Discover Pattaya spoke to Jana about her passion for Rotary and all it stands for. She told us that she became a Rotarian in 2016 and 2 years ago founded The Rotary Club of Pattaya Center International (chartered on June 1, 2023). The club focuses on doing good work for the local community's environment, education and health To date the club has delivered hundreds of rice packs, launched a dental-care program for children in the area, and initiated RCPCI tree planting. This initiative has seen hundreds of trees planted around Buddha Hill and throughout Pattaya City. There is also a drive to plant many thousand more and add plaques to the trees to educate children as to the trees' names and their importance to the environment.

Jana has also been a long-time supporter of helping with the stray dog problem in Pattaya and its surrounding areas. She personally loves and supports many in her area whilst working towards reducing the problem of Soi Dogs with City Hall and area Governors for sterilisation programmes that can reduce the problem. She also sees it as an important environmental issue because left unchecked Soi Dogs can be a menace to the community. Again through education, she wants to put the message out to children that dogs are not just a present to have when they are a cute puppy and then abandon, but should be a commitment to the full life of the animal.

Young people are important to Jana and in the club's charity event at The Hilton this month she includes both young male and female models to participate in the fashion show. Wanting to show them that being a Rotarian can be fun as well as worthwhile hard work. She wants to bring them into the world of Rotary to pass on the values of Rotary. To teach the next generation about the importance of helping others. At her club she actively encourages both Thai and International members to join together and regularly support other Rotarian clubs, even outside of Pattaya such as in Bangkok and Laos.





We've written before about how the Designer World has embraced coffee with many in house cafes. Now it seems at least one designer has gone on to get involved with the "hard stuff". Balmain's creative director Olivier Rousteing has become the first designer invited to collaborate with Johnnie Walker on a new collection titled Couture Expression. He was able to work with the iconic brand's team and choose from 500 rare and aged whiskies housed in the Johnnie Walker Vault under the brand's flagship store on Princes Street Edinburgh.



Such was Rousteing's passion for the creative project, he helped produce not just one but four limited-edition, bespoke blends in striking new bottles. "When I started to try the whiskies we were making], I realised that I wanted to create one whisky for every season, for every kind of taste," shares Rousteing. "My vision in fashion is about inclusivity, and creating an incredible community of people. So I thought, Why create only one whisky? Let's do four in the most incredible bottles and create this incredible journey of emotions for different tastes!"

Rousteing made his name in the world of fashion with collections that are bold, dramatic and glamorous and this translated well into the bottles that he designed to house the collaboration's limited-edition blends. The decanters are handcrafted in crystal by the artisans of the French luxury brand Baccarat to echo the silhouette of Johnnie Walker's signature square bottle. Each bottle features metallic draping, not unlike what you'll see in Balmain's collections, topped with a sculptural wing stopper.

Rousteing also gave each a bottle a metallic hue, turning them into trophies: gold was assigned to the smoky 'Fall' whisky, his favourite; silver for the vibrant and tropical 'Summer' whisky; rose gold for the refreshing and floral 'Spring' blend; and black for 'Winter', which boasts a deep and rich malt taste balanced with mulled wine sweetness.

He wanted to create a structured armour reflecting strength but to be swathed, like silk, to reflect the softness of the liquid inside.




The Johnnie Walker Vault was only open to the public in 2021 and is not a place that many people get to see. Whiskies there date from the end of the 19th century to the beginning of the 20th century. Rousteing was impressed by all the stories that Johnnie Walker has. "It's not even a brand. It's an institution from the 19th century" he says. "I went to Scotland, I discovered the incredible Johnnie Walker team, and enjoyed every single moment because as an artist, I am always curious to discover things.

It was not so far from fashion because it's about ingredients. It's about balance. For whisky, it's about what ingredients are you going to include? A bit of pepper, a bit of chocolate. And you start to create your whisky, and you feel like, "Okay, that was the emotion that I wanted to bring to it."

I hope these bottles will remain as pieces of art in the legacy of Johnnie Walker Vault."



As the first-ever collaborator for the Johnnie Walker Vault Rousteing says "When Johnnie Walker called me it was a dream come true. I remember my dad and granddad drinking whiskies so for me, whisky has a smell that I associate with being close to the fireplace in my childhood home in Bordeaux. Or with my grandma making crêpes, which is a traditional dessert in France. She would pour in a bit of whisky to the crêpes so the smell always reminds me of my childhood. For me, drinking whisky is always about enjoying the moment. It could be with family or friends. The four whiskies that we created are really unique you drink them neat, or with ice. You don't mix them. And just enjoy the emotions of each of them."





CAJUN LIFE CAFE:

PATTAYA'S HEALTHY HOTSPOT DELIVERS ON FLAVOUR AND FLEXIBILITY



It was a pleasure to return to Cajun Life Cafe and reconnect with Paola, their lovely manager who has now been there for eight months. After our last visit (which appeared in our January 2025 Magazine - to read it go to the Dining Reviews page pattayatrader.com)it's great to see them doing so well, especially when other restaurants are struggling in the low season.

