

Parking alongside is not that plentiful but if you take the turning, to the left just before the coach terminus for Bangkok airport, you will drive through to View Talay 1 and all the parking you need to visit Nee's Food Mafia at building B.

This charming spot has friendly staff clad in lovely colourful uniforms ready to serve you an amazing array of food and beverages. Of course, there is excellent Thai food but even more unexpected a good range of excellent international dishes including pastas, gyros, excellent cold cuts and a particularly delicious Duck Liver Mousse, For the vegans amongst us they have a selection on the menu available for diners or interestingly to take away - as are all Nee's dishes.

You can sit in comfort - inside or on the terrace where portable state-of-the-art air coolers are on hand when the weather is warm. There is even a well-stocked cocktail bar from which I would recommend you try their Limoncello Margarita! Beers, spirits and some very pleasing wines including an excellent house white and red.

Prices for the food are reasonable with specials such Curry Wurst, Fried German Bratwurst with French Fries and Hot Curry Sauce just 145 baht. The staff are happy and friendly and the ambience rather charming as the night draws in and you sit and watch people to and fro from the View Talay buildings.



Nee herself is extremely helpful and you can contact her to make a reservation or food enquiries by telephoning 081 670 0006. I also recommend you follow Nee's Food Mafia on their Facebook page to be kept updated with the specials of the day and give yourself an excuse to keep calling back there!

Mr. Charles Grayhurst Head of School at St. Andrews International School, Green Valley

Interviewed by James Kemp, Deputy Head of School at The British Learning Centre

St. Andrews International School, Green Valley, sits nestled within the stunning forested hills of Rayong, surrounded by farmland and close to Rayong Green Valley Country Club. It is from this setting that St. Andrews draws its unique feel and much of its educational ethos. I met with their new Head of School, Mr. Charles Grayhurst, to discuss his vision for the school and its future.

Mr. Grayhurst took over at the helm of St. Andrews in September of last year, bringing with him 25 years of experience as an educator including headships in China, Dubai and Malaysia. With a background of establishing successful 'green' schools in Asia, his background makes him a perfect fit for St. Andrews. During my tour of the school and its grounds, it became clear to me that eco-literacy and an appreciation for sustainability and the natural world are not just buzzwords here, but deeply held values that are ingrained into school life.

Throughout our walk around, a feeling of light, space and being situated within the natural environment was evident. Mr. Grayhurst proudly pointed out the ambitious growing project that the school has begun, under his tenure, where local plants and crops are grown to become an active part of the student's learning experience: Lipstick Palm is being grown near the Art studios, where it will be used to create paint pigment; older students have self-funded a hydroponic growing project as a part of their business studies. The school's dedicated Forest School area has also recently seen an expansion to include an Outdoor classroom, enabling deeper opportunities for true outdoor education. All too often eco-literacy is delivered tokenistically; this is not the case at St. Andrews, where it is taught with enthusiasm, rigour and purpose to equip students with the knowledge, skills and competencies that they will need in an uncertain future. The school employs both an Outdoor Education Coordinator and Place-Based Education Coordinators, something which demonstrates its commitment to this style of learning.



Of course, academics remain a priority, and St Andrews maintains a strong tradition of top academic results and sending students to some of the top universities across the globe. As one walks around the school, there is the feeling that you are in a true international school, with students from a wide variety of backgrounds. With students from over 40 nationalities and highly qualified teachers who have worked around the world, the school truly is a diverse community. St. Andrews is a fully authorised IB PYP school that offers the Primary Years Programme (PYP) from the International Baccalaureate (IB), integrated with the British National Curriculum from Nursery to Year 11, followed by an IB programme in Year 12 and 13. The fact that they are the only PYP school in the region is not their only unique feature; they are also unique for offering an accredited Dutch Stream for families from the Netherlands. The IB programme sits well with the school's holistic approach, something that Mr. Grayhurst hopes to develop through expanding the school's already extensive extra-curricular programme and incorporating the Duke of Edinburgh Awards scheme more fully into the school curriculumng the school again in the near future.



