These foundations are further enriched by partnerships with world-renowned institutions such as MIT, the Juilliard School, Nord Anglia, and Round Square. ## A GLOBAL LEGACY OF EXCELLENCE

It is with immense pride and joy that I stand before you this evening in such a splendid setting, to mark a truly momentous occasion the 30th anniversary of Regent's International School, with campuses in both Pattaya and Bangkok. Thirty years ago, Regent's was born of a bold vision shared by Khun Thiphavan my better half of 50 years and myself: not merely to establish a school, but to create a global community. A community where young minds are nurtured, challenged, and inspired to lead with empathy, wisdom, and courage. This evening, we celebrate not just the passage of time, but the extraordinary legacy built over those years.

Over the past three decades, Regent's International Schools have proudly sent graduates into the world who have walked the halls of the most prestigious universities Oxford, Cambridge, Imperial College, LSE, King's, Stanford, Yale, UCLA, the University of Chicago, Seoul National University, the National University of Singapore, and many more. Yet their journeys did not conclude at the gates of those esteemed institutions. One such alumnus, Hayk Harutyunyan, went on to serve in the Armenian Cabinet as the deputy minister of Energy, pushing forward the green energy policy a testament to how the values instilled at Regent's flourish far beyond our walls. Jee Woon Huang of Pattaya Campus, in 2002 received an unconditional offer from Oxford University after scoring 3A🛭 and 2A in A Level. But her family believed Seoul National University was best for her career. She is now a legal counsel for Korea K-water.

Another, Dr Jaanika Vider the first alumna from Pattaya campus earning all three degrees from Oxford is currently contributing to the 'Capturing the Arctic' research project in collaboration with the Smithsonian National Museum and the University of Vienna. Jekatarina Ivanova, the first from Bangkok Campus to Oxford University where she completed her two degrees and is now a lead engineer managing oil and gas concession in North Sea and West Africa. In the world of arts and letters, Eia Uus was honoured with the Eduard Vilde Prize for her poetry exploring the inner world of a sensitive young woman a theme she first began to explore during her English lessons at Regent's.

In the sphere of social impact, two alumnae Michaela Pobudová from Slovakia and Katrin Puutsa from Estonia co-founded the non-profit organisation Mareena, working to build inclusive societies by helping foreigners become locals. Their journey began with the Round Square spirit cultivated right here at Regent's. Even in the world of entertainment here in Thailand, one name stands out-beloved by virtually every Thai household and that is none other than Yaya, or Urassaya, who began her journey with us at the Pattaya Campus from pre-nursery. Another exceptionally remarkable Thai alumna is Toey Soralamba, who achieved an almost impossible and unprecedented perfect score of 45 in her IB Diploma, granting her access to the very best universities in the world. Last but perhaps, the proudest Thai alumnus, a humble boy known by his friend and staff as 'Pack', currently known as Dr. Vincent by his fan club around the Globe. Dr Natthapoj Vincent Trakulphadej, a 2002 Pattaya Campus graduate, currently an associate professor at Reading University - UK after earning his scholarship degree from Brunel, his MSc from Oxford University and Ph.D. from Cambridge University, his remarkably popular website, Maths ThroughStories.org draws in a global audience, with over 600 mathematics teachers from some 220 countries regularly visiting. Regent's is so proud that Dr. Natthapoj continues to make an unimaginable contribution to the training of mathematics educators worldwide. Over the past two to three decades, many of our alumni, whose names not mentioned here due to time limit, have helped place Regent's firmly on the map. These are not exceptions. They are the essence of who we are. They affirm that our mission to educate global citizens and nurture well-rounded leaders who shape a better world is not merely a motto, but a lived and enduring reality.

Of course, such outcomes do not occur in isolation. This evening, I must pay tribute to those who believed in this school and helped nurture it alongside my wife and our three children. They are our remarkable teachers, our headteachers, and our parents. I would like first to express my deepest gratitude to the former headmasters and principals who have each left an incredible mark on the legacy of our school: Richard Poulton, our founding Headmaster in 1996, former Headmaster of Christ's Hospital School, England Simon Leslie, former head of Geelong Grammar School -Timbertop Ken Ball and Patricia Metham, former Headmistress of the famous Roedean School in England To our two longest-serving Principals Martin Kneath in Bangkok and Mike Walton in Pattaya thank you for your years of transformative leadership. To more recent Principals Peter Hogan, Sarah Osborne-James, and Martyn Smith Each of you helped lay a firm foundation with dedication and vision. And to our current Principals Amos Turner Wardell (Pattaya) and Andy Edmonds (Bangkok) your total commitment to excellence continues to inspire both staff and students. We are deeply grateful. We stand on the shoulders of your contributions.