The friendly staff informed us that some regulars visit up to two or three times a day. This speaks volumes, as these patrons care about their health but also enjoy high-quality, tasty food at reasonable prices. It's truly the go-to destination for Pattaya's fitness crowd and clean eaters. With free Wi-Fi, it's also a great, relaxed spot for people to use their phones and laptops while enjoying what's on offer. Whilst doing our review we also noticed a constant stream of Grab bike drivers busily collecting food for delivery.



We were surprised at how generous the portions are at Cajun Life Cafe, you certainly get value for your money and what makes this establishment unique is the flexibility you have when ordering. It allows you to modify dishes to suit your dietary needs. Bodybuilders, runners, athletes, or those just looking to lose weight will find it very easy to track their macros here. Most dishes are protein-packed, so you can get all the grammes of fresh, high-quality protein you need whilst you are training.

If you visit the Cajun Life website (cajunlifecafe.com/menu), check out the custom meals section; it details calories, protein, carbohydrates, and fat for all ingredients. This allows you to adjust your meal prep to suit your fitness goals, whether you're dining in or arranging a delivery. Plus, there's a great selection of seasonings and sauces, offering variety if you're on a strict regime of the same ingredients but crave some different flavours. Cajun Life Cafe's focus on healthy, customizable meals makes it a popular choice for Pattaya's active community, including those involved in local running groups.

For our review, we chose a variety of dishes:

Drinks: For our drinks, we each chose a smoothie. I opted for the Chocolate Peanut Butter one, made with almond milk and whey protein delicious, and a great choice if you're looking to make some gains. My partner selected the Vanilla Berry, a lower-calorie option also containing whey protein but with low-fat milk, and it was equally delicious. Cajun also offers a great choice of other beverages, including different coffees, teas, fruit juices, and sodas.

Starter: We began with the Salmon & Avocado Quinoa Salad, featuring smoked salmon, quinoa, red beans, cherry tomatoes, radishes, and avocado with a healthy honey mustard salad dressing. This variety of ingredients is excellent for your gut microbiome and overall health. Notably, the smoked salmon was soft and delicious. I also liked how the dressing was served separately, allowing you to add as much or as little as you want.

Main Course: We went with the Cajun Grilled Chicken Caesar Wrap, all wrapped inside a flour tortilla and served with sweet potato fries, priced at only 230 baht. My associate had the Cajun Grilled Chicken breast served with mashed sweet potatoes. The chicken used in both dishes was good quality, well-prepared, and not at all dry.

Dessert: For dessert, we chose protein-packed pancakes made with fresh egg whites, oatmeal, vanilla protein powder and blueberries, served with maple syrup and strawberries on the side. Cajun certainly provides plenty of these pancakes per serving. We would certainly recommend this as a sharing dish. We also had a mixed berry smoothie bowl, which had bananas, mixed berries, pumpkin seeds, and granola on top of a delicious yoghurt. Both of these choices would make really great breakfast choices.

We found the staff warm, attentive, and willing to accommodate dietary preferences, which, along with the decor, gives the cafe its relaxed and welcoming feel.






For those who remember the TV Series "The Dukes of Hazzard" you can now relive the nostalgia right here on Jomtien beach road where there's a fabulous new Sports bar/Restaurant called Daisy D's. It even comes complete with a Dodge Charger - suspended above the bar and the girls serving here are clad in shorts with pretty gingham blouses.

As well as having an amazing location - right on the beach front, the place (only just opened) is destined to be so much fun with all the plans the energetic team have for it. They recently made the most of their huge interior with a Salsa night which was extremely popular. Karaoke looks to be coming soon and I suggested a Line Dancing night as a natural for this place. Why not? We could all dress up - who doesn't love a Cowboy themed fancy dress? But I'm running away with myself as this place just has so many possibilities it's hard not to get enthusiastic.

Daisy D's is an impressively spacious bar and restaurant, featuring plenty of sports screens and a wide range of seating options including tables, booths, and bar stools. I particularly love the ones at the front where you can just sit, stare out to sea and watch the world go by. There's also an upstairs terrace and a really large expanse at the back with pool tables and room for events and parties.

The food as you would expect (the professional team from The Sportsman are involved in this venture) is lip smacking good. From July 1st they will have breakfasts starting at 8 a.m. which we shall return to try, and an extensive menu from which we selected some already popular dishes. For example the sizzling Fajitas are really tasty, great for sharing and come complete with all the necessary salsa, sour cream guacamole and grated cheese that you have to have to make up your pancakes.



Then there's the chicken wings that have so many options. You can choose to have them "Naked" (no breadcrumbs) or "Dressed" (with breadcrumbs) 6,10 or if you're really going for it 20 pieces with a choice of 5 dipping sauces

Obviously the burgers are a great choice here so we went for the 3 slider Combo. You get 1 chicken, 1 pork and 1 beef all with salad and dressing inside the bun - the pulled pork was particularly good. As I mentioned before there, are plenty of great places to just sit with a cold drink (prices are very good with bottled beer and house spirits just 80 baht), look out to sea or watch the sports. So there are plenty of tasty accompaniments you can choose from the menu. We went for the Combo Popcorn Bites which were chicken and shrimp hand buttered in buttermilk and southern spices - addictively good!







