
















If you're looking for something a little more relaxed during this festive season, the Kliff Beach Club, with its stunning sea views, offers a stylish escape.



Sometimes given a military connotation, the word patriot actually describes someone who deeply loves, supports and defends their country (or, for the purposes of this article, their city). They often demonstrate loyalty through service, sacrifice, and civic engagement. True patriotism goes beyond mere pride—it involves striving to make improvements for all, for freedom, and for progress. I personally believe that Christmas isn't Christmas in Pattaya until the children of the HHNFT (Human Help Network Foundation Thailand) sing at the Rotary Club Eastern Seaboard's annual party. Even before I met Khun Toy, I had always been impressed at how well the children sang the carols both in English and Thai. The beautiful outfits they wore and most importantly their wonderful smiles especially during "Jingle Bells". It is for that very reason that I waited until our December issue to write about Khun Toy because I have always thought of her as being a "Mother Christmas" to the hundreds of children she has helped and is still continuing to help.

This September Khun Toy (Ratchada Chomjinda) who is the Director of HHNFT, celebrated her 70th birthday! For many of these years she has worked tirelessly for charitable foundations, 18 of them at HHNFT. Her excellent English can be attributed to the secretarial work she did after leaving school. Firstly working for the Japanese embassy and then as secretary to the Finnish ambassador in Bangkok.

When she followed this by working for UNICEF she told me that the job was mainly admin based, she never got to see the children that were helped. So when she came to Pattaya to work at the orphanage here and saw first hand the good work that was being done for disabled, blind and generally disadvantaged children, she knew she had "Come to the Right Place".

In August of this year HHNFT Director Radchada Chomjinda was selected as a distinguished female role model and honored by The Senate Standing Committee on Social Development and Children, Youth, Women, the Elderly, the Disabled and the Underprivileged Affairs. She received the award at Thailand's Parliament Building (The Senate Wing) in Bangkok and in her typically modest way, Khun Toy says the best thing about receiving the award was the recognition it gave to HHNFT.





Shining a light on the multiple programs, the foundation does including: a drop-In Center, offering food, clothing, medical care, and counseling to children in crisis. A Child Protection & Development Center (CPDC), which houses abused or trafficked children cared for by nannies, teachers, and counselors. Outreach programs on the streets and in migrant communities, supporting children at risk of exploitation, and an Education Center for those whose families lack access to formal schooling such as migrant children, many from Laos, Cambodia and Myanmar who otherwise would be begging on the streets or sleeping rough on the beach

Khun Toy is keen to praise her team which includes a professional psychiatrist and associate judge, plus two who have degrees as licensed social workers. This means that each child can be properly assessed and cared for. They can also benefit from mixing with other children and learning languages, and skills to give them real tools for independence. Under Khun Toy's guidance, HHNFT runs initiatives like the Decoupage Project: where the youth learn to make decorative handicrafts, which are then sold to raise funds and buy presents (at Christmas for example).





Also the kids love working in the organic garden which teaches self-reliance through farming. Learning to cultivate pesticide-free vegetables using aquaponic systems, combining ecological awareness with practical life skills. The HGM Education Fund: In partnership with HHNFT also awards scholarships to underprivileged children so they can continue their studies right through into University. So the care goes on even beyond the 150 children I was privileged to see and hear sing to me at the Drop in Centre.

Help and donations are always needed for the excellent work the HHNFT does, especially now as recently and quite unexpectedly the foundation mourned the loss of Ewald Dietrich, a key founder and supporter, which created a huge and sudden gap both emotionally and financially. Khun Toy and her team have had to step up their fundraising efforts as a result and in fact she had just returned from a trip to Germany to do just that when I went to visited her at the centre. Due Diligence: A Must for Foreign Property Buyers in Thailand

Thailand appeals to a wide range of nationalities with its stunning beaches, contemporary condominiums, and investment opportunities. However, many foreign buyers are unaware of the practical and legal pitfalls that lie behind the inviting prices and glossy brochures. As a consultant who frequently deals with foreigners purchasing real estate in Thailand, I have seen two kinds of clients: those who conduct due diligence and those who regret not having done their research. My goal is to help you avoid unpleasant surprises. Due diligence is not an optional step here—it's your main protection.

