






Hotel Map



We wanted to start our meal with Khao Soi recently ranked The World's best soup by TasteAtlas but surprisingly hard to find in Pattaya. It came wonderfully presented and was delicious. I actually couldn't leave the sauce alone, it was that good! This was followed by a variety of traditional Thai dishes, all presented beautifully and served by the most attentive and friendly staff.

The menu also includes amazing seafood and Western-style dishes from which we ordered the chicken skewers, accompanied by a jacket potato and excellent pepper sauce which were very good. The menu here can truly accommodate any taste, but I urge you to try the authentic Thai options as they are excellent to share and make for beautiful food photos!

Discover Pattaya was delighted to review the new Romsai Brasserie on Beach Road. Brought to you by the same ownership as Cafe La Plage, situated on the corner of Pattaya Klang and Beach Road, the new establishment is only a few metres down and directly overlooking the beach. Upon entering the restaurant, we were greeted by some beautiful Thai dancers performing to traditional Thai music, pitched at a perfect volume. A nice change! The restaurant itself is bedecked with flowers and the atmosphere overall is extremely comfortable and suitable for all.

Mooltripakdee International School: Pattaya's Best Kept Educational Secret

It would seem that Mooltripakdee International School is the best kept educational secret in the region. Tucked away among the tranquil countryside east of Pattaya, MIS has grown to nearly 1000 students from over 30 nationalities and became a significant name within the Chonburi district and beyond. I spoke with the Head of School, Dr. Matthew Coutts, to find out why so many parents have chosen MIS for their children.

home-away-from-home, as soon as they walk through the gates.



Dr. Matt, as he is affectionately known by his students and staff, is a hands-on Head of School. He speaks passionately about his school, its vision and the learning of his students. Typically, he deflects the limelight towards his hard-working teachers and staff, and towards the school's owner, Dr. Wirawan Mooltripakdee (Ms. Wee). Ms. Wee has been the visionary force behind the school's growth and in maintaining its unique atmosphere and charm. As you walk around MIS, you are struck by the smiling faces you encounter, the greenery which permeates every space and the sense of relaxed purpose within those who work and study there. As the school has developed, the leadership have been keen to make sure that it kept its homely feel. On a recent visit, I was told that Ms. Wee wants the students to feel like they are in their

In recent years, there has been a push to develop the curriculum of the school and drive standards of teaching and learning. At present, the school is in the process of seeking accreditation with the Educational Development Trust, an internationally recognised accreditation body. MIS offers the Cambridge International Curriculum across both Primary and Secondary age ranges, working towards IGCSEs at the end of Year 11, and the possibility of AS / A Level level study after that. Becoming an accredited 'Cambridge School and Examination Centre' is something about which Dr. Matt is very proud and that he feels will only further enhance the learning of the students and solidify the school's educational programmes.

Another of the aims at MIS is to offer genuine value for money. As Dr. Matt put it, they wish to make the international school experience accessible to a wide-range of families while still maintaining their close links with the local community and connection to the culture and values of Thailand. For me, this is a key selling point for the school: MIS has strived to maintain traditional values in an international school setting, with the uniquely colourful Thai celebrations, such as Loy Krathong and Songkran, only adding to the student experience here. In this endeavour, I believe they have been very successful, with both Thai and international parents commenting on how they feel comfortable with how the school operates and how they feel welcomed when on campus. MIS is also noted for having a very high ratio of teaching support staff to students. This not only means that the students feel well-looked after, but also, as support staff manage the day-to-day communications with home, that MIS parents feel well-informed and part of the school community.

MIS will soon be opening a new sports hall and dining facility, with plans ahead for an increased number of classrooms and learning spaces. Dr. Matt was keen to tell me about how this will help to develop the school's already bustling extra-curricula programme and mean that they can continue to offer great opportunities for their young sportsmen and women to thrive and enjoy themselves.

I have been fortunate enough to visit Mooltripakdee International School many times, in a professional capacity, and I must say it is always an occasion I look forward to. The warmth of the staff and the many jolly 'Sawadee Krup, Teacher' greetings from the students is a far cry from many schools that I have spent time in back in the UK, and an example from which I think all who work in education can learn. My own feeling is that MIS has purposely held on to the traditional values that many of us admire about our host nation and that this underpins the environment that has been created there. I am sure the school will continue on its path and grow to meet its considerable potential, while keeping the spirit of community that so many parents and students value.

Designed by Tom Fexas and launched in 1999, the 158GT motor yacht was named Continental Drifter II when owned by American singer-songwriter Jimmy Buffett.