Pizzas are also extremely popular Daisy D's even sell them by the slice. Their St Louis Style Pizza caught our attention because of its square shape and we were told that this is particularly favoured by families as it's easy to share. With plenty of options to choose from (also available in the traditional round shape) we were given an excellent recommendation of the Cajun Shrimp. With Cajun tiger shrimp, bell peppers, woodchip bacon, red onion, and fresh basil on a tomato base I can really attest to the tastieness of this pizza. It was of course too much to finish but don't worry take out is available as will Grab deliveries be.

Also available are Thai dishes, desserts, salads, pastas and many other dishes. Its also a good idea to keep an eye on the daily specials posted outside. We may just have to return one Monday for the excellent value Burger and Beer at only 250 baht!

Art Exhibition by Jeanett

The lotus leaves are collected, preserved, and dyed by hand literally becoming integral tothe canvas with their natural imperfections, veins and textures ensuring that every piece is absolutely unique..

Jeanett originally from Copenhagen, Denmark. First came to Thailand in 2015 for 3 years with her family. They then left for Germany but returned in 2020. She paints using bright colors and specialises in abstract and lotus-themed art Working in oil and acrylic, she sometimes puts a resin on top to transform natural lotus leaves into vibrant pieces.

A social worker, and therapist Jeanett has found her own particular therapy through art which she says helps clear her mind when she paints. She has also recently learned about sound healing which is how she found Once Upon a Hotel.








Attending a workshop here given by Shantika, from the Sound Healing Sanctuary of Koh Samui, Jeanett spent some time talking to Ken. At first not even realising he was the hotel owner she found he was interested in the fact that she loved to paint. So she showed him some of her work and he asked if she would like to do an exhibition at his hotel.

Ken told us that OnceUpon a Hotel Pattaya only opened recently and Jeanett's exhibition is exactly the type of event he is happy to host here. Certainly the lotus art fits very well with the overall ethos of the hotel, especially its beautiful gardens where Ken himself has chosen every individual plant. It's a really beautiful, tranquil space with fountains, Koi carp and beautiful statues. A location much appreciated by the ensemble guests who came to enjoy the art and the location.

Sometimes given a military connotation, the word patriot actually describes someone who deeply loves, supports and defends their country (or, for the purposes of this article, their city). They often demonstrate loyalty through service, sacrifice, or civic engagement. Restoring Humanity Through a Cleaner Planet: The Good News #planetcleanup

Chem Perez, (an English teacher from the Philippines) founded *The Good News #planetcleanup* here in Pattaya. A grassroots movement aimed at raising awareness about our global garbage crisis, Chem's journey began with a moment of quiet reflection, a realization that we live in an increasingly materialistic world. Everywhere he looked, people were chasing possessions: bigger homes, faster cars, the latest gadgets, all in pursuit of happiness that never seemed to last. Chem Perez was no different until asking a powerful question: What truly endures? The answer hit with clarity—nothing material. We spend our lives accumulating things we cannot take with us when we die. In that moment, Chem understood that the true legacy we leave behind lies not in what we collect, but in what we give, in the lives we touch, and in the future we help build.

That awakening inspired Chem to shift focus from investing in things to investing in people. Chem wanted to empower others to see the same truth and to act on it. Believing deeply in the idea that if we want to see change in the world, we must first become that change, he launched The Good News #planetcleanup in 2019. Pattaya, with its stunning beaches and bustling tourist life, was the perfect place to begin. But beneath its beauty, the city was struggling with a problem shared by many places around the world: GARBAGE. Littered streets, plastic-choked waters, and polluted public spaces were becoming the norm. Rather than complain, Chem decided to act.





Cleanups were organized, Chem invited students, friends, neighbours, tourists, and even strangers to join in. What began with just a handful of people quickly grew, as more and more individuals saw the impact—not just on the environment, but on each other. The cleanups became more than just acts of environmental activity; they became gatherings of hope, connection, and purpose. Children joined in with smiles, parents brought their families, and volunteers from all walks of life contributed their time. People who had never spoken before became friends and through it all, everyone began to remember something important: that we are all share responsibility for this planet we call home.

However, in 2020, the momentum was temporarily disrupted by the global COVID-19 pandemic. As lockdowns and restrictions on social gatherings were enforced, PlanetCleanup activities had to be put on hold. But this didn't stop Chem Perez from creating good news. In fact, it marked the beginning of something even more profound. Instead of organizing cleanups, The Good News shifted focus toward humanitarian aid. Recognizing the growing number of people who had lost their jobs, become homeless, and were struggling with hunger due to the pandemic, Chem began organizing feeding programs for the less fortunate. This new direction gave birth to #planetcleanuphumanity, an extension of the original mission—still centered on healing the world, but this time through compassion, food, and solidarity in crisis. Volunteers and donors came together, and thousands of meals were served to those most in need.