Only 35 minutes from Pattaya, St. Andrews International School, Green Valley feels like it could be a world away. Students are given the space, both physical and within the curriculum, to explore and develop. This will be key as the school seeks to stand out among an increasingly competitive market where parents are, quite rightly, demanding more for their children and larger schools are seeking to establish themselves in the region.





How to Use Intermittent Fasting to Lose Weight After 40

Millions of men and women over the age of 40 struggle to shed their excess pounds, despite trying every type of diet and working out every week. Often they have tried low-carb, high-fat diets, counting calories, 'juicing' etc. etc. but often the problem is that after losing a few pounds their food cravings take over. They ruin weeks of effort by just giving up and putting the weight back on. This weight loss "rollercoaster" can feel very discouraging but the problem is usually that these diets are extreme and hard to sustain over the long term because they're overly restrictive. What tend to have longer term benefits are the diets that don't feel like diets. The ones that don't create resistance from our body, such as food cravings, hunger, or mood swings. For example regimes such as intermittent fasting.

Unlike what many people think, fasting doesn't mean that we should starve ourselves. It just means we should carefully choose WHEN we eat instead of being obsessed with WHAT we eat.

You can eat pretty much whatever type of food you want, as long as you're eating the right quantity of food at the right time. The way intermittent fasting works is pretty simple: After fasting for more than 12 hours, our body has depleted all its glucose reserves and is forced to burn fat to find energy. When this fat burning "metabolic switch" is on, it is easier to lose weight without having to eat salad all day.

A recent study from Cambridge University has shown that our body starts burning fat about 25% faster after 13 hours of fasting as insulin levels in our blood drop, allowing our bodies to burn more fat as fuel. This is also helpful for patients who are insulin resistant, meaning their bodies make more insulin than normal.

Dr. Angela Fitch, MD, FACP, FOMA, Associate Director of the Massachusetts General Hospital Weight Center says "It takes 10 to 12 hours to use up the calories in the liver before a metabolic shift occurs to using stored fat. After meals, glucose is used for energy and fat is stored in fat tissue, but during fasts, once glucose is depleted, fat is broken down and used for energy."

"Many things happen during intermittent fasting that can protect organs against chronic diseases like type 2 diabetes, heart disease, age-related neurodegenerative disorders, even inflammatory bowel disease and many cancers."

Dr. Mark Mattson, a neuroscientist at John Hopkins University, who studied intermittent fasting for 25 years says "When people lose weight, typically 75% is fat loss and 25% is muscle mass. But with fasting, the ratio actually changes so that 90% of weight loss is fat and 10% is muscle."

However, while many doctors agree on the effectiveness of intermittent fasting in helping us lose weight, many people don't know how to integrate this diet in their daily life. It's also important to remember each of us has a unique metabolism. So if we want to lose fat, we either need to consult a doctor or nutritionist for a tailor-made plan suited to our needs. Or we can simply experiment with timings ourselves to see what suits our lifestyle and food preferences. Certainly worth giving a go!

When an electric catamaran glides past at high speed and without any noise, it might look like a modernist piece of architecture that got bored just standing around and decided to travel the world. But the real beauty lies in the underlying physics Equations. Catamarans and trimarans have a lighter construction and are more efficient than conventional monohull boats, which is true of both small day cruisers and 30m-plus bluewater catamarans. This is a major advantage for electric propulsion systems, as less power is required to propel the boat. It also means the capacity of the batteries can be better utilised and the range of the boat increased.

During long ocean crossings, the captain and crew of high-tech, high-performance catamarans are on their own. This is why it's essential that the crew, the yacht and its operating system are synchronised. Electric bluewater catamarans like the OE72 are cruising R&D labs for testing new materials and systems.

Ultimately, the larger maritime community profits from the innovation – just like the Apollo programme in the 1960s brought us freeze-dried food and modern solar cells. Only a couple of years ago, electric-hybrid propulsion was a feat only realised for a select few custom-made sailing yachts. Today, Deep Blue Hybrid is a ready-to-use solution for a much broader target group. The same goes for innovations like the automatic hydrogeneration mode of Torqeedo electric motors, which uses smart algorithms to find the highest torque the propeller can run at any given time so maximising the energy yield.