To our parents many of whom are leaders in your own right, across business, culture, law, engineering and medicine your belief in holistic, international education has been the bedrock of our success. Your trust, your advocacy, your partnership they have created a ripple effect far beyond your own families. You are not merely supporters you are co-architects of this remarkable 30-year journey. Thank you for your loyalty and trust given to the school. Thank you for your involvement. And thank you for choosing Regent's not once, but continuously, across generations.

### LOOKING AHEAD WITH PURPOSE

As we reflect on what has been achieved, we also look ahead with determination and ambition. The world today faces significant challenges climate change, conflict, inequality but it also offers immense opportunities. Regent's International School, with over 2,000 students and 300 staff across our Bangkok and Pattaya campuses, will continue to prepare our young people not merely to enter that world but to improve it. 

## A 9 Course Culinary Odyssey Crafted by Chef Alex at The Globe's Heritage

We pride ourselves on discovering new places for our readers and this month we have surely found you the ultimate Hidden Gem in Pattaya. If you are driving to the Globe's Heritage restaurant (and with the amazing cocktails and wine cellar at this restaurant I would advise against it) you can phone ahead. They will send someone to Pattaya Soi 7 to take care of your parking and bring an umbrella to escort you if it is raining. There are also rooms and a fabulous roof top bar to experience here so you may just want to extend your stay after your superlative dining experience.

Once inside you will find a marvelously well stocked bar where for my next visit I aim to treat myself to another Emerald Yukuza ... They also take their wines very seriously as Mats the joint owner here proudly shows a wine cooler that has 4 different temperature settings. He teamed up with Chef Alex because they both have a vision of really bringing culinary excellence to us here in Pattaya. The theme, as the name suggests, is food inspired from all over the world yet for me it was the simplest things done extremely well that make this restaurant so special. Everything here is made in house, the homemade butter alone is worth the visit but you must resist the temptation to fill up on bread as there are 9 remarkable courses to enjoy.



Just one example and a stand out starter for me, was the Tuna Tataki with premium Akami tuna loin pickle,apple gel,abruga caviar and a fragrant truffle Yuzu Kosho Vinaigrette. It also comes with the full theatrical experience being served in a mist of dry ice. Also the Risotto which combines both Italian and Thai inspiration comprising Jasmine rice rather than the usual Arborio under delicious prawns and even an edible grill. Pan-seared foie gras, Wagyu Short rib from Issab with a delightful red curry, Chicken with Yoghurt sauce. Even Bacalao with wild caught Norwegian salted cod and crispy salmon skin. Every dish is both beautiful on the eye, aromatic and full of beautifully balanced flavours and textures. The Globe American Pie is a golden puff pastry filled with fig and orange marmalade topped with a poached strawberry. The surprise element here is once again that everything on the plate is completely edible including the delicate turquoise lattice work..
















If you haven't been to Catch Bar & Restaurant yet you really should. Danny, their international chef, is gaining a great reputation here in Pattaya for his delicious Sunday Roasts, amazing Fish & Chips and the true East Ender's favourite:Pie and Mash. I visited to try the burgers. It seems everyone in Pattaya has one to their name but I heartily recommend Danny's burgers. He gives you a choice of 3 succulent options:

His "Smash burger" is made with a 100% pure angus patty, seasoned with a pinch of salt and pepper and topped with American burger cheese, chopped onions, lettuce, tomato ketchup and mustard. Then there's a succulent grilled chicken burger and more unusually Danny's own Fillet of Fish. With line-caught cod loin it is battered in a really tasty light batter (I far prefer this to breadcrumbs) and topped with American burger cheese pickles, mayo and a squirt of lemon.