What began as a local initiative in Thailand slowly evolved into a global movement. By 2023, The Good News #planetcleanup has expanded into six additional countries: the Philippines, Malaysia, Uganda, Nigeria, Pakistan, and Dubai. Each location brought its own challenges, but the spirit remained the same—cleaning the planet, restoring humanity, and spreading good news.

Through all of this, Chem Perez has continued to harness the power of social media-not as a tool for fame, but as a platform for mobilization, storytelling, and inspiration. In a digital world dominated by negativity and division, The Good News offers a breath of fresh air-real stories of people taking real action, proving that even in the darkest times, kindness and collective action can shine through.

At its core, The Good News #planetcleanup and #planetcleanuphumanity-is more than just a campaign. It is a movement to reawaken our sense of responsibility, not only for the Earth but for one another.

Every piece of trash collected, every meal served, and every life touched is a step toward restoring balance, compassion, and connection in our world. Today, Chem Perez continues to lead with purpose, reminding people around the world that real wealth lies not in what we accumulate, but in the good we do. In the face of climate change, pollution, and social division, The Good News #planetcleanup stands as a testament to what is possible when ordinary people unite around a common goal.

Chem asks us all what legacy will we leave behind? A world weighed down by waste and indifference—or a world lifted by care, hope, and responsibility? Let us be the change. Let us protect our communities, our planet, and each other. Because this planet is not just where we live—it is our home. Keeping Fit and Safe in Thailand's Condos

When planning to spend many years in Thailand, especially as a long-term resident or retiree, it makes good sense to look after your health. That means trying to eat well, staying active, and finding a regular form of exercise that fits your lifestyle. Over the years, I've joined several gyms in Pattaya. Some are very well run, keeping their equipment in top condition. Others, however, don't seem to invest in maintenance. Instead of fixing faulty machines, they simply slap on a "Do Not Use" sign and leave it at that. It's not just frustrating, it's unsafe.

One of the perks of condo living in Thailand is the often-included gym. It's a real bonus: no membership fees to worry about, and you can skip the sweaty drive or rainy-season hassle of commuting to a fitness center. Some condo gyms offer a surprisingly good selection of equipment, but others may only have a handful of machines squeezed into a spare room. Unfortunately, however, regardless of the setup, one thing many condo gyms have in

common is the fact that after the initial outlay they often skimp on maintaining their equipment.

From personal experience, I've noticed that the treadmill is often the first to show signs of neglect. Slipping belts, inconsistent resistance, and odd noises are common, especially when you increase the pace. Exercise bikes can become too stiff (or too loose), and strength machines often suffer from worn cables or dry pulleys that badly need lubrication.

Of course, it's not just about comfort. Equipment that's regularly serviced is also safer to use. A loose cable or faulty treadmill could lead to serious injury. If you're part of your building's committee, I strongly recommend budgeting for at least an annual service. It's a small investment that improves safety, preserves your equipment, and adds value to your condo community.



Another option, which more and more people are choosing, is to buy your own exercise equipment. It gives you full control over your workout environment, and you can tailor it to your preferences. We bought a Reebok exercise bike from Seara and it has served us brilliantly. Easy to move, comfortable to use, it quickly became part of the weekly routine especially when you can use it whilst watching favourite TV shows. Eventually though the tension controls became unreliable, and we noticed an odd noise from the casing that signaled something wasn't right. So it was time for a service and we got in touch with Seara.

Their team was prompt, professional, and punctual. a refreshing experience in a world where service windows often stretch for hours. The technicians arrived exactly on time, quickly diagnosed the issue, and got to work. Impressively, the repair was carried out on-site, with no need to remove the bike or wait days for its return. LEGAL ADVICE IN PURCHASING A PROPERTY IN THAILAND

Buying property in Thailand can be an exciting investment, but it also involves important legal points to consider to protect your interests. Whether you're a foreigner or a local buyer, conducting due diligence helps ensure a safe, transparent, and legally sound transaction. Property due diligence is a thorough process to confirm all legal, financial, and factual aspects of a property before purchase. It is advisable to begin the thorough, detailed due diligence before signing a binding contract. Here are the key points to consider in purchasing a property:

1. Title Deed

The first thing to do is check the title deed. Make sure there are no registered liens or obligations on it. If there is a registered lien, like a mortgage with a bank, you can still purchase the house. You just need to make sure that the mortgage is removed at the same time the house is transferred to you.

2. Right-of-Way

This is very important—you must be able to legally access the property. In some cases, you may find that a part of your land is being used by others. One common example is when your land inevitably becomes the only pathway or walkway of entrance and exit for your neighbors. You must ensure there's legal access to get to the house. Normally, this would be through a public road or a private road with a servitude (legal right of access) registered against it.



3. Construction Permit

Check if the house is legally built with a properly registered construction permit. Commencing any construction work without the proper permit is illegal. It must be built in accordance with the construction permit.

4. Housing Project vs. Stand-Alone Group

Determine whether the property is a part of a registered housing project or just a group of stand-alone houses. **A housing project** has rules and regulations listed at the Land Office and a juristic person to manage it. If bills aren't paid, sanctions can be imposed.