After last month's review of the Ford Ranger Raptor we thought we would take a look at something more practical for the family this month and the 2023 Mitsubishi Xpander Cross fits the bill. First introduced in Thailand in 2018, the latest upgrade seems to be more substantial than the first facelift in 2020 and the latest changes in 2022.

The exterior changes include a higher ride height which allows for 17-inch alloy wheels with bigger tyres and a more rugged styling on the front and rear bumpers, door furniture and wheel arches.

The front end features a new design with LED headlights, daytime lights, turning lights and fog lamps. At the back end the redesigned tailgate is flanked by LED rear lights.

The interior has leather seat upholstery finished in black and navy blue and a new leather wrapped steering wheel with a chunkier feel and numerous multi-function control switches. Other features include a 9-inch centre touchscreen with Apple car play/Android auto, USB-A and USB-C charging ports, a 12v power socket and rear air-conditioning.





Looking at safety, Mitsubishi have added its Active Yaw Control (AYC) system which according to them controls the driving and braking forces between the front wheels, improving the cornering performance and stability, especially on wet or slippery roads which is a big help in Thailand.

They have also said that the suspension has been improved to facilitate a more comfortable and stable ride.

This seven seater mini MPV comes with 1.5 litre four-cylinder petrol engine which generates 105bhp.

With a retail price of 946,000 Baht, this versatile ride gives you the chance to break into the MPV market and enjoy the benefits of a seven seat, multi-purpose vehicle without breaking the bank, especially as the Xpander has been officially recognised as the most fuel efficient vehicle in its class. As a first buy to enter the MPV market, it comes highly recommended.






Shaun here from The Savage Fishing Channel. This month's report comes from Chiang Mai at the lovely Teak Tree Lake. Now Teak Tree Lake is widely regarded as a hidden gem in the Thai angling community boasting 5.5 rai of lake.

I came here targeting Giant Siamese Carp and was not disappointed.

Day 1 started with a bang on the waggler, we threw in some pellets in and around a shallow rig hoping to catch the Pacu & Tambaqui feeding early. Second cast at around 7.05 am resulted in our first fish of the trip: a nice 17lb Pacu to get the ball rolling. We then switched to a fixed line feeder for both Carp & Predator rods resulting in our next take which was a respectable 20lb Juliens Carp - a new species for me. At around noon the line ripped off, after a 15 minute fight (and some superb boat navigational skills) I landed a cracker of an Amazon Redtail Catfish weighing in at some 60lb. This was followed by a very similar-sized Redtail.

Day 2 spirits were high as we started with a belting 30lb Tambaqui on the waggler achieving a PB for me. This was duly followed with a superb Juliens Carp weighing in at 30lb.



CLOSING A COMPANY IN THAILAND

Closing a company requires strict compliance with the laws and regulations of the relevant Thai government agencies. Financial, auditing, and legal aspects of the company must be settled accordingly.

SHAREHOLDERS' MEETING AND SENDING NOTICE TO THE CREDITORS

A shareholders' meeting must be held to discuss the liquidation process and confirm the appointment of the liquidator(s). The liquidators have the authority to settle the affairs of the company, to pay its debts, and to allocate its assets. At least 14 days before the meeting, invitation letters must be published in the local press and distributed by registered mail to every shareholder of the company. Plus, the notice shall be sent to the creditors as well.

REGISTERING THE COMPANY DISSOLUTION

Within 14 days after the business's agreed closing date, the dissolution of the company and the names of the liquidators must be registered with the Department of Business Development (DBD), Ministry of Commerce.

The liquidators are required to produce the company's financial statement within 3 months, have the designated auditor evaluate and certify it, and then notify the public by placing an advertisement in a local newspaper declaring the company's liquidation to warn its creditors, if any.

LIQUIDATION

The stockholders' outstanding shares may need to be paid in full at once by the liquidators. If the liquidators discover that the assets are still not enough to cover the liabilities after the shares have been paid off, they must begin following up the debts.