My colleague went for the beef burger and I had the fish Danny told me it was banging - and he was not wrong! I loved his touch of an extra piece of fish on top of the fries, and both burgers, fries, coleslaw, mayo and Tartar were beautifully served. What my team mate and I both

remarked on was the quality of the bun.

It may seem like a simple thing to get right but so many places don't. We hate buns that disintegrate as soon as you try to pick them up or are dry and hard. Danny's seeded ones are perfect!

Another point that was discussed was the size of both the angus patty and the fillet of fish - exactly right. I don't know about you but I really don't like burgers that are so big it feels like you're eating someone's leg! Slight exaggeration yes, but you get what I mean, and as I've mentioned before, I like to pick my burger up and bite into it with no poncy knife and fork tactics. Flat, thin, "frozen" patties aren't great either; you end up having too much sauce on just to make them taste of anything. To quote Goldilocks and as you can see from our photos these are "Just Right".

Try Danny's burgers for yourself and if you go on a Tuesday he'll treat you to a free beer!

I have to admit that I have never really got the deal with chicken wings. Why people in Thailand and especially in the US go crazy for them? Maybe it's because my only introduction to them whilst living in the UK was through KFC? Now I know many people who love a bucket of wings from that long established brand but my problem with them is that they are a franchise operation. Shouldn't make a difference I hear you say but I'm afraid from my personal experience it has. I once had a portion of chicken wings to take away from a KFC in South London and they were shockingly bad. The crunchy coating seemed as usual but I kid you not under the coating was raw chicken skin! How could this be? I have no idea. Was the fryer not set to a sufficiently hot temperature? Had the wings not been left in the fryer long enough? I don't know because being typically British and not wanting to make a fuss I didn't take them back to KFC but just threw them away and had a revulsion for chicken wings thereafter.

Fortunately for my taste buds but perhaps less fortunately for my waist line this loathing for chicken wings has been transformed into a passion. Now I get it! Now I see what all the fuss is about and that is because Qulture has shown me the light. It is now impossible for me to go to their lounge to enjoy a superb cocktail without ordering at least a portion of 6 chicken wings. I have joined the ranks of Qulture's American clientele who regard them as a comfort food essential, and a cultural staple.

These flavorful cuts of poultry now have an iconic status having risen from humble beginnings being largely credited to Teressa Bellissimo's Anchor Bar in Buffalo, New York. In 1964 she apparently tossed some deep-fried leftover wings in a hot sauce and butter mixture for her son and his friends. The dish quickly gained popularity, giving birth to what is now known worldwide as Buffalo wings. Now of course, chicken wings have evolved far beyond their Buffalo origins. Flavors ranging from classic barbecue and honey mustard to garlic parmesan, lemon pepper, and the fiery "Nashville hot." Asian-style wings can be coated in a sticky soy-garlic glaze or sweet chili sauce.

At Qulture Lounge and Bar you can try their amazing chicken wings with 4 delicious options to choose from: Lemon Pepper (my personal favourite), Thai Style, Garlic Parmesan with Blue cheese, or the classic Buffalo. The shareable nature of a dish with either 6 or 12 per serving makes them a perfect order when sitting at Qulture's fabulous bar, inside when listening to the cool Saxophone renderings of Shaddow (every Thursday and Sunday night). Or outside at the tables whilst Brandon and his team fire up the barbecue. Or if you can't wait until the lounge opens at 4pm you can order some fried chicken from the Cafe. It opens from 8 a.m. until 5:30 pm. Try eating their fried chicken alongside the signature French Toast - it's a taste sensation!

am using the term Patriot for a series of articles to feature in the magazine. Firstly because I love the alliteration, and secondly because I wanted a word to describe some very special people who live amongst us here in Pattaya. Sometimes given a military connotation, the word patriot actually describes someone who deeply loves, supports and defends their country (or, for the purposes of this article, their city). They often demonstrate loyalty through service, sacrifice, or civic engagement. True patriotism goes beyond mere pride—it involves striving to make improvements for all, for freedom, and for progress. In April I wrote about Margaret Grainger of The Hand to Hand Foundation and last month Liz and Lhen Lhen at Mercy Pattaya. If you missed these articles you can still read them online at pattayatrader.com.