A **stand-alone group** is simply a group of people who agree to pay shared costs. If one person doesn't pay, the system can break down because there's no legal enforcement. Therefore, it's usually best to buy a property within a registered housing project.

5. Local Area Tax

There's a building tax that City Hall can claim retroactively for up to 10 years. This tax is against the building, not the owner. So even if you bought the house only 6 months ago, you could still be liable for unpaid tax from 10 years ago. It would be best to visit the City Hall to confirm that this tax has been paid.

6. Court Cases

Check with the local courts to ensure there are no pending legal cases or disputes involving the property.

7. Sales Contract

Check the contract terms for fairness and make sure that there are no hidden costs or obligations. Allow a Thai lawyer to thoroughly review the contract details. A lawyer will help to ensure that the sales contract is legally binding, transparent, and do not contain unfavorable terms that could put you at a disadvantage.

If you follow these steps and everything checks out, then you've likely found a good property to purchase. Failure to conduct the necessary safeguard usually results in terrible consequences, such as serious financial and legal distress on the part of the buyer. This is why buyers must remember that almost always, after completing the transfer, the seller will not hold responsibility for problems the buyer did not discover. Doing your due diligence before buying property in Thailand isn't just a smart move—it's essential. From verifying land titles to checking for hidden liabilities, these steps can save you from costly mistakes and legal trouble later on. Game Time: Should Schools Embrace Esports?

Exploring Thailand's digital revolution in education and what it could mean for our classrooms.

Walk through any international school in Thailand and you'll likely see a familiar sight; projectors hum, fingers swipe rapidly on tablets, you may even hear some shouts from a particularly heated game of Kahoot. Technology is already transforming the learning experience. Yet increasingly, one form of digital engagement is standing out - not for its novelty, but for its unexpected educational potential: esports.



Esports, or competitive gaming, is now officially recognised as a professional sport by the Thai government. Since 2021, this recognition has enabled formal support from the Sports Authority of Thailand (SAT) and the Ministry of Tourism and Sports, with the Thailand E-Sports Federation (TESF) overseeing the sport's development nationally. As a result, athletes benefit from improved infrastructure, funding and legitimacy, while schools are being encouraged to explore their place in education. This shift presents both a challenge and an opportunity for schools. Are we ready to take esports seriously? More importantly, are we willing to engage with it in a way that adds meaningful value to our students' learning?

The Impact on Students: More Than Just Games

Young people are already immersed in gaming culture. For many, this is more than a pastime, it is a digital social space, a creative outlet and a competitive environment that demands quick thinking and collaboration. Ignoring this reality can create a disconnect between school and the world students live in. In contrast, structured esports programmes offer an opportunity to bridge that gap. When implemented thoughtfully, esports can support:

Teamwork and Communication: Many games require teams to plan strategies, communicate under pressure and evaluate performance together. These skills are transferable well beyond the screen.

Leadership and Responsibility: Esports roles go beyond players. Team captains, coaches, analysts and managers all contribute, creating opportunities for students to take ownership and lead their peers.

Digital Literacy and Media Skills: Students involved in esports often engage with streaming, content creation and shout casting, video editing, data analysis, and digital marketing, all highly relevant in today's job market.

Inclusion and Equity: Unlike traditional sports, esports is less dependent on physical ability, gender or language. Students from diverse backgrounds can compete on equal footing, building confidence and connections in ways that traditional models sometimes fail to offer.

Mental Agility and Resilience: Competitive gaming is intense. Success requires fast decision-making, persistence after failure and managing the highs and lows of performance, key attributes in both academic and personal life. It's important to acknowledge the risks too. Excessive screen time, sedentary habits and online safety concerns remain real. These can, however, be mitigated through clear boundaries, supportive adult guidance and holistic programming that includes physical wellbeing, digital citizenship and offline activities.

A Curriculum Students Actually Care About

Introducing esports into schools should not mean simply creating a club and walking away. The deeper opportunity lies in how it can shape a curriculum that feels relevant, exciting and genuinely future-facing. For example, schools might incorporate esports themes into:

Computer Science and ICT: Programming, game development or understanding the algorithms behind matchmaking and game engines.

Business Studies and Entrepreneurship: Branding, sponsorship, event management and the economics of the gaming industry.

Media and English: Writing reviews, producing streams, shout casting, commentating matches, or scripting in-game narratives.



Wellbeing and PSHE: Conversations around healthy online behaviour, screen-life balance and managing digital identity. This is where schools can genuinely innovate. Rather than viewing esports as an isolated activity, it can act as a lens through which to make broader learning more meaningful. Students are more likely to engage with content when they see its relevance to their passions and potential futures.

Where We Go from Here

This is not a call to replace sports fields with gaming chairs. Physical activity, outdoor learning and human connection remain vital, as I argued in my article 'Tech or Trees?' However, schools must also evolve alongside the world students inhabit. Esports may be a surprising vehicle, but it could also be one of the most effective for helping students thrive in a digital age.