RETIRING TO THAILAND? SOME THOUGHTS ON HEALTHCARE



If you're considering retiring to Thailand, you will be of an age where your health and the care available in the kingdom will be one of the most important things that you have to consider. Having lived in Thailand for many years and being of retirement age myself, it may be helpful to you if I pass on some observations that have occurred to me over recent years. I must stress that these are personal opinions and for something as central to your decision to retire here, this should be thoroughly looked at. The final conclusion must be yours alone. Extensive research on the options available is the key and hopefully the points raised here will help you along the way.

It would be very difficult to advise on what healthcare policy will suit you best, as this is such a personal matter. It may be prudent however to go through some of the things that may exclude you from receiving a payment despite the fact that you may have full coverage and be paying your premiums up to date. For example, if you provide false information when applying, your policy will become null and void. Something you do not want to only realize when you make a claim.

If you have any pre-existing medical conditions that you do not declare, your policy will be null and void, even if you claim for something that has nothing to do with the said condition. Alcohol and successful insurance claims do not go together. If you claim for an accident of any kind and were even mildly inebriated, you will have a very difficult task getting paid.

Speaking of accidents, very few policies will cover you if it occurs on a motorcycle. Even if you do get cover, you will only get paid if you hold a Thai or international driving license, were wearing a helmet, had not drunk any alcohol and can prove you were not at fault. Even then it may not be easy! It would be better to organise a separate specialist policy.

If you're still active and enjoy various sports you would be well advised to make sure that these activities are covered in your policy. Be sure to read the small print on this and anything else that may catch you out.

When you first enter Thailand, you may already have travel or medical cover from your home country. However, if you want to obtain a long-stay non-immigrant O-A visa before you arrive you will need to show that you have a policy that covers you for 40,000 Baht outpatient and 400,000 baht inpatient as a minimum. Something to consider though is that when you go to get your yearly extension from immigration, your policy will have to originate from an approved Thai company, a list of which you can find online. Something to think about if you're pondering a new policy before travelling.

There are numerous agents here in Pattaya that have given sound advice to many retiring expats over the years. It may be best to arrive here in the Kingdom and then arrange your insurance for the long term. Be careful when making your choice, take time to examine the fine print, particularly the omissions, and make sure you get the cover that suits you. Look at the insurer's reputation, research the company online by using review sites and get personal recommendations from long-term retirees here if you can. Get as many quotes as possible, the cheapest may not get you the cover you need and making sure you have the right policy will be time and money well spent. There will be plenty of opinions available here, get them all and then make your own choice.

If you're going to finish your time in Thailand, you have to be covered for your health. Unless you have a serious amount of cash put aside, you're going to need it eventually. Take your time and do all the research that is needed to make the right choice.

SETTING UP A US TREATY OF AMITY COMPANY IN THAILAND

Yetting up a company in a foreign country can be a complex process, but if you're a US company looking to do business in Thailand, the Treaty of Amity and Economic Relations between the United States of America and the Kingdom of Thailand can provide favorable conditions and legal protections for your venture.

What is a US Treaty of Amity Limited Company?

An international pact known as the Treaty of Amity was reached between the US and Thailand with the intention of fostering bilateral trade, commerce, cultural understanding, and legal rights. Signed in 1966, this treaty aims to promote economic cooperation and provide favorable conditions for US companies wishing to do business in Thailand.

An 'Amity Treaty company' in Thailand refers to a company that has been established under this treaty. Companies founded in accordance with the Treaty of Amity are entitled to a number of benefits and exemptions, including as immunity from asset expropriation and nationalization, access to dispute resolution procedures, and the capacity for 100% foreign ownership without the need for a Thai partner.

Advantages of Setting up a US Treaty of Amity Company

If you're considering setting up a company in Thailand, opting for a US Amity private limited company can offer several advantages: • The Amity and Trade Treaty allows U.S. citizens to have majority ownership in companies participating in certain portions of stateowned enterprises where majority ownership is limited to Thai citizens under the Foreign Business Acts.

- It gives a sense of security and stability for US corporations operating in Thailand, as these companies are safeguarded against the Thai government's nationalization and expropriation of their assets. Additionally, in the event of a dispute with the Thai government. Amity companies have access to international dispute resolution mechanisms, such as international arbitration.
- · Amity companies enjoy certain privileges and exemptions, including tax exemptions and reductions, which make it easier and more attractive for them to do business in Thailand.

Activities Not Permitted for US Amity Companies

The Amity and Trade Treaty specifies that companies that are predominantly American owned will be treated as nationals or will be able to act on the same basis as Thai companies.

However, there are some exceptions. Amity and trade treaty companies are not allowed to own land or participate in certain state-owned enterprises such as transportation and courier, local trade in agricultural products, land, exploitation of natural resources, taking care of property for the benefit of others, and independent professions such as bank and financial institution that involve with fund deposits. It is essential to be aware of these restrictions when planning your business activities as a US Amity company.





What do tourists and foreigners who live long term in Thailand need to know.