For this month's article I went to the police station on Pattaya Beach Road (right next to Central Festival) and met with Rick to see first hand what he does. In a city famed for its bustling streets, this quieter but profoundly impactful initiative is dedicated to protecting the most vulnerable road users: children. Rick Brown, known on social media as Savvy Rick Brown, is the founder of Helmet Heroes Thailand. Alongside his dedicated partner in this mission, Max Kimberley-Thompson, Rick is turning personal adversity into a beacon of hope, one helmet at a time, right here in Pattaya.

For Rick, the journey to founding Helmet Heroes Thailand began after a dreadful bullying incident when he was just 14 years old. It led to a life-altering bicycle accident, leaving him with spinal trauma and PTSD. This harrowing experience sowed the seeds of a deep-seated desire to protect others. So after moving to Thailand, a country he now calls home, his observation of seeing countless children riding motorcycles without helmets sparked a transformative mission."It was a lightbulb moment," Rick shares. "I knew I had to do something. My own accident taught me how quickly a life can change, and seeing these kids so exposed, I couldn't stand by."





Driven by this newfound purpose, Rick, under his online persona 'Savvy Rick Brown,' researched extensively, sourcing high-quality, safety-certified children's helmets from a local Thai manufacturer. What began in December 2023 with just three helmets and an unwavering determination has quickly blossomed into a powerful community-driven safety initiative. Helmet Heroes Thailand was born, with a clear and ambitious mission: to provide a free, safety-certified motorcycle helmet to every child in Thailand and, eventually, beyond. The ultimate goal? To distribute over one million helmets.

This is no small undertaking, especially in a country where motorcycle accidents are a leading cause of injury and death among children, with statistics indicating that only a small percentage of children wear helmets. But Rick isn't alone in this fight. A crucial partner in this endeavor is Max Kimberley-Thompson, a well-known figure in Pattaya and the President-Elect of the Rotary Club of Jomtien-Pattaya. Max's involvement has been instrumental in expanding the reach and impact of Helmet Heroes. "When Rick shared his vision, it resonated deeply with the Rotary's mission to create lasting change in communities," Max explains. "Road safety, especially for children, is a critical issue in Thailand. Partnering with Helmet Heroes allows us to leverage Rotary's network and resources to support this vital cause effectively."







Together, Rick and Max have forged powerful collaborations, most notably with the local Thai police in Pattaya. The Central Police Station on Beach Road has become a recurring venue for their helmet distribution events. These events are more than just giveaways; they are community engagements where safety education is paramount. Officers often assist in fitting the helmets, demonstrating correct usage, and reinforcing the importance of road safety to children and their parents. A unique and heartwarming aspect of these distributions is also the involvement of the wider community, including tourists. While Helmet Heroes doesn't have a formal program for tourists to distribute helmets, their public events, often held in visible locations like the Central Police Station, draw attention and support from visitors. Tourists often witness these distributions, learn about the cause, and are moved to contribute, whether through donations or by simply spreading the word. This interaction adds another layer to Pattaya's image, showcasing a community actively working to protect its youngest members.

"It's incredible to see the support from everyone – locals, expats, and even tourists who are just here for a short time but want to make a difference," Rick says. "Every helmet is only 550 Thai Baht, about \$15 USD. It's a small price to protect someone for the next five years." Since its inception, Helmet Heroes Thailand, with the support of partners like the Rotary Club of Jomtien-Pattaya and various local businesses and sponsors including Ducati Motor Thailand and Pattaya House Builder, has distributed hundreds of helmets – nearing 1,000 by early 2025. They've organized events at local schools, like Tantrarak Elementary School, alongside their efforts at the police station, always emphasizing that education is just as important as the helmet itself.







Local police have reported observing improved helmet usage rates among children in areas where distributions have taken place, a testament to the project's effectiveness. For Rick and Max, these are the tangible results that fuel their continued dedication. "We're not just giving away helmets," Max emphasizes. "We're building a culture of road safety. We're showing children that their community cares about their well-being. And we're providing a practical tool that can prevent tragedy."