Recognizing the Actual Risks

The property market in Thailand doesn't work quite the same way as it does in many other countries. Yes, foreigners can legally own condominium units, but owning land is a different story with strict limitations. That's why many buyers end up exploring long-term leases, company setups, or usufruct arrangements — each of which comes with its own set of rules and fine print.

Because of all these layers, things can easily go wrong when someone jumps into a purchase too quickly. I've seen buyers rely on friendly assurances, assumptions, or a smooth-talking agent, only to discover problems later on. Some found out the title deed didn't match what was registered at the Land Office. Others learned that their building had already reached the foreign



ownership quota, that construction permits were missing, or that the property they bought was carrying someone else's debt. These situations are far more common than many people think, and they're exactly why due diligence is so important. These issues might have been avoided by carrying out appropriate due diligence prior to completing the transaction. When we do due diligence for clients, our main aim is straightforward: to make sure the property you're planning to buy is truly what it appears to be, without hidden issues. The process typically includes:

Verification of Title Deeds

We go to the Land Office to check the property's title deed. This lets us confirm that the seller genuinely owns the property and has the clear right to transfer it to you.

Check for Encumbrance and Liability

Properties in Thailand can come with mortgages, liens, leases, usufructs, or other registered rights attached to them—and these don't simply vanish when the property is sold. We make sure you're not unknowingly taking on someone else's debt or obligations when you buy.

Review of Foreign Ownership Quota (for Condos)

By law, foreigners can own only up to 49% of the total sellable area of a condominium project. Many buyers are unaware of this—and end up unable to register their purchase even after paying. We verify available quota before anything is signed.

Background Check for Developers or Sellers

We check the developer's track record, completed projects, and any financial issues or disputes. We check resale units for any legal cases, bankruptcy concerns, or irregularities involving the seller.

Zoning and Building Permits

We verify that building permits, land use approvals, and environmental requirements are met for homes, villas, or off-plan projects. This step is crucial for avoiding demolition orders or unregistrable structures.

Reviewing Contract

To make sure your rights are adequately safeguarded, we review the contract to ensure they are legally binding, transparent, and do not contain unfavorable terms that could put you at a disadvantage.

Why Due Diligence Is Even More Important for Foreign Buyers

Foreign investors often turn to agents, friends, or sellers for information. But if anything goes wrong later, the Thailand's legal system places responsibility on the buyer—not the seller.

Additionally, foreign buyers must comply with specific rules such as:

- Sending money from overseas correctly to obtain the Foreign Exchange Transaction Certificate, which is required to own a condo.
- Making sure that leases are properly registered to be enforceable.
- Avoiding unlawful nominee arrangements when buying land.

A minor error in any of these areas could result in the loss of ownership rights or prevent resale.

My Professional Recommendation

If you plan to buy property in Thailand—whether it's a condo, villa, or land lease—engage a qualified Thai lawyer or consultant before paying a deposit. A developer may tell you everything is fine, but due diligence should always be handled independently. The cost of the due diligence itself is much less than the peace of mind you get from knowing your investment is legal and safe.

Celebrating the Festive Season in a Multicultural School Community

For many families living abroad, December brings a swirl of emotions. The festive season arrives wrapped in nostalgia, tradition and memories of home. Yet in Thailand, where international communities are wonderfully varied and schools bring together children from dozens of countries, this time of year also offers something unique: the opportunity to celebrate Christmas and other seasonal traditions in a way that is inclusive, joyful and culturally rich. International schools across Thailand work hard to create this balance every year. With students representing nationalities from every corner of the globe, the festive season becomes far more than a countdown to Christmas; it becomes a celebration of community.

A Season That Means Something Different to Everyone

The first challenge, and privilege, of being in an international school setting is recognising that December holds a different meaning for each family. For some, it is a deeply religious period. For others, it is a cultural holiday centred on food, family and gifts. And for many, it is simply a special time marked by lights, music and a general sense of goodwill.

Schools aim to honour these differences without prioritising any one tradition above another; after all, Thailand is majority Buddhist but with thriving Muslim, Hindu and Christian communities, among others. The festive season becomes an opportunity to teach students about diversity, respect and curiosity. Rather than assuming that Christmas sits at the centre of the month, educators design activities and events that acknowledge a wide spectrum of celebrations, from Christmas to New Year festivals in various cultures, and even the Thai traditions that continue as usual throughout December.