Pullman Pattaya Hotel G led successful beach cleaning initiative, fostering sustainable tourism practice in Wongamat Beach, Pattaya




The Autovlography BARRY UPTON

A couple of years ago, I wrote my autobiography wistfully entitled 'Confessions Of A Pop Tart'. My life in the music and entertainment business has, not just been thoroughly enjoyable, but full of great stories as I crossed paths with numerous recording artists and celebrities.

LAMPANG, THE HISTORIC AND TIMELESS CITY

Chapter 7 – Unseen Lampang

Introduction: After you have seen so many aspects of Lampang, in this chapter we are going to make you amazed at Lampang with the other sides.

Daibutsu, the Great Buddha Image of Kotokuin Temple, Kamakura Town of Japan

Looking at this picture of Daibutsu at the first sight. Do you think you see the temple of Daibutsu in Kamakura Town of Japan? Just follow us to Wat Phra Thart Doi Phra Shan or Doi Phra Shan Temple, located in Mae Tha District, around 15 Km. southeast of Lampang City. When you see the environment around the temple, it completely looks like the original one in Japan. This is the temple Abbot's inspiration for imitation of Daibutsu. At one in night of 2013, he had a dream of the Great Buddha of Kamakura Daibutsu flew from the sky and landed on the top of Doi Phra Shan Hill, and he heard a voice saying, "Please build me here, I will come here to be with you". Therefore, one year later, the abbot decided to build the great Buddha that was made of a metal by forming method that assembled with steel frames using metal weighted at 32 tons in total. The Buddha dimension is 14 meters width and 23 meters height. The foundation laying ceremony was held on June 19, 2014 and construction completion was September 21, 2021.








THE SKY PAGODA

Located at Phra Bat Suthawas Temple in Chae Home District, about 60 Km. north of Lampang City taking about 1 hour driving to get there. This temple was built to commemorate King Rama IV for his 200th. Anniversary on October 18, 2004. In order to get to the mountain ridge where the line of many different sizes of pagodas are situated on the ridge, all tourists must take a minibus from the ground of the temple passing the narrow and steep road that is about 800 meters above the sea level that take about 30 minutes of time to reach the walk ways on to the summit which are steel staircases of over 300 steps with the length of 540 meters. Upon reaching the peak, there is a first aids unit for anyone who might faint from the sick of long walking steps. At the viewpoint, you can see the wonderful panorama of the mountain with many pagodas on the ridge and down to ground where many villages laying in wide angle of sight.



หลังจากที่ท่านได้เห็นลำปางในแง่มุมต่างๆแล้ว เราขอพาท่านไปชมความทึ่งของลำปางในอีกด้านหนึ่งที่ท่านอาจยังไม่เคยเห็น

ไดบุตสุ พระพุทธรูปองค์ใหญ่แห่งเมืองคามาคูระ อันถือเป็นสัญลักษณ์หนึ่งของประเทศญี่ปุ่น

ถ้าท่านเห็นภาพนี้ในแวบแรก ท่านอาจจะคิดถึงพระพุทธรูปไดบุตสุแห่งวัดโคโตคูอินเมืองคามาคูระ ในประเทศญี่ปุ่น หากท่านตามเรามายังวัดพระธาตุ ดอยพระฌาณ ซึ่งตั้งอยู่ที่อำเภอแม่ทะ ประมาณ 15 ก.ม.ทางทิศตะวันออกเฉียงใต้ของตัวเมืองลำปาง และเห็นสิ่งแวดล้อม ณ สถานที่ตรงนั้น จะเห็น ว่าเหมือนกับวัดโตโคคูอินที่มีพระพุทธรูปไดบุตสุประดิษฐานอยู่จริงๆ นี่คือแรงบันดาลใจของท่านเจ้าอาวาสวัดดอยพระฌาณที่เกิดจากความฝันของท่านใน คืนหนึ่งของปี พ.ศ. 2556 ในฝันนั้นท่านเห็นนิมิตว่า พระพุทธรูปไดบุตสุ ลอยมาจากฟากฟ้าแล้วลงมาตั้งอยู่บนยอดดอยพระฌาณ พร้อมกับมีพระสุรเสียง เปล่งออกมาว่า "ท่านสร้างเราไว้ที่นี่ แล้วเราจะมาอยู่กับท่าน" จากนั้นอีก 1 ปีต่อมา ท่านเจ้าอาวาสจึงตัดสินใจสร้างพระพุทธรูปไดบุตสุเพื่อประดิษฐาน บนยอดดอยพระฌาณ ซึ่งใช้แผ่นทองแดง เคาะขึ้นรูปเป็นองค์พระ แล้วหุ้มโครงเหล็กซึ่งมีน้ำหนัก 32 ตัน องค์พระมีขนาดหน้าตัก 14 เมตร สูง 32 เมตร มีพิธีวางศิลาฤกษ์ในวันที่ 19 มิถุนายน 2557 การก่อสร้างแล้วเสร็จในวันที่ 21 กันยายน 2564 นับเป็นสถานที่ท่องเที่ยวสำคัญแห่งใหม่ของลำปาง