Rick's transformation from a victim of bullying to a proactive protector of children is a powerful narrative. His social media presence as Savvy Rick Brown helps to amplify the message, reaching a global audience and inspiring others to take action in their own communities. He often shares updates, personal stories, and information on how to support Helmet Heroes, including through their website, helmetheroesthailand.org. Donors even have the option to have their brand logo or image added to sponsored helmets, creating a unique way for businesses to show their corporate social responsibility.

As Helmet Heroes Thailand continues to grow, its sights are set on reaching more children in more provinces across the nation. For Pattaya, it's a story of resilience, compassion, and proactive change, proving that heroes can emerge from ordinary people driven by extraordinary missions. And for the children of Thailand, it's a chance for a safer journey, one helmet, one hero, at a time. Many thanks to Arawana Hotel who donated the helmets for this occasion. ## Gloria goes to Taara Clinic for the treatment of osteoarthritis.

As we get older osteoarthritis in the knees is a common degenerative joint condition. The cartilage cushioning the bones in the knee joint wears down over time and once it's gone it's gone. Previously there was little to be done for this condition. Corticosteroid injections provide temporary pain relief but only for a limited number of times as their repeated use can: further weaken the cartilage over time.

So as the condition progresses, bone begins to rub against bone, causing increased discomfort and loss of joint function. Treatment at this stage will most likely be joint replacement surgery. Therefore PRP treatment offers hope as it can regenerate damaged cartilage in knees if the condition is caught early enough.

Treatment typically involves harvesting platelet and plasma from the patient's own body (autologous treatment). These cells are then processed to separate them from the red blood cells and then injected directly into the area that needs healing. The goal is for these PRP cells to reduce inflammation, repair damaged tissue, and even grow entirely new healthy cells to replace diseased ones.

So if this is something that we're pretty much all in danger of suffering from once we pass the age of 40 why don't we all just routinely have this done was a question I put to Dr Patrick of the Taara Clinic? I often put questions to Dr Patrick because I have a natural journalistic interest and also because unlike many other doctors I have found he always answers me in good, concise English. In a nutshell what he explained to me was that if you randomly go ahead and inject into a knee that doesn't need treatment it can lead to damage, inflammation and do more harm than good.

Was I experiencing pain problems with my knees? Well the answer to this was in this country I hardly ever notice it but whenever I'm back in the UK I do. Reasons - possibly the cold, damp weather - although I am rather intrigued to research the difference between a humid climate and a damp climate - perhaps another article at a later date? More likely though, it could have more to do with stairs. I do more walking when in the UK and seem to have to go up and down more stairs than when here in Pattaya where I nearly always find myself taking the lift (elevator) or escalators.

So Dr Patrick examined me and found that I had the start of osteoarthritis in both knees. He could tell this when he examined and maneuvered my knees and we both heard the clicking sound they made when he did. He therefore prescribed a set of 4 treatments.

Now I have to tell you that I used to have a morbid fear of needles but from the extraction of my blood to the injection of the PRP into my knee the procedure was pretty painless. Dr Patrick and his team all know their stuff in terms of making the procedure as pleasant and pain free as possible. For about 24 hours after the injections I had to rest up a little as my legs just felt a little "tight" but after that I could walk as normal. After the 3rd treatment Dr Patrick was pleased to find that there was no more clicking in my knees.

The future of education is uncertain. Ecological collapse and financial instability may mean choppy seas ahead for our young people to navigate. Add to this the implications and opportunities of the AI revolution and the attitudes and opinions of young people have never been more important. As part of an article writing competition, the Year 10 students at MIS wrestled with these ideas and shared their perspectives.

# Here now is the winning article by Hagen Laermann

Many countries have their own unique approaches to educating the next generation. Teaching styles, curricula, and even the way students are examined to think about the world vary widely. However, one crucial perspective is often overlooked – ours, its students. We rarely get a say in how education evolves, despite it shaping our futures. In this article, we'll explore a young person's perspective on the future of education and the changes we believe are necessary.

In a fast-paced world where anybody can access knowledge whenever, new systems and methods would most likely be introduced into the future of education. This could change the entire educational system as we know it.

### **Technological Advancements**







# Chicken Brand Ceramic Bowl

Lampang's famous mineral resource is white tone earth and felspar that are the main material for molding ceramic wares.