Creating an Inclusive Atmosphere

One of the simplest yet most effective ways schools embrace the festive period is through atmosphere. Children adore the sense of magic that comes with twinkling lights, themed displays and decorations lovingly assembled by teachers, staff and sometimes even parents. But the decorations in international schools tend to be intentionally varied. You may see a Christmas tree next to a display about winter celebrations around the world, or paper lanterns created by students from countries where December isn't a major holiday at all. Classrooms often have "festive corners" where students contribute their own symbols of celebration, whether that's a Christmas ornament, a traditional craft from home or a drawing of their favourite seasonal food. This kind of visual representation sends a powerful message: everyone belongs, and everyone's traditions matter.

Learning Through Celebration

Many schools use the festive season as a springboard for learning. It's a natural point in the year to explore comparative cultures, geography, storytelling and religious education, all woven into activities that feel fun and engaging.

You might see students researching how winter is celebrated in their home countries, writing reflections about their family traditions or tasting foods from around the world at a multicultural fair. Teachers often incorporate music, drama and art, allowing children to express themselves creatively while learning about the significance of celebrations elsewhere.



In Early Years and Primary settings especially, role-play and storytelling bring these moments to life. One classroom might re-enact the Nativity for cultural understanding, while next door students might explore the symbolism of light in different festivals. The aim is never to promote one belief, but to cultivate a sense of global awareness and empathy.

Events That Bring the Community Together

International schools often act as community hubs for expat families, and the festive season is one of the rare times of year when everyone gathers in the same space. From winter concerts and charity drives to relaxed family afternoons with games and market stalls, these events help families feel connected at a time when many are far from home.

What stands out most in these moments is the sense of togetherness. Parents from different countries swap stories about how they celebrated as children. Children delight in singing songs, sometimes in several languages, without feeling the need to "belong" to any one tradition. Staff greet families warmly, knowing how important it is to recreate that familiar sense of warmth that December brings. Charitable giving is also a common thread in international schools. The festive period becomes a chance to teach students about compassion and responsibility towards others, whether through donation drives, fundraising for local causes or organising visits to community organisations.



Supporting Students Who Find the Season Difficult

It's important to acknowledge that not all students experience the festive season positively. Some miss extended family; others may feel overwhelmed by the unfamiliarity of new customs. International schools therefore take care to ensure the season remains supportive as well as celebratory.

Pastoral teams and teachers are often particularly attentive at this time of year. They look out for students who need a little reassurance, encourage open conversations and make sure that no child feels excluded or pressured to participate in activities that don't align with their family's beliefs. The message is simple: everyone is welcome to join in, and everyone is equally respected if they choose not to.

Celebrating What Unites Us

In the end, what defines the festive season in Thailand's international schools is not a single event, tradition or holiday. It is the shared experience of celebrating together, of finding common ground amid differences. Whether families come from London, Seoul, Moscow, Mumbai or Bangkok, December in an international school setting offers a reminder that community is something we create, not something we inherit. For many expat families, this is what makes the festive season abroad so memorable. It becomes a celebration of many traditions, woven together in harmony, a true reflection of the multicultural world our children are growing up in.



OF 2025

We're coming to the end of the sporting year so let's take a look at some of the outstanding performances of the last twelve months which have made 2025 another memorable year in the world of sport around the globe.

Golf history was made in the Masters at Augusta in April when Rory McIlroy joined the elite group of players to have won the "Grand Slam", which is a victory in all four majors, the Masters, the US Open, the US PGA and the British Open over the course of a career. He joins

legends of the game such as Gary Player, Jack Nicklaus and Tiger Woods in this exclusive club and it puts him in competition with Nick Faldo and Seve Ballesteros for the title of the greatest golfer Europe has produced.

Of course where McIlroy is involved nothing is ever straightforward and having given up a seven shot lead to runner-up Justin Rose, he was forced into a playoff with the Englishman which he won on the first extra hole. That kind of performance is typical of McIlroy and the kind of swashbuckling golf that he plays has endeared him to millions of golf fans around the world. He finished the year with four victories and has become only the second player in history, behind a certain Tiger Woods, to earn over \$100 million in a single season.



This lends weight to the theory that the Americans are uncomfortable in the team events over the first two days but excel in the individual matches on the last day and the team USA comeback in the singles matches was indeed remarkable. The Ryder Cup is one of the very few times that golf is played as a team game throughout the year and the format lends itself to being a great spectacle. Let's hope the fans can enjoy it in the future without recreating some of the scenes we witnessed at Bethpage Black this year.