I have working with foreigner in Thailand for many years and I have been working on the Visa Services for 25 years. Through all those years experiences, I have found that a lot of people did not know what to do when their visa expire and still want to stay longer in Thailand. Some people confuse what is TM 30, what is 90 days report? and why they have to do visa run? why can't they extend visa in Thailand? And some people even get so frustrate on extending visa.

So here are some answers that I can advice you.

- 1. TM 30 Now that the government required everyone who enter Thailand, must do a report where they are staying. The owner of the residency must report if they are not report, you yourself must report where you stay. This report need to be done within 24 hours on the date you arrived.
- Report 90 days This report is for those who staying longer than 90 days or stay year by year. If you are on a year visa, you must do report every 90 days into immigration that you are still living in this address. You can report your 90 days 7 days before expire or after 7 days.
- 3. Visa Extention To extend your visa, you can do it at immigration only one time than you need to leave Thailand. For those who want just to do visa run one day in-out you can do visa run to neigbour countries. There are so many others information to know which I can't give it all here. If you are not sure on your situations, you can bring your passport and visit me at my office for more informations.

- 2. การรายงานตัว 90 วัน อันนี้สำหรับคนที่อยู่เป็นปีหรืออยู่มากกว่า 90 วัน เป็นการรายงานตัวว่ายังอยู่และพักอยู่ที่นี่ ดังนั้นคนที่อยู่มากกว่า 90 วันใน ไทย ให้รายงานตัวกับตม. ทุกๆ 90 วัน

As previously mentioned in my July feature, I'm now working on a challenging but fun project. This combines pop, classical, rap, country, surf, bossa nova, reggae and Thai music seamlessly together in one long song that has a duration of over twenty minutes, possibly the longest single commercially produced track ever. You could say that 'Tubular Bells' by Mike Oldfield is one long track but was released as an album without a re-occuring theme or song.



So, the big challenge was to make twenty minutes of music sound interesting throughout. This I think I've achieved by utilizing a couple of 'out of copyright' classical themes originally written by Beethoven and Tchaikovsky (though not together of course) having integrated these classics into my song.

Then I decided to seamlessly vary the style throughout and used a few 'mash up' techniques to have a string quartet playing with a country style pedal steel guitar and mix some rap with reggae, for example.....and so on.

Lyrically, these days, I always have some kind of visuals in mind because of the impending accompanying video for youTube and, as I'm living here in a 'paradise bliss', i.e. Thailand, someone dreaming of a beautifully romantic encounter on the fabulous beaches of this area, was a stimulating enough vision. Hence the title, 'A Dreamer's Kiss In A Paradise Bliss'.

Recently, I have been educating a bunch of music tech students from Taiwan about my specialist subject, songwriting, gratefully receiving a commendation from Taipei University and talks of extending my commercial music production course for the future.





Accompanying the students was a budding Taiwanese film maker, Adam Yang, who jumped at the chance to film some scenes for my latest video. Knowing how to film cinematically is crucial to getting great results and utilizing him was a useful boost for his confidence going forward ... and for my production.

However, after his return home, I was left to my own devices to finish filming and then do the editing. I opted for everyone wearing white as if in a dream sequence and called on some regular friends/models to provide the glamourous content. Also, a traditional Thai dancer and ballerina on the beach were essential to certain parts of the song.

By the time you read this, all recording and editing should be finished and uploaded to YouTube on my designated music channel FAB BAZ MUSIC TV (please press 'like' and 'subscribe').

As I approach an advanced age, every project takes on greater significance and with Artificial Intelligence rearing it's ugly head on the horizon, real art may be in it's final stages. All the more reason for each and everyone of you discerning lovers of originality to support us authentic 'hard working' creators.

So, experience 'A Dreamer's Kiss In A Paradise Bliss' with me. Go on...you know you want to !!



The Tamar Center was founded in 1999. It's aim to provide education, vocational training and job opportunities for girls wishing to leave bars. Tamar's office on Pattaya's 3rd Road now has a large, green double fronted building that includes restaurant, bakery, and gift shop. I have yet to try their breakfast but will be sure to come back to amend this, especially as they bake their own bread for accompanying toast and have healthy options such as muesli and smoothie bowls. Throughout the day they also serve excellent Thai food (with no MSG added) and Western food including salads, tacos and high quality burgers











While you're trying their food, be sure to pick up some of the charming handcrafted items here. I especially like the cards from as little as 80 baht - always good to have at home for the last minute birthday notice, or cute presents from the jewelry, scarves and bag ranges.





Another excellent feature at this location is the conference room complete with boardroom table, chairs, bluetooth screen, white board and full air conditioning. This is available for private hire at just 300 baht an hour or absolutely free if you ask the center to provide you with food and beverages whilst there - not a difficult decision!