VAT DE-REGISTRATION

The company must submit its tax return and pay any outstanding taxes. Companies that have registered for VAT must submit an application for VAT de-registration 15 days before their business closes, and they must also give their tax ID card and VAT Registration Certificate (Por Por 20) back to the Revenue Department.

FILING LIQUIDATION REPORTS AND REGISTERING THE COMPLETION OF LIQUIDATION PROCESS

Until the liquidation process is complete and the Revenue Department has sent the DBD a letter certifying that the company is tax-free, the liquidators must submit a report of their activities detailing the accounting of the liquidation process every three months. The DBD will then issue a document stating that the company has successfully concluded its liquidation.

FINAL SHAREHOLDER'S MEETING

The liquidator must call the final shareholders' meeting once all of the company's assets and obligations have been properly liquidated in order to deliver an account report of the liquidation outlining how the process was carried out and how the company's assets were disposed of. After the account report is approved, the liquidators have fourteen days from the meeting's date to register the proceedings with the DBD. This registration is viewed as the liquidation's conclusion. The balance sheets of the liquidated firm must be deposited with the DBD within fourteen days of the liquidation. There, they must be retained after the liquidation is complete and made available for public view. It is strongly advised to appoint a skilled legal team to promptly and efficiently handle this complex process.





CLASSICAL POP - Barry Upton

The influence of classical music in pop & rock music has had a profound effect throughout history. Complex harmonies, rich melodies and intricate arrangements of classical music can be observed in many songwriters' and performers' work. Orchestration that compliments words and music has been apparent since the fifties and especially in the sixties when artists such as the Beatles & The Beach Boys started experimenting with ways to incorporate orchestral instruments into their songs.

Classical music has also influenced popular music in terms of song structure. By drawing on the rich musical traditions of the past, pop & rock musicians have been able to create new and innovative sounds that continue to captivate audiences around the world. As an international hit pop writer and producer, I myself have been a great advocate of stealing, ...sorry, ...borrowing ideas from genius composers such as Mozart, Bach, Mendelssohn and so on.

This started whilst I was in chart toppers, The Brotherhood Of Man during the early eighties. Given a certain degree of freedom to play around in top studios with arrangements for new singles and albums, I seized upon the chance to augment our successful vocal sound with a string quartet (Eleanor Rigby style) and many other orchestral sounds played by the best session musicians. Suddenly synthesisers reared their heads and everyone started using them to the max instead of real sounds.

Recently, my interest in classical music has been reawakened by 'The Pattaya Classical Society' with leading light Gregory Barton who has built a superb music room at his 'Eelswamp' property, just outside of Pattaya, that can present performing musicians for around 30 guests, giving a feeling of times gone by with a chamber ensemble. He regularly presents performances from Russian pianists and an amazing Bangkok string quartet plus, on occasion, mesmorizing Indian classical music with Sitar and Tabla. I try to attend whenever I can as it is amazing how much inspiration I get from witnessing incredibly complex pieces of music performed by musicians...close up. My latest studio music project is a direct influence of absorbing such uplifting and impressive pieces from a variety of classical composers. Of course, coming from a commercial pop background, I felt that It should be my duty to try to find a way to integrate a couple of these famous writers of classic material into my own creation.

So, for months I have had an idea going around in my mind and now I'm finally painstakingly putting the whole thing together. There will be classical piano plus a string quartet and also a Thai classic guitar section mixed together with my usual pop sensibilities. Rhythm wise, there's a mixture of romantic ballad, country, bossa nova, reggae and surf guitar to compliment the classical themes expressed. My original creative piece (with a couple of 'borrowed' themes) clocks in at 20 minutes and 30 seconds which is far too long for radio play but really works as a creative standalone song. Obviously, I will have to do an edited version for radio but for the proposed accompanying video, the full-length version will be presented.

To top all this, my favorite part of the project is that the writing credits will show 'Upton/Beethoven/Tchaikovsky' and, as the other two writers passed on many, many years ago, I get to claim all of the performance royalties.....100%. The finished music and video will indubitably appear on my dedicated YouTube channel FAB BAZ MUSIC TV. 