In Formula 1 Max Verstappen managed to hold on to the drivers title for the fourth successive year but in the constructor's championship the incredible resurgence of Mclaren continued with their first win since 1998.



McIlroy also played a major part in the other big golfing story of the year, Europe retaining the Ryder Cup on American soil. The event was marred by some appalling behaviour from spectators and we can only hope that the outpouring of criticism from the press and some of the greats of the past will encourage the crowds to behave in a way befitting the game when the competition returns to Ireland in 2027. In the end team Europe only scrambled home after the singles matches having taken what most people thought was an unassailable 11.5 - 4.5 lead into the final day.





In tennis in the men's game, something quite remarkable is happening. After the twenty year domination by Nadal, Djokovic and Federer we now have two players that are leagues ahead of the rest in the shape of the Spaniard Carlos Alvaraz and Jannik Sinner from Italy. Their supremacy is such that the only Grand Slam final not contested by the two of them playing each other was the Australian Open in January where Sinner defended his title with a comfortable three set victory.

Since then they have met each other in the French, Wimbledon and US Open finals with the Spaniard coming out on top 2-1. The recent Champion of Champions tournament, which matches the top eight players in the world against each other, saw them both reach the final without dropping a set and the world rankings, where Alavaraz is shading Sinner for the top spot by a few hundred points, sees the third best player trailing some 5000 points behind!



In football, Harry Kane continued his remarkable goal scoring record for both club and country and after his continuing heroics for Bayern Munich, he must now go down as one of the greatest players ever to come from England. His figures for the German club are quite extraordinary and he continues to find the net for England too.

Let's hope he can carry that form forward to the World Cup next year. Also scoring goals for fun is Erling Haaland, who's record since the start of the new Premier League season is quite ridiculous and he too has carried that form forward to the international scene for Norway, who have become lively outsiders for the World Cup after trouncing Italy in a recent qualifier 4-1 away from home, with Haaland claiming two of the goals

The success has continued in the new season with McLaren holding an unassailable lead in this year's table and both of the team's drivers, Lando Norris and Oscar Piastri battling it out with Verstappen for this season's title. To see Verstappen still in with a chance of retaining his title, however slim that may be, in a car that is clearly inferior to both of the McLarens is a testament to his outstanding ability and dogged determination to wring every point that he can from the car. With the sacking of Christian Horner after twenty years in charge and a new deal with Ford in place, alongside a new team, if Red Bull get back on track for 2026 Verstappen is going to take an awful lot of beating.



The gulf between these two and the rest is huge at the moment and unless some great new young talent comes through, with Alvaraz at only 22 and Sinner at 24 we can expect these two to dominate the game for many years to come.

Among other notable achievements in 2025 was the claiming of the undisputed best heavyweight on the planet title by Oleksandr Usyk, He has now earned himself a place in the boxing hall of fame by beating everyone that has stood in front of him, a thing that all the great heavyweights of the past have done and he's has done it by being the best in all departments, A truly remarkable fighter.



There have been plenty of other highlights in 2025, but alas we haven't space to share them here. Sports such as Cycling, Athletics and Darts have produced moments of high drama and I think we can expect more of the same in 2026, with the centrepiece being the FIFA World Cup, which is being shared this time between the USA, Canada and Mexico. With the expansion from 32 to 48 teams and the competition running for five weeks in the Summer, It's going to take some stamina to follow your country if they go all the way with the time difference being what it is. It'll be worth it though!

2. Growth Period


The strategic focus shifts to market expansion, increased investment, and securing additional funding.

Modern accountants should go beyond traditional bookkeeping and act as Strategic Sentinels who can identify early warning signs of operational issues and alert management so that corrective action can be taken.



According to Thai Accounting Standard (TAS) No. 1, management is responsible for assessing the business's ability to continue as a going concern. While Thai Standard on Auditing (TSA) No. 570 requires auditors to examine and search for appropriate evidence to support the management's assessment, including evaluating

A key tool for business monitoring is the Cash Flow Statement, and Projection they serve as an early-warning signal, and in the next chapter, we will provide a more detailed explanation of how to use cash flow information for business sustainability.