เหล่าพระธาตุบนยอดเขา


ตั้งอยู่บนยอดเขาที่วัดพระพุทธบาทสุทธาวาสหรือวัดเฉลิมพระเกียรติ ในอำเภอแจ้ห่ม ห่างจากตัวเมืองลำปางขึ้นไปทางทิศเหนือประมาณ 60 ก.ม. ใช้เวลา ประมาณหนึ่งชั่วโมงโดยการขับรถไป วัดแห่งนี้ สร้างขึ้นเพื่อเฉลิมพระเกียรติพระบาทสมเด็จพระจอมเกล้าเจ้าอยู่หัว รัชกาลที่ 4 เนื่องในโอกาสครบรอบ 200 ปีพระราชสมภพของพระองค์ท่าน ตัววัดและพระอุโบสถ ตั้งอยู่เชิงเขา การเดินทางขึ้นชมส่วนของพระวิหารและเจดีย์บนยอดเขา ต้องเดินทางโดยรถ สองแถวเล็กที่ทางวัดจัดไว้ให้บริการ โดยท่านต้องจอดรถไว้ในบริเวณวัด เส้นทางรถขึ้นไปสู่บันไดทางขึ้นเขา เป็นทางแคบ คดเคี้ยว และสูงชัน ซึ่งต้องใช้คน ขับรถที่ชำนาญทางเท่านั้น โดยใช้เวลาประมาณ 20 นาที เมื่อถึงทางขึ้นเขาซึ่งเป็นบันไดเหล็ก มีจำนวนประมาณ 300 ชั้น ระยะทาง 540 เมตร อยู่เหนือ ระดับน้ำทะเล 800 เมตร และมีที่พักเหนื่อยเป็นระยะๆ เมื่อถึงยอดแล้ว จะมีหน่วยปฐมพยาบาล บริการนักท่องเที่ยวบางท่านที่อาจเหน็ดเหนื่อยจากการ เดินเท้าขึ้นบันไดเป็นระยะทางยาว อาจมีอาการหน้ามืดเป็นลม เมื่อถึงจุดชมวิวแล้ว จะรู้ว่าคุ้มค่าเหนื่อยจริงๆ ท่านจะเห็นภาพและสามารถถ่ายภาพมุมกว้าง แบบพาโนรามาของเหล่าเจดีย์น้อยใหญ่ที่เรียงรายอยู่บนสันเขาอย่างงดงามตื่นตา รวมไปถึงภาพด้านล่างซึ่งเป็นหมู่บ้านเล็กๆหลายหมู่บ้านจากมุมสูง











Travel escapes to the beautiful rural town of Red Cloud in the State of Nebraska, USA are being promoted to explore the history and life of a renowned woman writer. Born around 150 years ago, the literary great Willa Cather: (Dec. 7, 1873-April 24, 1947) is known for her uniquely American prose, still relevant today. Travelers to Red Cloud can learn about Cather by taking tours at sites related to her, including visiting the home where she lived. There are also many activities in the town and surrounding areas, such as shopping, hiking, golf, bowling, dining, swimming, and sightseeing.



Hotel Garber is the newest thing in Red Cloud with its multi-million dollar restoration of the historic Potter-Wright structure. The extraordinary new hotel has 27 well-furnished rooms, and hallways are filled with photographs from the last century. From the lobby, you can sit on colorful sofa chairs, relax, and admire the beauty of Hotel Garber, a nod to Silas Garber, a character in Cather's book "A Lost Lady". Forrester is also mentioned in a Cather book. We were invited to stay overnight at the extraordinary boutique Garber and try the tasty food for dinner in its restaurant Forrester's. Chef Mark Tucker oversees a delicious menu in this lovely, hip dining and bar area. It's well worth a drive from Interstate Highway 80, which goes east and west across the United States. A stay at Hotel Garber makes for the perfect stop on a road trip.

In 1871, Garber and a group of locals named the town "Red Cloud" after the Ogala Lakota Native American: Chief Red Cloud. A prominent figure in the 19th-century conflicts between Native Americans and the U.S. government, he was an admired leader. The region had also been used as a hunting ground by the Pawnee Native Americans. Today with about 1,000 residents this awesome small town is in the center of the country and draws U.S. and international visitors to check out the hometown of noted Pulitzer Prize-winning author Willa Cather.





In 1923 Cather was awarded the Pulitzer Prize for "One of Ours," a novel set during World War I. "My Antonia" is another of Cather's famous books. The National Endowment for the Arts in Washington, D.C. included it in its Big Read program, sparking even more recent interest in her work. Some of her other many books include "Alexander's Bridge", "The Song of the Lark", and "O Pioneer". She loved her little Nebraska frontier town, with an impressive Opera House, and referenced Red Cloud in speeches and in her writings. The community still celebrates her with conferences; famous actors such as Jessica Lange have starred in movies made from Cather novels.