DR: The market at Chatuchak will give you an adrenaline rush because it has a wide selection of woodworking, handy crafts, home décor, and pets. Almost anything can be found there. Another trendy place to visit would be the Train Night Market Ratchada. Big, vibrant outdoor market with music, featuring many vendors selling a variety of goods & food. Or go and explore the Patpong Museum. The Patpong Museum is a museum in Bangkok, Thailand. Opened in 2019 in Patpong Soi 2, its collection includes interactive exhibitions, artifacts, and recreated spaces covering Patpong's history from 1946.

IMMERSED IN RAJA AMPAT

Following earlier festivals along the Amazon River and in the Sahara Desert, the latest edition of Immersion was held in Raja Ampat, which provided a spectacular backdrop for an alluring cocktail of dancing and diving, meditation and music.

Isolated within the towering karsts of Raja Ampat, a commune of over 100 travellers have arrived by boat on Wayag Island. On this uninhabited and near-inaccessible atoll, the wayward wanderers are performing a cacao ceremony. Participants are gathered in a circle, praying, singing and meditating while sipping on the natural elixir sanctified by the ancient Aztecs and Mayans. This esoteric exercise, taking part in an unspoiled corner of the globe, is part of a New Age festival known as Immersion. It might seem like a scene straight out of Danny Boyle's film The Beach, but rather than gathering a group of backpackers in Thailand, Immersion has attracted these luxury charter guests to West Papua in east Indonesia.

Raja Ampat was the seventh Immersion gathering organised by Greg Habib, a French-Brazilian entrepreneur. Previous editions of the music and wellness event have taken place along the Amazon River, amid the dunes of the Sahara Desert and on the salt flats of Bolivia. Habib calls Immersion events an invitation to "immerse yourself in a cultural universe".

A festival that seeks to showcase epic locations off the beaten path, Immersion chose Raja Ampat this year for its spectacular natural beauty. However, Immersion events are more than just gatherings in beautiful locations. Immersion is a global community that aims to bring people together to experience new cultures, nature, music, gastronomy, self-knowledge and friendship, and to give back to the local community."



The six-day programme included a give-back initiative, encouraging participants to volunteer in a local village. The group then continued sailing around the archipelago and indulging in a variety of activities to fully experience the stunning scenery. Diving, snorkelling and feasting were complemented by holistic experiences such as sound healing rituals, primal movement sessions and massage therapies. Each day was followed by a hedonistic evening of dancing under the stars, be it on a beach or a boat, or in the water.







The guests represented over 40 different nationalities, with their ages ranging from six months to 73 years. Attendees were joined by a production crew, professional musicians and spiritual leaders, although Habib emphasises that there's little distinction between guests and staff at Immersion events. "We needed a partner who could understand and accommodate our complex needs, and Yacht Sourcing went above and beyond in helping us create an unforgettable experience for all participants," he says. "From negotiating and securing the perfect vessels, to assisting with logistics, menu planning and licensing requirements, Yacht Sourcing's understanding of the remote location of Raja Ampat was critical"

By the end of the event, Habib received feedback from guests "describing the experience as the most beautiful trip of their lives". The success of the festival, the support of the local Indonesian community and the pristine beauty of the region have encouraged Habib to consider returning for another edition of the festival in the future. "While Immersion is committed to exploring new locations, Raja Ampat is likely to be revisited due to its exceptional appeal," says Habib. "It's a destination that many people dream of visiting."


The Highlight of our Phnom Penh trip was a sunset boat ride. We really recommend taking a boat on the Mekong River and the price is so reasonable, especially if you don't book but just show up. There are many boats that leave at various times so we asked the price for one and then walked to the next one to compare. What a deal we got ...it was so cheap, around \$3 USD for each of us and the views atop the boat were spectacular.



While it's kind of a steep climb down to get into the boat and back up afterwards (you need to be careful) – it's all worth it. After the boat ride, we went to Grand River Sports Bar which faces the river and from where you can enjoy people-watching. Whilst sitting there and looking at all the tuk-tuks driving around we enjoyed a delicious green vegetable curry which reminded us of our favourite green curry back in Pattaya in the Jazz Pit at Sunsabella Classical Thai Restaurant. So good!