Originally, chicken brand bowl was made for noodle and rice consumption since 1958 by a group of Chinese people who operated a factory. After discovery of white tone earth resource in the north of Lampang, there were more group of Chinese who run the factories for mass production of chicken brand bowls.

As it had become the native way of life in using Chicken Brand Bowl for food holding, particularly rice and noodle then finally be local eating tradition in using this kind of tableware.



At the modern time with an advance production technology, there are more efficient quality control. Even though it is a mass production but parts of it are handmade such as chicken figure painting on the surface of products before putting in kiln and coating as ceramic ware. This process is a combination of hand made and manufacturing with state of art.





Chicken Brand is the community trademark. Now there is diversification of chicken brands to various kinds of ceramic products such as teacup, coffee mug, tea pot as well as other kinds of tableware and ceramic products that you can buy as souvenirs.

# Cotton Dyed with Lac

It is a kind of hand weaved cotton fabric with natural dye. Lac is a kind of natural dyeing color that makes mild red tone to the fabric that is suitable for making cloth dressing. Lampang has cotton cloth dyed with lac that is a distinguished local product.

หลังจากที่ได้นำเสนอเรื่องราวของลำปางในหลากหลายมิติ ในฉบับนี้จะขอแนะนำผลิตภัณฑ์ที่เก่าแก่และมีชื่อเสียงของลำปาง ตั้งแต่ยุคอดีตซึ่งได้มีวิวัฒนาการและแตกแขนงมาเป็นสินค้าหลากหลายและเป็นที่นิยมในปัจจุบัน ดังต่อไปนี้

# ชามตราไก่

ลำปางมีทรัพยากรธรรมชาติสำคัญคือ ดินขาวและหินฟันม้า (felspar) ซึ่งเป็นวัตถุดิบสำคัญ ในการปั้นเครื่องถ้วยชามเครื่องปั้นดินเผาเซรามิคที่เก่าแก่และมีเอกลักษณ์ อีกทั้งเป็น สัญลักษณ์ของเมืองลำปางคือ ชามตราไก่ แต่ตั้งเดิมชามตราไก่ ใช้เป็นภาชนะหลักในการใส่ ข้าวสวยสำหรับคนจีนยุคเก่า ที่ใช้ตะเกียบพุ้ยข้าวเข้าปากแทนช้อน อีกทั้งเป็นชามใส่ก็วยเตี๋ยว เป็นหลัก อันเป็นวัฒนธรรมการรับประทานอาหารของชาวจีนมาตั้งแต่ปี 2500 การผลิตทำ ในโรงงานเล็กๆ ที่ปั้นด้วยมือ เมื่อมีการค้นพบแหล่งดินขาวที่สำคัญทางตอนเหนือของลำปาง ได้มีกลุ่มคนจีนรวมกันทำโรงงานชามตราไก่เป็นอุตสาหกรรมชุมชน และได้ขยายการผลิตมา ตั้งแต่ยคโนัน

Nearly two years ago I wrote an article entitled "Gloria chats with Dao and Jeff Mitchell of AMAR International". If you missed this you can still read it on the Expat Living page of our website pattayatrader.com. I remember the interview particularly well because Dao and Jeff were both so busy with incoming calls before and after our chat. At one stage I think they had 2 mobile phones each on the go! Such is the urgency of their business it seems they need to be available and on call constantly.

It is exacting work, requiring skill, diplomacy and tact so it makes sense that as their business continues to grow Dao and Jeff have selected a family member Dana Micallef to join the team. Having seen her mother Dao take calls, I am sure Dana has gained valuable experience simply by being in the same room. Plus having worked in France for a completely different business Dana brings new skills and procedures to the AMAR business. She says:

"Before coming to AMAR I was working in PR for an agency in France for three years. It was a totally different industry from the funeral industry. So I spent, I think, actually a year following what you (Jeff) do with Ma; the process of repatriation and cremation, and how you deal with and give respect to the families and the Thai authorities."

AMAR has grown so much in the last two years with so many new cases, they urgently needed Dana's help to manage information and navigate timelines more smoothly. She has helped create foundations that enable each case to be handled with more fluidity, especially when multiple nationalities, cultural backgrounds, time zones and legal frameworks are involved.

