the return of tourism, transport infrastructure developments are expected to continue galvanising the property market, according to the latest DDproperty Thailand Property Market Report. Fringe and outskirt areas of Bangkok with access to the SRT (Red Line), MRT (Blue Line) and BTS (Green Line) routes, in fact, recorded the highest Price Index growth in Q4 2022. Overall housing Demand Index in Bangkok in the fourth quarter of 2022 increased 47% from the pre-pandemic period (Q4 2019). The Price Index of residential property for sale in Bangkok is also likely to increase in 2023 while property seekers need to be ready for higher inflation and interest rates.