Then it was time for dessert. Who doesn't like an amazing dessert? Our favorite place for a treat was Backyard Cafe, where we went all out with scrumptious chocolate balls and chocolate pie, both desserts that we'll never forget. It felt so decadent and rich. It was definitely worth the stop at this outstanding restaurant only a short walk from there to the fascinating Russian Market.

This is the second biggest market area the biggest and more famous is Central Market) with stands of fresh and cooked foods. At the Russian market, we saw many people selling fruit and vegetables, all kinds of wares, and clothing of various brands, real and fake. A few other healthy restaurants we tried were the Maitreya Healthy Vegetarian Restaurant, with a great mushroom dish, Planta and Sacred Lotus Cafe, which had an all-day vegan breakfast available.





Whenever we could, we ordered fresh coconuts to drink from stands along the sidewalks. They're so hydrating and welcome in the Cambodian weather. Phnom Penh features a wealth of fresh and healthy drinks for the locals to enjoy throughout the day. Phnom Penh is also a great place for every range of lodging from hostels to top-of-the-line, even luxurious casino hotels, such as the beautiful Naga 2 Casino – which we enjoyed visiting. Jason decided \$100 was all he would be willing to lose at the Blackjack table, but at \$25/hand he lost that quick. But that is the risk one must accept.

We stayed at the mid-price Monsoon Bassac Hotel which is within walking distance of a lovely, large park with a fountain and monument. The park is empty all day and then fills up later with locals exercising and taking sunset walks. At the hotel pool, we had fun chatting with French travelers and met a Canadian farmer taking a visa run from Danang, Vietnam. The Canadian farmer, Sheldon, joined us for a meal at a nearby outdoor patio Greek restaurant, Elia Greek Kitchen. There is also an authentic local Cambodian coffee stand across the street from the hotel (as there are almost everywhere), which we enjoyed using each morning. A coffee is typically a dollar, whether hot or iced. The hotel is also a good location from which to walk to the lively Bassac Street nightlife area. Bassac Street is a relatively new entertainment area with exciting discos, bars and cafes in the hidden streets behind the main road. Several times, we tried Mama Wong's restaurant there, across from a disco. We loved our late-night noodle soup with mushrooms and greens, the spinach dumplings and the lime crème brulee which we ate while watching the dancers at the disco.

After our week in PP, we took a van to visit the relaxing, small riverside city of Kampot where you can actually swim in the river at a handful of resorts, such as Meraki, Sabay Beach and Hidden Resort. We also liked the Simple Things Cafe and the Epic Arts Restaurant, where we joined friends at the end of a day adventuring on a rented motorcycle. We then took a \$5 evening boat ride and bought all kinds of black and brown pepper, an important product produced in the area. Returning to PP for a night, we then took a farewell tuk-tuk back to the airport for our Viet Jet flight back to Bangkok and then by land to Pattaya.





Phnom Penh turned out to be a thrilling time away from Thailand. Anyone can find things to do in this up-and-coming Asian power-house city. Everybody coming from Thailand will be so relieved they can take the Grab tuk-tuks here! So don't forget to take tuk-tuks: they are a deal here and give you a perfect vantage point of the historic heritage sites as you pass by them.

They are so convenient. Another tip is to walk around each area where you have a meal. Foods of all ethnic nationalities are available; we even found Mexican tacos street food style at Tacos Kopelli.

Top attractions are the National Museum, Wat Phnom, the Independence Monument, the Royal Palace & Silver Pagoda, the Phnom Penh Night Market (best visited 5 to 9 pm), the Riverfront (open all day and night, every day), the Choeung Ek Killing Fields (a former orchard and mass grave of victims of the Khmer Rouge killed between 1975 and 1979, and Prison S21 (a former high school), where you can see photos that documented the brutal site to the world. Thousands were murdered at S21, and all were photographed and documented. We have seen most of these sites.

If like us you have not been to Phnom Penh for 10 to 15 years you will find it a very different city. We will go there again since it felt like we needed more time here. It was such a fun visit.