"It was very difficult, but I think that we're getting there. The fact that my mom is Thai but I was working in France, I got to see the benefits of both countries. I liked many of the European processes, you know, the way they manage tasks and implement procedures. Yet I also wanted to respect the Thai management style and the Thai way of working. Now by clarifying processes and supporting the team with the new tools it's a way for everyone to build new skills. This ultimately leads to better responsiveness, more accuracy and stronger support for the families. "



As Jeff adds: "We try to think about the client first, we want to be available to answer questions and organise on the go. Dana has introduced tools, databases, and systems that make it so much easier to deal with this and our expanding customer base. Most families understandably crave information and updates and what makes our job quite difficult is that there are often people, maybe friends or family, all giving their opinions. Saying: Oh you want to do this, you want to make sure that happens, you don't need the embassy, etc. So we have to try and dispel that quite quickly and the only way we can do that is to know the information as it's coming in and disseminate that information to the family quickly. So it's really like giving live updates all the time. Even if we have no news we'll let them know that we are still trying to get updates for them because that's more comforting than silence"




The positive changes implemented by Dana have particularly helped with customer service enhancements. Through the introduction of new tools and standard operating procedures the team at Amar are already seeing improved management of the growing customer base. Yet Dana's talents are not simply confined to administrative ones. She is a Thai, French and English speaker and in order to fully understand customer expectations and provide effective support, especially in sensitive situations she is getting involved in all sides of the business.

Jeff explains "We're learning from each other. Dana insisted that she wanted to do casework as well. She's worked on the office floor with our team, even getting on her knees and crushing ashes. She's learning from the top to the bottom and back up, which we think is what a family business is all about. And so going back to the expansion of our company, we have quite a few staff now and in order to support them and the additional salaries and overheads, we have to have structure. Dana is really helping to make us more efficient with new tools and systems that are most importantly aimed at enhancing customer service."

The Artist House Bangkok is packed full of colors and people who love art. It's a beautiful place where you can make art and jewelry right by the canal. You can buy (for a small fee) everything you need to make a painting right there, or pick out beads for a necklace or bracelet. Staff at The Artist House Bangkok are friendly and on hand to help you complete your artwork. Or you can admire the unique gallery in this centuries old house. It's also fun watching the longtail boats pass by and taking pictures. We sat by the water at the front of The Artist House and found a cute little table while charging our phones and enjoyed fresh sugar cane juice.

Local art work and photography are featured and displayed here and there is a puppet theater Location: Khlong Bang Luang Artist House, 309, 28 Phet Kasem Rd, Khuha Sawan, Phasi Charoen, Bangkok. You get to Baan Silapin by the MRT to Bang Phai Station, then walk 1 km northwest to Soi 28 You pass Wat Kamphaeng Bangchak and Wat Thong Sala before reaching the gallery.

You can also take a motorbike taxi. We saw that many people do this transport. Closes 6 pm





Nattaporn Ice Cream is also a "find" that we really love, especially on a hot Bangkok afternoon. Sitting around a table outside, we tried many flavors, our favorites being Thai tea, coconut, green tea, and coffee ice cream. It is a fun family-run place on a side soi and the perfect place to chill. Located at 94 Phraeng Phuthon Rd, San Chao Pho Sua, Phra Nakhon, Bangkok. Closes 5 pm

**32Bar X** is another happy, hidden spot especially for chocolate lovers. It's a quaint, cool hangout and the owner is super friendly. The staff give you free chocolate samples to determine which craft chocolate you want for your cold or hot beverage. The cacao comes from at least nine different Thai cacao-growing regions and this tiny, air-conditioned cafe is perfect on a hot day, especially with plenty of chocolate to eat and drink. **Body Care Works Soi 18** is off Sukhumvit and well-worth taking the time for what's called the complete "head to toe" beauty and cosmetic spa experience. A Vietnamese and Korean style spa, it is one of our favorite discoveries. How can you not love having everything done in one place: scrubbing, massage, nails, hair washed, really everything you'd love for a pleasurable happy body care treatment?

The spa even does nose waxing, deep ear cleaning, body massage, foot massage, and body scrubbing, cucumber facials, all kinds of professional body care treatments. Men especially love the hot towel facial shave! I think we were there for about three hours making a recent YouTube video showing Jason getting the full treatment. 