"Great Stories Grow Here" is one of the tourism sayings of Red Cloud. The National Willa Cather Center is among important sites, located across the street from Hotel Garber, to immerse in the author's life. There is so much here about Cather, and visitors can go into the archives room to find out more. The Willa Cather Memorial Prairie is outside of town, with roughly 612 acres to enjoy. You can hike the trails, delight in the unbroken horizon, and experience the prairie as it was more than one hundred years ago. It's especially beautiful at sunset time for pictures, and even later for star-gazing!

Visitors come from all over the world to tiny Red Cloud because of the significance of the legendary author. A new "Cather Immersion Package" includes several days of excursions to connections with the writer and a night's stay in Red Cloud. Celebrities such as civil rights activist Maya Angelou and American media personality Garrison Keillor have slipped into Red Cloud because they were fans of Cather's 12 novels, six collections of short fiction, and several volumes of poetry.



Bank

Around town and in the surrounding area are fun things to do. There's a huge unique Starke Round Barn, the largest true round barn in the world, with a tour from Liz by appointment from jmccartney@redcloudnebraska.com. The Shute Bison mural is another sight. A 19-mile drive will take you past the Nebraska border and into the State of Kansas (before reaching the town of Lebanon). Here you can take pictures at the exact geographical center of the Continental United States.

They looked all over the U.S. and finally found this place that was going to go out of business. So they saved the cute retro bowling alley and added a lot of atmosphere and great food. Alley Cat has a big breakfast following with huge portions of yummy pancakes, eggs any style, and the works. Nearby is craft beer & cocktail bar On the Brix, matching the sophistication of any city bar. Relax at Corner Nook for soft beverages, browsing books and clothing. There's a lot to do in and around Red Cloud.

Summer in the City of London Gloria Rediscovers The Royal Botanic Gardens, Kew

It has been many years since I last visited The Royal Botanic Gardens, Kew, usually simply referred to as Kew Gardens. It is a wonderful place to go, especially on a summer's day in London. Spanning over 300 acres and serving not only as a place of immense natural beauty but also as a global leader in plant science, conservation, and education. With its rich history, diverse plant collections, and commitment to safeguarding the future of plants, it's a truly unique place to visit and one I thought I should rediscover.

Kew Gardens' dates back to 1759 when it was created as a royal garden for Augusta the Princess of Wales. Later in 1840 Queen Victoria endorsed the decision to transform Kew from a royal pleasure place into a public park, on the understanding that it would also be used as a scientific institution dedicated to botanical research. Sir William Hooker was then appointed its first official Director and during his time there the gardens grew in size. Many glasshouses were constructed including the iconic Palm House, the building most people associate with Kew. A masterpiece of Victorian engineering, it is made of wrought iron and glass and inside designed to replicate a rainforest environment. Visitors can experience a vast array of tropical plants. By climbing the spiral staircases you can get an even closer view of varieties of exotic plants including towering palms, banana trees, orchids and rare ferns. The humidity and warmth create an immersive experience that feels like stepping into another world.

More orchids can be found within The Princess of Wales Conservatory, opened in 1987 by Princess Diana. As well as orchids it's home to vast array of plants, including cacti and even carnivorous species like Venus flytraps.I remembered it from an earlier visit some years ago although this visit time I have to say the conservatory was outshone by the smaller Waterlily House but stunningly beautiful this was a new discovery for me only found because we had been able to explore more of the gardens via the Kew Explorer.







The Kew explorer costs £6.50 for adults and £2.50 for children and is very well worth the ticket price. With it you are really able to appreciate the actual size of Kew and the parts it would take far too long to walk to. For example the impressive Redwood trees area.rare and endangered species and the famous and majestic Kew oaks. In fact there are more than 14.000 trees here from over 2,000 different species. There is also a tour guide on the explorer to alert you to amazing facts like the fact that around 90% of the world's entire plant species can be found in Kew Gardens. Home to one of the most diverse plant collections on Earth, with over 50,000 living plants spread across its vast landscape, glasshouses and gardens, the specimens here represent nearly every corner of the globe.







Today, Kew is not only a UNESCO World Heritage Site that inspires millions of visitors annually, it is also a major global centre for scientific research and plant conservation. The Kew Science department employs hundreds of botanists, mycologists, and researchers who work to discover, catalogue, and conserve plant diversity.Kew's Herbarium houses over 7 million preserved plant specimens and is one of the largest and most comprehensive collections in the world. These specimens, some dating back centuries, are used by scientists around the globe to identify plant species, study biodiversity, and track ecological changes over time. The library and archives are similarly impressive, containing more than 750,000 volumes and thousands of botanical illustrations, maps, and manuscripts.

Kew is deeply committed to educating the public about the importance of plants and the need to protect them. Exhibitions, guided tours, seasonal festivals, and art installations further engage visitors, helping to raise awareness about critical issues such as climate change, deforestation, and biodiversity loss. As a leading authority in botany, it collaborates with more than 100 countries to support sustainable development, protect endangered species, and train future plant scientists. Its work supports the UN's Sustainable Development Goals, particularly those related to climate action, life on land, and food security.


